OVERVIEW

2004 Fairline Squadron 58 — Flybridge Motor Yacht

A distinguished member of Fairline's Squadron line, this 58-foot flybridge motor yacht marries British workmanship with assured performance and enduring lines. Kept by the same owner for 15 years and presently located in Turkey, she arrives as a well-preserved luxury cruiser offered by a motivated seller—an appealing opportunity for Mediterranean ownership.

Boarding reveals the yacht's generous proportions. Measuring 58 feet overall with a generous 15-foot beam, she offers an expansive, airy salon framed by wide panoramic glazing, a galley arranged for efficient service, and a sequence of comfortable lounging areas that flow organically from interior spaces to the cockpit and upward to the roomy flybridge. The arrangement is crafted for graceful entertaining, sunset cocktails, and quiet private retreats alike.

Her deep V hull speaks to seakeeping and composure; it slices confidently through chop to deliver the dry, stable ride Fairline yachts are noted for. Propulsion comes from twin Volvo Penta inboard diesels, which furnish smooth and reliable power for economical, long-range cruising—well suited to island-hopping itineraries and coastal passages. A draft of just over four and a half feet helps unlock shallower bays and harbors, while the yacht's balance and hull design ensure poise at speed.

Self-sufficiency aboard is thoughtfully provided. Two generators rated at 17 kW and 7 kW supply redundant, flexible electrical capacity, ensuring comfort whether at anchor or underway. Fuel capacity sits at approximately 650 gallons, extending the cruising range, while a freshwater reserve of about 238 gallons supports extended stays off the dock. From climate control systems to galley appliances, onboard services are arranged for quiet, refined operation. Constructed in durable GRP composite with a fiberglass deck, the hull and superstructure promise longevity and straightforward upkeep. Interior

finishes—polished joinery, premium upholstery, and quality hardware—reflect Fairline’s exacting standards and give the living spaces a refined, welcoming character. The flybridge, a hallmark of the Squadron design, functions as an elevated terrace: commanding sightlines at the helm, ample seating, sunpad areas, and a convivial zone for alfresco dining.

Versatile in purpose, she performs equally well as a family liveaboard or a Mediterranean-ready powerboat, delivering the essentials discerning buyers seek: elegance, capability, and readiness for immediate use. This is a true flybridge motor yacht: deep V performance, GRP integrity, and the enduring appeal of the Fairline Squadron name.

Serious buyers are invited to inspect the yacht in Turkey. Privately maintained for 15 years and now available from a motivated owner, she represents an exceptional proposition in the luxury flybridge cruiser segment.




