OVERVIEW

This graceful motor yacht marries refined seagoing luxury with tournament-ready performance, driven by twin Caterpillar 3412 diesel mains with approximately 950 hours on the clock. Onboard electrical support includes a 20 kW Onan genset, fully rebuilt in 2023, alongside a 25 kW Northern Lights generator installed new in 2020, while a watermaker extends true bluewater autonomy. A recent refit introduced cockpit mezzanine seating that perfectly suits a convertible sportfish layout, complementing the factory-custom four-stateroom arrangement and a spacious four-cabin, three-head accommodation plan. The exterior received a complete repaint finished in 2022, and the vessel's enclosed, climate-controlled bridge/flybridge ensures all-season comfort. New helm electronics and a modern navigation suite round out the upgrades.

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

1999 Viking 58 Convertible Maritere

Maritere, a 1999 Viking 58 Enclosed Bridge, is a classic and proven offshore platform that has been thoughtfully refurbished with a cockpit mezzanine seating configuration, creating an elegant blend of fishing functionality and social comfort. Powered by twin Caterpillar 3412 diesel engines with low hours and built on Viking's renowned solid construction, she delivers confident seakeeping and dependable performance for extended passages well offshore. For an owner seeking a capable sport-fish or cruising yacht with an attractive ownership proposition, this Viking 58 distinguishes itself with an enclosed, air-conditioned bridge that enables true all-weather operation, spacious accommodations for family and guests, dual generators for reliable systems redundancy, and a carefully executed refit that enhances comfort, utility, and style throughout. Inside, the salon welcomes with generous volume, an inviting L-shaped settee and a dedicated dinette, all framed by Viking's high-quality wood cabinetry, while the galley is fully equipped for extended outings with a refrigerator/freezer, electric cooktop, microwave and oven, plus ample storage to keep provisions and cookware neatly organized. The enclosed bridge is fully climate-controlled for comfortable offshore runs, pairing a helm with excellent visibility with an L-shaped sofa for guests, and a helm chair and two helm companion chairs that provide ergonomic support on long passages while a convenient refrigerator keeps refreshments at hand. On deck, the large cockpit—refit with mezzanine seating—creates a superior vantage and a comfortable social hub whether trolling or at anchor, and practical fishing and cruising amenities include a cockpit freezer, tackle storage with a bait prep area, wide side decks for safe movement, a bow pulpit with an anchor windlass for effortless ground tackle handling, and robust stainless steel hardware

throughout. Principal particulars underscore her bluewater intent: a fiberglass hull with a modified V-hull form; LOA 58 ft; beam 18 ft 2 in; draft approximately 5 ft; displacement approximately 92,000 lbs; fuel capacity approximately 1,500 US gal; fresh water capacity approximately 260 US gal; accommodations comprising four cabins and three heads. Altogether, Maritere is a compelling Viking 58 that blends capability, comfort, and enduring build quality for owners who demand performance and refinement.


