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OVERVIEW

The 2009 Sunseeker Manhattan 60 Seaesta is a finely appointed flybridge motor yacht presented in turnkey condition for private cruising, the result of meticulous ownership and thoughtful specification. She has been honed for straightforward ownership, marrying Sunseeker performance with refined onboard comfort so she is immediately enjoyable at sea or at rest.

Conceived with the owner-operator in mind, Seaesta offers reassuring stability and systems that are intuitive to manage, with an internal layout that allows family and guests to move freely throughout the yacht without congestion. For longer passages or more formal service, a dedicated aft crew cabin with full amenities is discreetly sited to preserve the privacy and flow of the guest areas.

Sleeping six in three well-proportioned staterooms, she features a main-deck salon and galley arranged for effortless living, while the generous flybridge serves both passage-making and alfresco entertaining, creating an elevated social space for cruising. The yacht presents as a carefully maintained example of the model—calm at anchor, composed underway, and equally at home on coastal hops or more ambitious bluewater agendas.

Notable ownership benefits include LLC title and recently completed servicing of both machinery and generator. A full bottom job has been carried out, with new seals, bearings, hydraulic hoses and fresh antifouling applied, the superstructure has been refinished, and the teak decks have been professionally cleaned and sealed—clear evidence of diligent stewardship and a yacht ready to cruise.

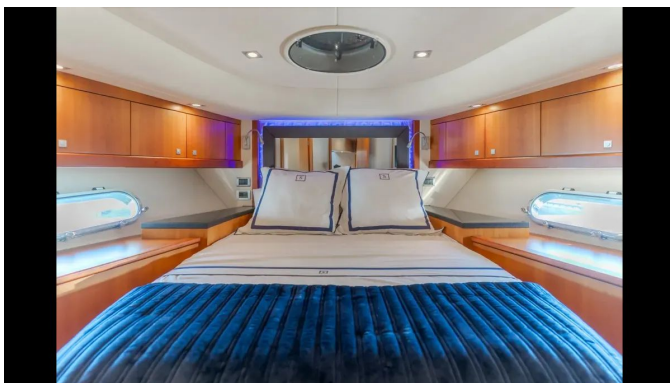
















DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Additional equipment

Meticulously appointed for ultimate comfort and convenience, the yacht boasts a generous Bimini top to create ample shaded areas, while warm teak planking graces the flybridge underfoot. A fully integrated climate-control system supplies both air conditioning and heating to keep the interior comfortable in all conditions. Crew enjoy private aft accommodation with two berths and an independent head, a hydraulic passerelle enables seamless boarding, and an upgraded generator delivers whisper quiet, dependable power both underway and at anchor.

Salon

Step into an elegantly appointed salon where relaxation and entertainment are perfectly balanced: a Sharp 42-inch LCD flatscreen TV rises smoothly on its lift, linked to a high-definition satellite TV receiver and enveloped by a Bose surround sound system. Gentle 24V halogen overhead lighting creates a refined atmosphere above soft carpet runners, while practical luxuries — including a dedicated wine and beverage refrigerator, custom Sunseeker glass stemware kept in its designated storage cabinet, and ample storage cabinets — ensure every item is beautifully stored and ready for use.

Galley

A refined workspace designed for both function and style, the galley centers on a large stainless-steel sink accented by a handrail wrapped in chocolate brown leather to ensure secure movement while underway. Cold provisions are accommodated by a Vitrifrigo stainless-steel upright refrigerator that features

dedicated refrigerator and freezer drawers, while meal preparation is effortless thanks to a Sharp Carousel Grill 2 microwave/convection oven and a Plastimo electric three-burner stovetop. Two opening portholes welcome natural light and fresh air into the space, and dimmer switches on the interior lighting allow you to set the mood with subtlety. Luxurious finishes include cherry high-gloss wood trash bin and sink cover lids, and storage is generous throughout, with ample cabinetry and a dedicated utensil drawer to keep everything neatly organized.

Master stateroom

A sumptuous king-size bed is showcased beneath 24V halogen overhead lighting and accompanied by two 24V reading lights, while natural illumination streams through two large opening portholes and four fixed portholes, each dressed with blinds. Entertainment is discreetly elegant with a Sharp flatscreen TV paired to a satellite TV receiver and an Alpine DVA-9861 DVD player. Refined furnishings include a dedicated master stateroom entry credenza, bedside end tables with drawers below and a cedar-lined hanging locker, and valuables are kept secure in a two-brick safe with a digital lock.

VIP stateroom

The VIP stateroom is centered on an island queen berth with convenient drawer storage beneath, bathed in the warm glow of 24V halogen overhead lights and complemented by two dedicated reading lights for tranquil evening moments; daylight and fresh sea air enter through two opening portholes and an overhead deck hatch fitted with a screen, while adjustable blinds provide instant privacy. Entertainment is elegantly arranged with an Alpine DVA-9861 DVD player paired to a Sharp flat-screen TV and satellite TV receiver, and cedar-lined hanging lockers to port and starboard ensure garments remain

fresh and impeccably stored.

Guest stateroom

Designed for refined comfort and practical ease, the guest stateroom presents twin single berths with generous under-berth storage to keep luggage and personal items neatly out of sight. Soft ambient illumination is supplied by 24V halogen overhead lights, while two dedicated reading lights provide focused lighting for evening relaxation. Entertainment is provided by a Sharp flat screen TV accompanied by an Alpine DVA-9861 DVD player, and a full hanging locker offers generous wardrobe capacity. Discreet blinds ensure privacy and controlled daylight, resulting in a serene and well-appointed retreat for guests.

Flybridge

Purposefully configured for elegant open-air living, the flybridge features a Gaganeau electric BBQ grill and a streamlined fiberglass table that make alfresco entertaining effortless. A custom acrylic flybridge deck hatch, tinted to temper the sun, allows generous daylight while maintaining a comfortable atmosphere, and the flybridge stereo provides immersive sound that fills the area. All exterior sun pads and seating are constructed with reticulated foam for superior comfort and rapid drying, and bespoke covers protect the flybridge seating, sun pad and helm when the day concludes. A Raritan ice maker ensures drinks remain perfectly chilled beneath a navy blue canvas Bimini top, mounted on a stainless steel framework that offers lasting shade and refined durability.

Lower helm

The lower helm delivers confident, intuitive control anchored by a Raymarine

autopilot paired with two Raymarine Axiom color radar chart plotters that provide crisp radar imaging and navigation detail, ensuring exceptional situational awareness. Maneuvering in tight quarters is made effortless by Side-Power bow and stern thrusters, while dedicated trim tab controls allow precise adjustment of the vessel's running attitude for refined performance. A remotely controlled searchlight enhances safety during night and limited-visibility passages, and the Sea Fire Monitoring System maintains continuous oversight of onboard safety systems. Key engine performance and diagnostic information are presented on MAN engine monitors for clear, immediate interpretation, with a Ritchie compass offering a reliable magnetic heading reference.

Engine room

Impeccably cared for, the machinery space is anchored by twin MAN 900 CRM diesel engines, registered at 950 hours on April 23, 2021, providing assured and composed propulsion, while a Kohler 15.0 Kw generator, logged at 1700 hours on April 23, 2021, delivers dependable electrical support. Every detail reflects considered craftsmanship, from the bespoke shelf crafted to stow the toolbox to the bright, service-oriented lighting that makes inspections and servicing effortless. A curated inventory of spare parts and filters is kept onboard to streamline routine upkeep, and a dedicated fire suppression system combined with efficient engine room blowers ensures a safe, well-ventilated environment. The result is a pristine, expertly organized engine room that marries operational readiness with refined attention to detail.

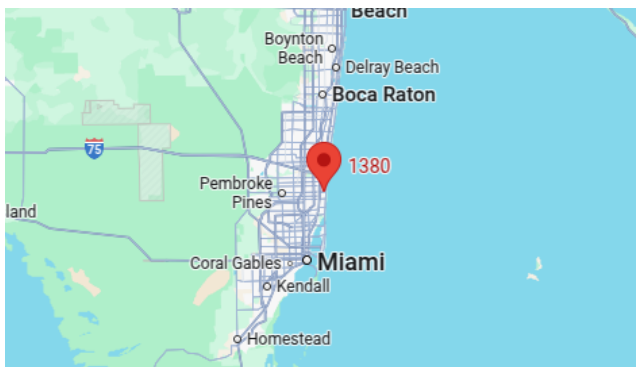
