## OVERVIEW

---

A 60-foot, custom cold-molded luxury sportfisher from 1998, built in the United States and conceived for true blue water roaming, this yacht pairs classical lines with the stout, nimble character that experienced skippers seek. Her sweeping 17-foot beam grants an authoritative profile and exceptional interior volume, while the cold molded hull and deck deliver a refined, solid passage—quiet underfoot, warm to the touch, and steadfast in a seaway.

Power comes from twin Caterpillar inboard diesels installed amidships, providing the dependable torque and long range efficiency synonymous with the marque. A substantial 1,500 gallon fuel capacity supports extended cruises and consecutive tournament days, and a 250 gallon freshwater reserve ensures onboard autonomy and comfort. Whether pursuing distant horizons or trailing billfish, she responds with poised range and satisfying throttle authority.

Boarding reveals a broad, uncluttered cockpit designed for the demands of serious anglers and active families alike: work ready, easy to move around in, and laid out to rig, fish, or entertain without compromise. The cold molded deck beneath your feet underscores the custom nature of the construction—quiet, solid, and confidence inspiring. From the helm, visibility is exceptional, the controls sit intuitively to hand, and the boat tracks predictably while delivering crisp turns and an athletic balance between performance and seakeeping.

Below, the salon welcomes with warm, handcrafted joinery and a thoughtful arrangement that invites lingering evenings and easy conversation. Natural light bathes the interior, blurring the line between sea and sanctuary. A well appointed galley functions as the social center, while the accommodations below are laid out to host family and guests with comfort—ample storage, thoughtfully configured heads, and tasteful finishes

create a living space meant for quiet mornings at anchor and lively celebrations after a perfect day offshore.

As a custom build with the stamina to match, this 1998 classic represents a rare opportunity: a true bluewater performer with elegant proportions, durable materials, and an inviting, upscale demeanor. Lying in the United States and poised to impress, she is equally at ease cruising refined coastal waters or charging into the canyons during tournament season.

# DETAILED DESCRIPTION

## Broker remarks

---

New to the market, ROSE arrives with the promise of fresh opportunity, with additional photos coming soon to showcase her presence, and she is thoughtfully arranged in a three-stateroom, three-head layout that balances comfort and function for extended cruising and serious fishing alike. Long regarded as one of the finest-riding boats to emerge from the family yard, she is powered by Caterpillar 3412 engines that deliver economical operation, generous range, and renowned reliability, and celebrated as a fish-raising masterpiece, ROSE pairs proven performance with pedigreed build quality to satisfy discerning anglers and cruisers in equal measure.

## Salon

---

Welcomed through centerline double salon doors, the salon unfolds as a refined gathering space anchored by a hi-lo coffee table and an L-shaped sofa with hidden storage, while two barrel chairs provide additional seating opposite a pop-up Samsung TV and a Sony stereo system that integrates with an installed Savant/Sonos music system for rich, customizable entertainment. A SAT phone handset stands ready for offshore communication, the electrical panel is discreetly placed for easy service, overhead handrails lend secure movement underway, an ice machine keeps refreshments perfectly chilled, and liquor storage completes a salon that is both inviting and thoroughly equipped.

## Galley

---

Designed for effortless provisioning and culinary ease, the galley features a GE

upright refrigerator and freezer, a Nutone food center, and an Insta Hot hot water dispenser set into a seamless Corian countertop, while the teak and ash sole adds classic warmth beneath a Princess oven and matching Princess cooktop complemented by a GE microwave and a practical garbage disposal, ensuring every element is poised for reliable service whether hosting dockside or far offshore.

## Dining

---

Opposite the galley, a Corian dinette table is framed by U-shaped seating for four, with generous storage concealed beneath the dinette to keep the space uncluttered and ready for lingering meals or chart work.

## Master stateroom

---

The master stateroom offers a tapered queen berth with substantial storage below, flanked by end tables with drawer storage and illuminated by refined reading lamps, while a mirrored vanity enhances light and space, an Insignia TV provides private entertainment, and a hanging locker with port lights completes a serene, functional retreat.

## Master head

---

Thoughtfully finished, the master head features a mirrored head, Corian countertops, and a handsome ash and teak sole, where a stall shower provides true home-style comfort, complemented by a Dometic head installed in 2022 and a brightening port light.

## Guest stateroom-starboard

---

On the starboard side, upper and lower berths create flexible sleeping for

guests, paired with a credenza offering drawer storage and a full hanging locker, while reading lamps warm the space, a Vizio TV and a stereo speaker provide entertainment, private access to the guest head ensures convenience, and port lights bring in natural light.

## Guest stateroom-forward

---

Forward, the guest stateroom mirrors the practical arrangement with upper and lower berths and a credenza with drawer storage, complemented by a hanging locker, stereo speakers and dedicated reading lights set the tone, there is direct access to the rope locker for utility, and private access to the guest head for comfort.

## Guest head

---

The guest head is appointed with a mirrored medicine cabinet, Corian countertops, and a stall shower, set over an ash and teak sole, while a Dometic head installed in 2022 and port lights round out a bright, practical space.

## Day head-starboard

---

Conveniently placed on the starboard side, the day head combines utility with comfort: a Kenmore laundry center, a vanity with storage, and a stall shower, all set over an ash and teak sole and complemented by a Dometic head installed in 2022.

## Flybridge

---

The flybridge is outfitted for command and sport, with two Bluewater helm chairs facing CAT engine gauges and four Miya Epoch 9/0 teaser reels set in a molded-in box, while an air outlet with quick disconnect adds practicality and

Rupp 44 outriggers, an aft rail rocket launcher, and generous rod storage speak to serious intent; communications and entertainment include SeaTel SAT TV, a SAT phone by KVH and a hybrid phone system guided by a Ritchie compass, while overhead lights molded into the hardtop include four white and two red lamps supported by two aft spreader lights and one forward spreader light, and a refrigerated drink box with a Blue Water back rest enhances comfort between bites.

## **Electronics/navigational equipment**

---

Connectivity and clarity come standard with Starlink paired to a Furuno NAV Pilot and a Furuno 96 radar, and the helm is anchored by one Furuno TZT nine-inch monitor and two Furuno TZT sixteen-inch monitors complemented by a Furuno FI-50, a Fusion radio, and comprehensive GPS/plotter/sounders, while weather and audio are covered by a Sirius weather system and Sirius SAT radio and communications are assured by a Sea 156 VHF radio and two Horizon Spectrum VHF units, with a Dytex ST500 water temperature display and remote speakers rounding out a capable, redundant suite.

## **Tower**

---

A Bausch American Tuna Tower crowns the profile with full steering and controls at the top, while Kahlenberg air horns announce your presence and 110-volt forward and aft spreader lights and molded-in running lights extend the day; a molded-in teaser reel box keeps the cockpit organized, and a fresh water spigot and a Sea VHF radio complete a tower designed for precision sighting and fast decisions.

## Cockpit

---

Purpose-built for action, the cockpit features a teak sole and teak covering boards, with an in-floor refrigerated fish box with macerator paired to an in-floor live well, while a transom door eases landing and six clearing rod holders on the tower legs keep gear at the ready; gaff lockers stand by and kite reel plugs on the flybridge and an LP deep drop reel plug expand tactics, while fresh and salt water washdowns and a fresh water inlet make cleanup simple. Two 50 amp shore cords, a phone and cable inlet, and stereo speakers add utility, as do a Blue Water chair with rocket launcher, a tackle center, a rigging station, a bait freezer, a swim ladder, and a cockpit cover to protect the whole stage.

## Fishing equipment

---

The spread is formidable, with Rupp 44' Big Gun outriggers and two sets of teasers supporting live bait tactics from a dedicated live bait well, while a refrigerated fish box preserves the catch and both a tuna door and a transom door streamline the action at boatside.

## Deck/hull equipment

---

Classic teak detailing defines the exterior with a teak deck, teak covering boards, a teak transom, and a teak toe rail, while practical features include a swim ladder, trim tabs, and hull port lights, and a removable davit, a bow pulpit with winch, and a bow thruster deliver capability and confidence when handling the boat in any harbor.

## Engine/mechanical equipment

---

Power comes from CAT 3412 engines rated at 1350 HP with 450 hrs SMOH, supported by Cruise Air AC from June 2019 and dual AC pumps to keep the interior temperate, while Glendenning controls installed in 2022 and a Dolphin battery charger from 2025 speak to thoughtful updates. Dripless shaft logs, Racor fuel filters, fuel sight tubes, and a fuel transfer system serving forward and aft tanks underpin reliability, as do dual power steering pumps, an oil change system, and trolling valves. Ship's power is robust with two Kilopak 21 kW generators and dedicated Gen Racor filters, while freshwater systems include two Head Hunter water pumps and a Raritan water heater. A Watermaker, Inc. water maker space membranes package, an engine room AC unit, a sub electrical panel, DC engine room lighting, and a comprehensive fire suppression system complete a machinery space built for endurance and ease of service.
