Step into the expansive salon and open galley to discover lustrous, high-gloss cherry joinery paired with custom granite accents, a testament to classic Hatteras workmanship. The elegant interior is thoughtfully arranged with a three-stateroom, three-head layout that suits owners and guests who divide their time between cruising, offshore fishing, and relaxed entertaining. Celebrated for sturdy construction and an exceptionally composed ride, this luxury motor yacht provides a refined experience underway. Twin Caterpillar C-32A engines deliver an efficient 30-knot cruise at an approximate 105 GPH burn, while a reported draft of 4'10" broadens access to varied cruising grounds. A tournament-ready flybridge, convertible design, and clear sportfisherman pedigree complete a versatile and sophisticated package for serious anglers and discerning cruisers alike.

## DETAILED DESCRIPTION

---

### A must see!!!

---

Preliminary listing. Evermore is a finely outfitted, captain maintained, Caterpillar powered Hatteras GT that immediately conveys the hallmark Hatteras blend of strength, speed, and sumptuous finish. Step into a spacious salon flowing into the galley and you're met by deep, high gloss cherry veneers and custom granite surfaces that radiate warmth and craftsmanship. Below, three generous staterooms and three heads make hosting owners and guests effortless, whether the day calls for cruising, chasing pelagics, or simply savoring time aboard. The ride is quintessential Hatteras—quietly confident and remarkably comfortable—while the Caterpillar C 32 A engines deliver an easy cruise of 30 knots at 78 GPH, with a reported draft of 4' 8". Highlights include a cherry interior and granite countertops, Caterpillar C 32 power, a hydraulic bow thruster, a full Garmin electronics suite, Furuno Sonar CH 500 Lighthouse, FLIR night vision, mezzanine seating, and teak decks with teak covering boards.

### Layout

---

A remarkably spacious three stateroom, three head layout grants every guest privacy and comfort: the owner's queen stateroom lies to port, the forward VIP features large sixty/forty split berths configured over under, and the starboard bunkroom completes the trio, with each cabin enjoying en suite access.

### Salon

---

Enter a refined, beautifully appointed salon where high gloss cherry joinery

sets a rich, welcoming tone of quality and comfort. A J/R Beer's power door and a teak and holly landing make arrival effortless and elegant, while the starboard electrical panel keeps ship systems at your fingertips. An L-shaped settee with hidden storage faces a teak square table with its own stowage, all set atop plush carpeting with protective runners. Frameless, dark-tinted windows and air conditioning discreetly diffused through the valances preserve clean lines and serene climate control, complemented by Hunter Douglas blinds. Entertainment centers on a 48-inch smart television on a lift, a Bose surround sound system with Boston Acoustics speakers, satellite receiver, and a Wave WiFi booster, with the headliner refreshed in 2019 and a Whisper Wall system installed throughout the vessel the same year. LED lighting on both AC and DC circuits sets the mood, and a Whirlpool ice maker and dedicated bar storage complete this sophisticated gathering space.

## Galley

---

The U-shaped galley to port is perfectly paired with a comfortable L-shaped dinette to starboard seating five, all finished in high-gloss cherry cabinetry and upgraded with granite counters and backsplash in 2019. A stainless sink, Sub-Zero six-drawer refrigeration, GE Profile four-burner cooktop, and GE convection microwave make gourmet preparation a pleasure, while a disposal, Amtico teak and holly sole, and LED lighting underscore practical elegance.

## Companionway

---

The companionway is lined with soft panel walls punctuated by custom teak accent strips, creating a hushed, tailored passage. Attic storage maximizes capacity, padded walls and carpeting soften every step, and a GE washer and dryer add true liveaboard convenience, with LED lighting and a secure handrail guiding the way.

---

## Owners stateroom

---

Tucked aft to port, the owner's retreat features a queen berth aligned fore and aft with generous storage beneath, set against a mirrored bulkhead. Two lighted end tables and two hanging lockers complement ample drawer stowage, while carpeting, LED lighting, cherry veneers, and designer soft goods refine the ambiance. GFI outlets and a dedicated television add thoughtful convenience. The en suite head offers a vanity with storage, a flush mounted sink, a lighted mirror, a Vacu Flush fixture, and a shower with a door, all set on an Amtico sole.

---

## VIP forward

---

The forward VIP presents large sixty/forty split berths in an over under configuration, blending flexibility and comfort. A single hanging locker, dedicated drawer storage, carpeting, LED lighting, cherry veneers, designer soft goods, and a GFI outlet complete the space. Its en suite head features a vanity with storage, a flush mounted sink, a lighted mirror, a Vacu Flush fixture, and a shower with a door atop an Amtico sole.

---

## Bunkroom

---

The starboard stateroom is a versatile bunkroom with over under double berths, a single hanging locker, and ample drawer storage, finished with carpeting, LED lighting, cherry veneers, and designer soft goods, plus GFI outlets and a television. Its adjacent head serves as the day head, providing shared access to a vanity with storage, flush mounted sink, lighted mirror, Vacu Flush fixture, and a shower with a door over an Amtico sole.

## Flybridge

---

The flybridge centers on a faux teak helm pod with two Release teak helm chairs, a stainless steering wheel, and Palm Beach shifters, with bow thruster control at hand. Generous seating with storage sits behind a three sided enclosure with plush cushions, while a belly band with rod holders, brow storage, a storage rich console, and a secure handrail enhance utility. Teaser reels stand ready above twenty four volt dredge outlets, aided by a FLIR camera, LED spreader and overhead lighting, closed circuit TV, and a fresh water washdown.

## Electronics and navigation:

---

An actuated electronics compartment reveals a comprehensive Garmin suite anchored by three Garmin screens, a Garmin sounder, and Garmin radar, complemented by a Furuno Sonar CH 500 Lighthouse and a Furuno sounder. Night passages benefit from FLIR night vision, precise GPS, two I com VHF radios, and five cameras covering critical angles. Up in the tower, LED spreader lights, a Ritchie compass, Furuno NavNet 3D, and an I Com VHF extend command and awareness. For entertainment, the salon features an LG television, with additional televisions in the master, VIP, and bunkroom, a KVH TV antenna (one), a Bose surround sound stereo system alongside the ship's stereo, and Direct TV boxes to bring favorite programming aboard.

## Cockpit

---

The tournament ready cockpit features mezzanine seating with custom refrigeration and abundant storage, plus direct access to the engine room. A transom door, hawse pipes, teak covering boards, and a teak deck pair with stainless hardware for rugged refinement. Practical touches include a

refrigerated drink box, a starboard ice dump, a step with storage, courtesy lighting, secure handrails, and a deep freezer—everything placed for seamless action.

## Engine room

---

Beautifully faired and painted, the engine room reflects meticulous care. Power comes from Caterpillar C32 A engines rated at 1800 HP, with the port engine serial T3T00126 showing 3404 hours and the starboard engine serial T3T00128 showing 1136 hours. Twin Disc transmissions, model MGX 6599A, carry port serial 9A3491 and starboard serial 9A2444. Ship's power is supported by two Onan diesel marine generator sets, each 21 kW, with serials C130470472 and NEW ON ORDER. Mechanical excellence continues with trolling valves, Sea Star steering, Bennett trim tabs, a Sea Fire Clean fire suppression system, a Glendening power cord retractor (one), Delta T engine room fans, a toolbox, an oil change system, fresh water washdown, and dripless shaft and rudder seals.

## Mechanical

---

On deck and hull, purposeful detailing meets classic materials: a robust bow rail and a teak pulpit with a stainless guard lead the way, while teak covering boards and a teak cockpit deck frame the working arena. Maneuvering is effortless with a hydraulic ABT bow thruster and a Maxwell 24 V windlass. Ground tackle includes one stainless steel Max plow anchor on 300 feet of 3/8 inch chain, plus one Danforth anchor. Five fresh water washdowns stand ready, joined by four tri-color underwater lights and one underwater camera, with Bennett trim tabs refining the ride.

## Fishing

---

Anglers will appreciate a Furuno Sonar CH 500 Lighthouse, a Murray Brothers teak fighting chair rated to 130 class, and a matching teak rocket launcher. Livewell systems include two livewell outlets with drains and two Hooker livewell pumps feeding tuna tubes, while in deck fish boxes with two macerator pumps swallow the day's catch. Multiple rod holders, two hydraulic outriggers, a center rigger, two Miya Epoch US 9 teaser reels, and two twenty four volt outlets bring true tournament capability.

## Electrical

---

The electrical system is centered on a custom lighted main panel and twin 50 Amp 240 VAC shore power connections. Ship and engine needs are met by 12 VDC systems, with ten AGM marine batteries installed in 2023 housed in custom battery boxes, and charging handled by two 60 Amp battery chargers.
