Part luxury motor yacht, part hybrid cruiser, equally at home as a family yacht or a weekend coastal cruiser, it is crafted for modern, conscious yachting.


















DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Description

New factory listing presenting the Azimut Seadeck 6 — MY 2025, the inaugural model of Azimut's first hybrid Series conceived for families and designed to deliver seamless cruising and a pure, barrierless connection to the sea. Embracing a more mindful relationship with nature, Seadeck 6 is the first yacht in the brand's most efficient Series ever, integrating advanced technological solutions that reduce emissions by up to 40% while preserving luxury and performance. At its heart lies a reimagined sea level cockpit lounge that wraps the stern in an open embrace, dissolving the boundary between yacht and ocean and creating what the design intent calls a Fun Island — an unprecedented outdoor living space that fosters limitless contact with the water and enriches every moment on board with an immersive, harmonious natural experience, shaping a lifestyle centered on well being and effortless elegance.

Seadeck 6 – equipment and options list upgrades & base additions

Curated from the factory, this Seadeck 6 arrives with a compelling suite of performance and comfort enhancements, most notably a triple installation of Volvo IPS 650 units, each rated at 480 hp, elevating efficiency and handling with remarkable poise. Practical readiness is evident in the additional set of zincs, an additional socket, and an additional waterproof socket that extend utility where it matters most. The Advance Package layers on thoughtful refinements while the aft cockpit lounge with a convertible sunbed in recycled Libeccio fabric sets a sustainable tone without compromising luxury.

Underway, the Automatic Volvo Interceptor System optimizes running attitude, and carbon poles with safety railing throughout the stern add both visual lightness and reassuring security to the sea level experience.

Optional equipment

Meticulous options elevate life on board, beginning with an automatic cockpit awning and a dedicated co-pilot seat, complemented by cork on side decks and extra cork for enhanced grip and warmth underfoot. Crew comfort is addressed with a crew cabin featuring one bed and air conditioning, while the Décor Upgrade – Thun version and decorative interior cushions – Thun selection refine the ambiance with tailored textures. Daily rituals are effortless thanks to a dishwasher, a docking station with bow thruster control on the side deck, and the dynamic positioning system Skyhook for pinpoint station-keeping. Comfort flows through an electric blackout awning for the salon ceiling, external cushions in Libeccio recycled fabric, and a thoughtful provisioning kit including an extra gallon of gel coat and an extra gallon of paint in Grey Bronze Metallic, with a freezer in the lower deck hallway for extended cruising. The helm and navigation suite is enriched by Garmin AIS 800, a Garmin fishfinder, the Garmin Platinum package, and two Garmin videocameras, delivering awareness and clarity in all conditions. Social spaces flex with a hi-lo and extendable table in the salon and a hi-lo system for the TV in the salon, while styling is elevated by the HT painted central area plus radar arch in Grey Bronze Metallic, painted antennas and accessories on the radar arch in high-gloss black, and a painted boot stripe parallel to the waterline. Practical advantages abound, from a motorized shore power cord reel, Prop speed on the propulsion system, and a proportional bow thruster, to twin refrigerator drawer type units in the cockpit on the port side and starboard side. Outdoor entertaining is effortless with a removable Kenyon grill in the cockpit with support, and privacy is assured by roller blinds with a blackout

system in the master cabin, alongside a safe in the master cabin. Motion comfort is perfected by the Seakeeper stabilizer 9, and thoughtful living is underscored by a set of cooking pans, a set of linens for all cabins except the crew cabin, a set of linens for the crew cabin, and a set of towels with the Azimut logo. Ambience after dark is sublime with a smart audio video package, spreader lights on aft, two underwater lights on sides, and two underwater lights on the transom; ground tackle inspires confidence with a stainless steel anchor 40 kg. Connectivity and exploration are amplified by a Starlink antenna, sunbathing cushions with a foldable backrest on the bow in Libeccio, and a sunshade sail on the bow with removable carbon fiber poles. Shore access and tendering are refined through a telescopic gangway, tender installation and chocks for tender installed, and wood chocks for tender. Textile harmony extends with Thun bedspreads for the master, VIP, and guest cabins in the Rena Iner color, while visibility is maintained with two extra windshield wiper blades. The US Package adapts the yacht to regional standards, and extended autonomy is supported by a washer and dryer combo unit in the lower deck, winch control buttons for anchor and boat control, a wine cooler on the stairs to the lower deck, and warm, durable wooden floors in the lower deck hallway, in the salon, and on the stairs to the lower deck. Completing the ambience, a luxury lighting package for exteriors and a luxury lighting package for interiors set a sophisticated tone throughout.

Features

The onboard experience is anchored by a comprehensive electronics suite that includes a radar detector, multi function plotter, responsive autopilot, clear channel radio, precision GPS, immersive cockpit speakers, a flat screen TV for effortless entertainment, and AIS for enhanced situational awareness. Interior comfort is elevated by Seakeeper stabilization that calms the sea's motion, a convenient microwave oven for quick culinary moments, efficient

heating for shoulder seasons, and a capacious refrigerator to store provisions. Outside, everyday luxury takes shape in a beautifully finished teak cockpit with plush cockpit cushions, a versatile cockpit table for al fresco dining, an easy access swimming ladder, and a hydraulic swim step that brings you gracefully to sea level.

Propulsion

Powering this Seadeck 6 is a confident triad: Engine 1, Engine 2, and Engine 3 are Volvo Penta IPS 650 inboard diesel units, each rated at 480 hp and each showing 180 hours, combining intuitive joystick handling with efficient thrust and impressive range. The triple IPS configuration delivers agile low speed maneuvering, quiet, economical cruising, and the poised acceleration that defines modern Azimut performance.

Specifications

Designed for spirited passages, Seadeck 6 reaches a max speed of 33 kn, with a length overall of 60 ft and a beam of 16.58 ft that opens generous interior volume and expansive outdoor living. The hull is fiberglass, blending strength, efficiency, and refined finish quality. Fresh water, fuel, and holding tank capacities are to factory specification and available upon request, aligning endurance and convenience with the yacht's forward thinking ethos.


