OVERVIEW

The 2002 Viking 61 Convertible Bolita Too combines twin MTU engines rated at 1,485 horsepower each with a Seakeeper SK16 gyro stabilizer to produce a remarkably steady bluewater platform. Thoughtful upgrades throughout the vessel enhance her readiness for serious offshore use, including a newly installed teak cockpit sole, Rupp outriggers, Veem five-blade propellers, fresh Odyssey batteries and a full Garmin/Furuno electronics package, presenting a truly turnkey convertible sportfisher.

Her interior is arranged in a three-stateroom, three-head configuration that balances privacy and luxury for extended passages or weekend escapes. High-gloss teak joinery surrounds an expansive salon where ample seating and a well-appointed galley create an inviting, polished atmosphere. The owner's stateroom features a queen berth and private ensuite, while the VIP and guest cabins provide tranquil accommodations for crew or guests after a day on the water.

Aft, the cockpit has been outfitted for tournament performance with mezzanine seating incorporating refrigeration, multiple freezers, tuna tubes, a transom fish box and a Murray Brothers fighting chair, all arranged for efficient fish handling. Up top, the flybridge delivers exceptional sightlines and comfort for long runs, with premium navigation and fish-finding electronics, integrated teaser reels and supportive helm seating to keep anglers and captain comfortable during full days of trolling.

Located in the premier sportfishing port of Quepos, Costa Rica, Bolita Too represents a rare opportunity to own a proven Viking convertible that is as capable in tournament conditions as she is refined for cruising. Meticulously maintained and comprehensively outfitted, she is ready for her next offshore adventure. The tender is excluded from the offering and does not convey with the sale.

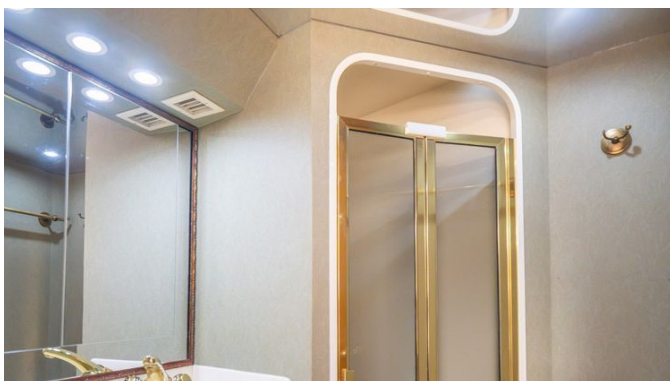


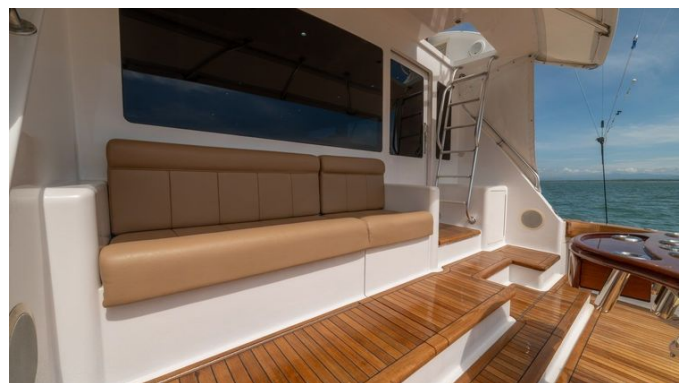


















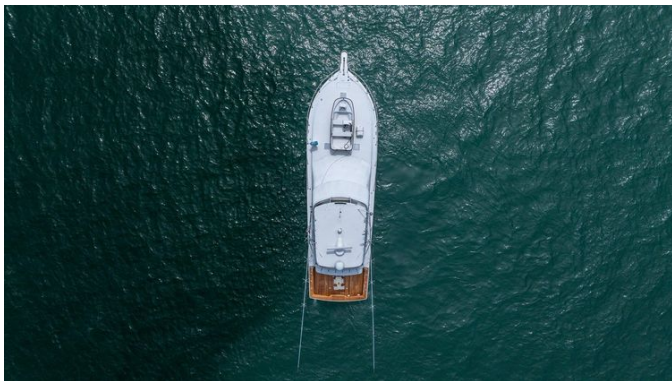












DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Recent upgrades

In 2026 the cockpit was renewed with a fine teak sole and the propulsion package was upgraded with Veem five-blade propellers alongside eight new Odyssey batteries, improvements that together sharpen performance and enhance onboard reliability. Earlier, in 2023, the yacht received new Rupp riggers to extend her offshore capabilities, and stability has been further perfected with the addition of a Seakeeper SK16 gyro, resulting in a noticeably smoother, more composed ride.

Upgraded electronics 2022

Refit in 2022, the yacht's helm and entertainment areas were treated to a comprehensive electronics renewal centered on Starlink high speed connectivity and a sumptuous JL Audio sound system, with additional JL Audio speakers extending the sonic palette throughout the vessel. Navigation and fish finding accuracy are assured by a Simrad AP28 autopilot working alongside a Garmin GSD26 sounder and a Furuno CH500 sonar, while situational awareness is elevated by a Furuno TZT 13X Touch radar and GPS suite integrated with Garmin Electronics GPS Map 8610 and 8617. Reliable, crystal clear communications are provided by an Icom VHF Marine IC M506 together with an Icom IC M502 VHF radio, completing a helm configuration conceived to inspire confidence offshore.

Galley

The galley is appointed for seamless entertaining, featuring a Bosch cooktop paired with a Sharp microwave/convection oven, an ice maker and a stainless

steel sink. Extensive cold storage is provided by four SubZero drawer refrigerators and two SubZero drawer freezers. A dinette table with wraparound seating creates an inviting area for relaxed meals and conversation, while a Kenmore trash compactor and a garbage disposal simplify cleanup. Teak-and-holly vinyl flooring and a headliner replaced in 2020 contribute a fresh, contemporary atmosphere, and a dedicated subpanel keeps onboard systems organized and within easy reach.

Salon

Inside the salon, gleaming high-gloss teakwork bathes the space in a warm, refined glow while plush carpet underfoot heightens the feeling of comfort. A generous U-shaped sofa surrounds an elegant coffee table, perfectly sited for unobstructed viewing of the Sony 48-inch flat TV Bravo, and media is handled effortlessly by a Denon Entertainment center complemented by a Samsung Blu-Ray player and a Sky satellite box. Chilled beverages are on hand thanks to the Edge Star Ice Maker, and climate and atmosphere are precisely adjusted via CruisAir A/C controls. Vessel systems are neatly consolidated in an upright electrical panel, a GPS Monitor supplies instant navigational readouts, and a salon door provides a seamless step out to the deck—together creating an inviting setting tailored to convivial gatherings and refined cruising.

Companionway

An elegantly appointed companionway provides effortless passage to every owner and guest stateroom, with custom-crafted steps and a luxurious carpet underfoot that transform the descent into an experience. Practicality is discreetly integrated: an onboard Krib Bling washer paired with a Kenmore dryer delivers true laundry convenience for extended passages, and dedicated bilge access allows swift inspections and straightforward maintenance so

systems can be checked with confidence.

Master stateroom

Step into an elegant private suite centered on a queen berth framed by a sophisticated headboard, where every detail has been considered to ensure a luxurious and comfortable stay. Two double-door closets with mirrored fronts offer ample hanging capacity and built-in rod storage, while plentiful cabinets keep personal effects neatly stowed and out of sight. Entertainment is first-rate with a Samsung TV paired with a JVC KD-SX850 stereo with CD and a Hitachi DVD and VCR combo, all delivered through clear overhead speakers. Climate is easily controlled via the CruisAir air-conditioning control, and a deck hatch fitted with a blackout screen lets you choose between gentle daylight or total darkness. Plush carpeting cushions your steps and private access to the head completes this serene, well-appointed retreat.

Master head

The master head is luxuriously finished with a Corian sink and countertop harmonized by a Grohe faucet, while a dedicated towel ring together with towel rods and hooks keep linens and essentials neatly organized and within easy reach. A Dometic Vacuflush head supplies dependable sanitation, and the fiberglass shower stall with an integrated seat provides safe, comfortable bathing underway. Clever storage is concealed behind the mirror and a full-length linen closet with a mirrored door offers generous stowage, while a mirrored ceiling amplifies light and the sense of space. Bright, energy-efficient LED lighting completes this refined, highly functional suite.

Forward VIP room

Nestled at the bow, the VIP cabin features over-under oversized bunks, each with practical drawers beneath to maximize storage without compromising living space. An overhead deck hatch fills the room with natural light and allows cool sea breezes to circulate, while a hanging locker provides orderly storage for garments on extended cruises. Privacy is assured by a private ensuite head, and a mirror on the forward bulkhead enhances the sense of space and understated elegance. Climate is quietly and efficiently regulated by CruisAir A/C, delivering comfort throughout every season.

Forward VIP head

The forward VIP head features a lustrous Corian countertop paired with an elegant Grohe faucet, set against a mirrored vanity and mirrored ceiling that reflect and amplify the soft warmth of energy-efficient LED lighting. A Dometic Vacuflush head delivers reliable, hygienic performance, while a dedicated fiberglass shower stall affords enhanced comfort and privacy. Discreet conveniences such as a towel ring and hidden storage beneath the sink complete this impeccably appointed space.

Guest room

Elegantly arranged for comfort and privacy, the guest room features two twin berths and plush carpeting beneath your feet. Personal belongings are kept orderly in a hanging locker with additional storage space, while gentle daylight filters through a deck hatch fitted with a blackout shade to allow bright, airy mornings or fully darkened, restful nights. Guests benefit from direct private access to the head for discretion and convenience, and a dedicated 110V outlet ensures essential devices remain powered.

Guest head

Elegantly finished for comfort and convenience, the guest head features a Corian sink and matching countertop paired with a Grohe faucet, all softly illuminated by integrated LED lighting. Direct access from the companion way makes the space exceptionally convenient to use, while considered details such as a towel hook, ling, and rod keep toiletries and linens neatly arranged. A Dometic Vacuflush head provides dependable operation, and the fiberglass shower stall offers a bright, low-maintenance setting for leisurely refreshment.

Cockpit

The cockpit, laid in sumptuous teak, marries tournament-grade functionality with refined comfort. A mezzanine lounge, cooled by its own dedicated mezzanine air conditioning system and oriented to take in every moment of the action, is served by a refrigerated drink box for immediate refreshment. A transom door provides seamless boarding and working access, while a transom fish box and livewell preserve catch and bait with meticulous care. For extended days at sea there is an in-deck ice bin alongside two freezers to handle serious provisioning. Dominating the well, a Murray Brothers fighting chair provides the focal point for angling pursuits, augmented by a Pomponette rocket launcher for rapid spread adjustments, and in-deck tuna tubes keep lively baits ready whenever needed.

Flybridge

From the elevated flybridge you settle into Murray Brothers helm chairs and preside over a sculpted helm pod fitted with single-lever controls and MTU displays within easy view. Built for tournament performance, the station is equipped with Miya Epoch teaser reels and an upgraded bow thruster control

for confident close-quarters handling. A 50-inch LED light bar provides powerful night illumination while a dedicated Seakeeper display keeps stabilization status instantly visible. Thoughtful conveniences complete the space, including a large freezer for extended passages and a full canvas helm cover to protect the station when not in use.

Engine room and electrical

Within a purposefully arranged and immaculate machinery space, twin MTU M90 12V2000 engines deliver decisive, yacht-grade power, supported by twin Cummins Onan 21KW generators that provide reliable, redundant ship's electrical supply. Extended cruising capability is assured by an FCI Water Maker paired with a Raritan 1700 Series Marine Water Heater, while a Reverso fuel priming pump and Racor fuel and water separator keep fuel and fluids impeccably conditioned for confident operation. The vessel's electrical systems are expertly managed by a Dolphin Pro 24.60 Battery Charger, augmented by a fresh water pump and two 110V GFI outlets for convenient service access. Rounding out the fit-out for serious fishing and guest comfort, an Eskimo Ice Maker and a Pentair 1.5HP pump dedicated to the tuna tubes and livewell complete this robust specification.

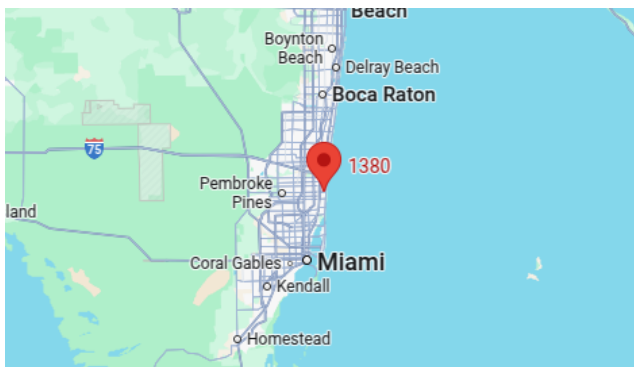
