DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Option list

A meticulously curated specification elevates comfort, capability and style throughout this yacht, beginning with the aft cabin, which is fully fitted with a single berth and its own separate WC and shower, and extending to the saloon, where a full size dining and coffee table replaces the standard table and operates with twin electrically operated leg mechanisms that reduce its length by fifty percent when folded and incorporate a sliding action to serve elegantly as a coffee table. The galley is appointed with GREY HORIZON worktops and a slimline dishwasher capable of nine place settings, while a combination washer/dryer is neatly installed beneath the companionway stairs. Heated towel rails are fitted in the bathrooms as specified per bathroom, and the aft cabin toilet is connected into the holding tank system. Everyday refinements include extra toothbrush cups for each bathroom, a complete set of mosquito nets for the window portholes, and a comprehensive hospitality ensemble comprising a set of dishes for six people — plate, small plate, bowl, cup and saucer — together with a set of glasses for six people and a set of towels for one person supplied as six sets at £85.00 each. In the forward saloon area, stools are provided for use at the dinette — two in total, with lockers beneath the cabin berth accommodating two stools — and Poltroncina folding cockpit chairs in white with stainless steel frames and teak armrests are supplied, each with dedicated storage in the lazarette. The owner's stateroom gains reading wall lights above the bedside cabinets identical to those on the V50 model, while ambiance throughout is heightened by a lighting dimmer in the saloon, LED lighting under the sofas in the saloon and LED lighting beneath the bed in the main cabin.

Performance and autonomy are assured by an ONAN 17.5 kW/50 Hz generator

specified in place of the standard unit, the 17.5 kW generator being recommended when gyro stabilisers or air conditioning are specified, and by reverse cycle air conditioning and heating rated at 78,000 BTU for tropical comfort up to 40°C. A dedicated aft cabin air conditioning system comprises a 6,000 BTU condensing unit supplying a 6,000 BTU unit with SMX control and a separate outlet in the toilet, while a windscreen demist system delivers warm air from the calorifier. The faecal discharge system adds an electric overboard discharge in addition to the standard manual arrangement. Environmental awareness is supported by a weather station compatible with Garmin and extended blue water cruising is enabled by a Dometic desalinator rated at 190 l/h. Electrical infrastructure includes Continental 220/240 V sockets and additional 230 V sockets, with installation of 230 V cables and sockets prepped for satellite TV.

Exterior and deck refinements include a teak laid flybridge deck and side boarding doors to the cockpit area for effortless access, while ground tackle is upgraded with a stainless steel anchor in place of the standard 25 kg anchor together with an additional 20 m of 10 mm chain, bringing the total to 60 metres. Visibility and control are enhanced by three cameras in total covering starboard, port and stern with mounting locations to be confirmed, and there is remote control of the Side Power thrusters at both bow and stern. The exterior lighting upgrade package adds dramatic illumination after dusk.

The ALLURE package (no hardtop) layers on couture detailing both inside and out, introducing quilting with contrast piping and panelling to the lower helm seats and mirroring the effect externally with quilting, contrast piping and panelling to the flybridge helm seats. Teak step nosings are upgraded to include the transom, flybridge and foredeck and, when the side deck option is selected, the steps to the side deck as well. The flybridge console and flybridge wetbar are sprayed in oyster grey, while the foredeck is furnished with sunbed cushions and adjustable headrests; exterior upholstery is specified in Comfort Exterior III Met MACADAMIA.

Navigation and communication are comprehensive: Garmin 16" multifunction displays with chartplotter and GPS and an external aerial are installed at both control positions and paired with a dual station autopilot. On Volvo engine installations the 16" screen incorporates Volvo software enabling engine instrumentation and autopilot function displays; if a second 16" screen is ordered it is fitted immediately in front of the helm with the engine instrumentation display to starboard. A Garmin 424 XHD2 radar with a 48" open array provides powerful situational awareness, while a second 16" colour multifunction display is fitted at the lower helm for expanded control and complemented by Garmin remote control keypads (GRID) at both lower and upper helms. Dedicated Garmin GMI20 4" multifunction displays at each helm provide separate display and control of individual functions such as log and echo sounder, and the suite is completed by a Garmin AIS 800 Class B transponder and a VHF radio.

Canopy and protection solutions are equally considered, with an electro hydraulically powered Bimini top available at additional charge, exterior covers in grey canvas, a matching grey canvas Bimini top and black windscreen covers for privacy and UV protection. The colour and materials palette is timeless: the hull is white with a dark blue waterline and black antifouling, and the hull and bathing platform fendering is white with a stainless steel insert. Interior woodwork is walnut in a satin finish with the galley floor in planked walnut as standard, and the interior colour scheme is SEYCHELLES STONE. Galley worktops are GREY HORIZON, bathroom countertops are CARRARA WHITE and bathroom floors are KOKO WHITE. Helm seats in Feather are trimmed in QUARTZ II LEATHER COLLECTION – PUTTY, the saloon is upholstered in QUARTZ II LEATHER COLLECTION – BONE with optional stools also in QUARTZ II LEATHER COLLECTION – BONE subject to the additional charge for Quartz II leather upholstery in the saloon, and the owner's stateroom, forward cabin and starboard cabin are dressed in QUARTZ COLLECTION VII – MARI FROST 7649/01, with exterior upholstery in Comfort

Exterior III – Met MACADAMIA completing the thoughtful and coherent finish.
