OVERVIEW

This stunning 1977 Somerset 14 x 58 Aluminum Hull Houseboat, now available on Norris Lake, Tennessee, presents a rare chance for yacht enthusiasts. The yacht comes with a 12' 4" x 60' 4" dock, constructed with encapsulated styrofoam flotation and wooden framing, featuring a storage shed, ShoreMaster PWC port/float, water slide, and shore power connection. Equipped with a MerCruiser 898 V8 inboard/outboard engine and a Champion air-cooled generator, this houseboat promises a dependable and enjoyable voyage.

The interior showcases a main salon with two convertible sofas, while the galley kitchen is equipped with an electric refrigerator/freezer, gas oven/range, microwave, coffee maker, and a double stainless sink. Outside, a charbroil gas grill with a side burner is ready for use. Comfort is assured with a roof-mounted air conditioning unit with heating capabilities, supplemented by a 1500-watt infrared portable heater.

Moving towards the rear, the hallway features twin over full-size bunk beds, leading to a full bathroom with a new marine head, vanity sink, and walk-in shower, shared with the master stateroom. The master suite includes a queen-size bed, two nightstands, two closets, an integrated dresser, and another roof-mounted air conditioning unit.

Entertainment options include two Roku HDTVs and an AM/FM/CD/Aux input stereo. The covered patio is perfect for unwinding, with a sun-shade, ceiling fan, and a patio table/chair set, plus an additional set on the dock. The upper deck, with its newly gel-coated roof and elevated railing feet, provides ample space for sunbathing. The mooring location on Norris Lake is transferable, making this yacht an attractive choice for those interested in yacht sales at this prime location.




















DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Features & Specs

Presenting the 1977 Somerset 14 x 58 Aluminum Hull Houseboat, a timeless vessel that marries classic allure with contemporary comforts. Nestled on the scenic Norris Lake, this houseboat offers transferable shore power, ideal for those desiring an effortless shift to lakeside living. Accompanying the boat is a 12'4" x 60'4" dock, featuring a shed, PWC port, and a water slide, all built on encapsulated styrofoam flotation with wooden framing and decking.

The houseboat is driven by an 898 MerCruiser 305CID 198HP V8 I/O engine, with unknown hours, and a 7.5KW Kohler generator, which is currently inoperable. Nevertheless, a 2015 Champion 3400/4000Watt air-cooled generator is included, though not depicted in the images. This vessel provides ample sleeping quarters with two bedrooms, including a queen master and a twin over full-size bunk bed, plus two convertible sofas, comfortably accommodating 6-9 guests. The full bathroom is newly outfitted with a marine head, vanity sink, and walk-in shower.

The kitchen is well-equipped with a Magic Chef electric refrigerator/freezer, microwave, Westinghouse 4-burner gas oven/range, and a coffee maker. For alfresco dining, a Charbroil gas grill with a side burner is available. The living area is enhanced with two patio table and chair sets, a front porch sunshade, and a fan. Climate control is maintained with dual roof-mounted air conditioning units, the front unit also offering heat, and a Magnavox 1500Watt infrared heater. Additionally, a free-standing Honeywell 12,000BTU air conditioning unit is included but not shown.

Entertainment amenities include a 40" Philips Roku TV and a 43" TCL Roku TV, paired with a Pioneer AM/FM/CD/Aux input stereo system. The helm is outfitted with gauges for fuel, battery volts, engine temperature, tachometer

with an hour meter, oil pressure, and drive trim, along with a Lowrance 3500 depth finder. A ProMariner dual bank onboard battery charger and a stern davit are also included.

Water access is simplified with a 4-step swim boarding ladder for the houseboat and a 5-step swim boarding ladder on the dock. The houseboat offers generous headroom, with 6'9" in the upper cabin and 6'11" in the lower cabin. It includes a 20-gallon electric water heater, two 50-gallon aluminum fuel tanks, a 185-gallon fresh water capacity, and a 50-gallon plastic waste holding tank. The roof has been gel-coated and rail-mounts elevated in 2024, with the outdrive serviced in 2016 and the engine serviced in 2025.

The dock features a shore power cable, a water slide, an 8' x 10' storage shed, and an 11'7" x 4'10" ShoreMaster ShorePort PWC port, among other amenities. This houseboat is the epitome of comfort, functionality, and style, poised to provide its new owner with a distinctive and delightful experience on the water.


