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## OVERVIEW

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1999 58' SonShip by West Bay — Wavos Rancheros arrives as a thoughtfully modernized, self-sufficient motor yacht, prepared by an experienced owner for true bluewater independence. This 58-foot SonShip, born of West Bay's pedigree, has been painstakingly upgraded and professionally maintained, elevating her pilothouse and flybridge functionality well beyond many vessels in her class.

West Bay, the parent company behind SonShip, is known for stout construction and finish work reminiscent of larger superyachts; Wavos Rancheros bears those hallmarks in every bulkhead and system. Overbuilt mechanicals, meticulous joinery and an array of refined systems are woven through the boat's design, creating a yacht that is as dependable as it is handsome.

A generous aft deck and teak swim platform provide a welcoming first impression. Boarding is made simple by thoughtfully placed handholds and twin pop-up cleats that make tender handling straightforward. Power is modern and redundant: dual 50A shore power cords were recently replaced and are managed by a Glendinning Cablemaster for fast, single-step hookup. The cockpit is protected by a locking fiberglass transom door that affords security underway and prevents unwelcome boardings, while roughly 4' of freeboard contributes to a safe, confidence-inspiring environment for children and pets. Practical comforts include a propane grill and a handy drink refrigerator, while a discreet portside wing/docking station makes lines and fenders easy to manage. A combined staircase and ladder ascends to the flybridge beneath the sheltering bridge overhang, keeping the bridge deck shaded and dry when needed.

Step through the twin opening salon doors—designed to ease the passage of furnishings and provisioning—and you enter a luminous living space. A

U-shaped settee seats six comfortably around a versatile high/low table suited for formal dining or relaxed cocktails; to starboard, two new leather barrel chairs flank a companion table for intimate conversation. Entertainment and service are well thought-out with a U-Line ice maker, dedicated AV storage and a 35" Vizio smart TV paired with a sound bar. Panoramic windows frame the horizon, dressed with custom wood mini-slat blinds, and a dedicated HVAC zone ensures the salon remains temperate whether living aboard full time or cruising to distant anchorages.

A few steps up position the galley and lower helm as the social and operational heart of the yacht. The galley's Corian counters and extensive cabinetry are set beneath sweeping 270-degree views, and the appliance package suits serious cruising: a 4-burner Ceran glass cooktop, Whirlpool oven, Broan trash compactor, GE side-by-side refrigerator, Toshiba microwave and a Frigidaire dishwasher all contribute to a fully capable culinary workspace. The lower helm is arranged for clarity and command, centered on three 16" Furuno NavNet touch-screen MFDs and a Furuno autopilot, supported by a full complement of navigation, sonar, speed and depth instrumentation. Maneuvering and low-visibility operation are enhanced by a Wireless Yacht Controller, an auxiliary spotlight and a night-vision camera, features that underline this yacht's intent as a long-range passagemaker.

Below decks, the accommodation plan supports extended voyages with three well-proportioned staterooms. The full-beam master stateroom provides exceptional storage, including a walk-in closet and a concealed washer/dryer, while the ensuite bath offers a newer Raritan macerating toilet, a Corian countertop with a single-bowl sink and a roomy shower. A centerline queen berth promises restful nights at anchor or underway and the owner benefits from a dedicated HVAC zone for personalized comfort. Midship, the guest cabin offers upper and lower berths with adaptable storage arrangements, and the second head functions as an effective day head and shared guest bath. Forward, the VIP stateroom presents an island queen berth with ample



lockers and its own HVAC, assuring privacy and climate control for family or visitors.

Exterior circulation is effortless: port and starboard sliding doors open to secure side decks that lead fore and aft beneath stout stainless-steel rails. The foredeck is practical and expedition-ready; MarQuipt Tide-Ride boarding stairs are stowed for rapid deployment, and the anchoring system is built for reliability with a 105 lb Mantus anchor riding 250' of 3/8" galvanized chain, hauled and paid out by a brand-new Muir hydraulic windlass for controlled setting and recovery.

Wavos Rancheros embodies West Bay's commitment to durability, comfort and independent operation. Whether crossing offshore miles, exploring rugged coastlines or settling into a quiet anchorage, this Pilothouse Flybridge Motor Yacht delivers the systems, accommodations and peace of mind demanded by long-range, liveaboard cruising. With significant upgrades, attentive maintenance and an arrangement of creature comforts, this 1999 58' SonShip by West Bay is ready for its next ocean-spanning chapter.
