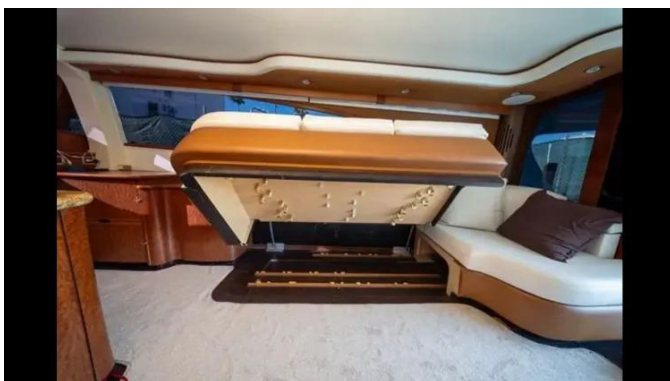


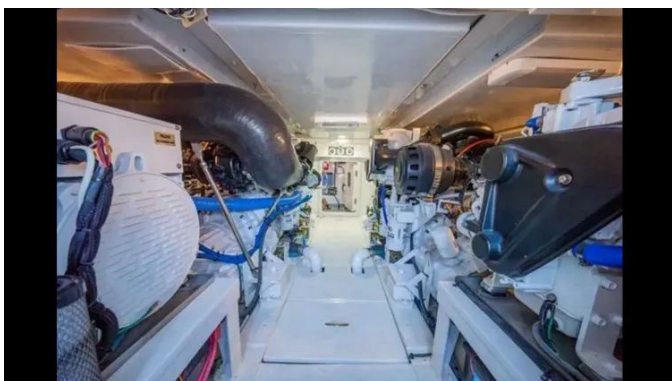




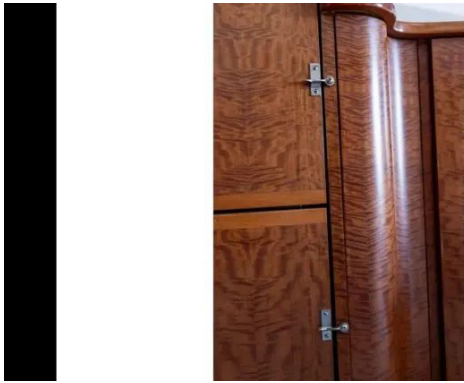












DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Description

This striking sixty-one-foot Garlington, originally built in 1997 and brought to peak condition through comprehensive refits in 2022 and 2025, embodies the apex of custom sportfish craftsmanship. With new engines, state-of-the-art electronics, fresh teak throughout, a refreshed interior, new generators, newly installed SeaKeeper stabilizers and a curated suite of premium upgrades, this yacht is offered truly turn-key and tournament ready, delivering the poise, speed and finish demanded by serious anglers and discerning cruisers alike.

Other details

The 2022 refit established a robust bluewater backbone, installing a high-capacity water maker, two eight-ton chillers and all-new AC pumps to deliver reliable, climate-controlled comfort, while propulsion was modernized with new Caterpillar C18 engines that carry warranty through March 2027 and show 500 hours. The helm was elevated with twin twenty-four-inch Garmin displays, a new stereo with speakers, a new VHF antenna and a protective Iceglass enclosure, and offshore communications and awareness were transformed by the addition of Starlink and FLIR night vision. Deck and systems improvements included a new anchor windlass, replacement of bilge pumps and diesel lines, and the installation of a diesel polishing and fuel transfer system, while electrical independence is assured by two twenty-seven-kilowatt Phaser/Kubota generators showing 300 hours, and the interior received new upholstery to complete the refresh. The 2025 upgrade cycle refined performance and finish with fresh bottom paint and PropSpeed on running surfaces, the addition of a Garmin camera and an extra Garmin unit for enhanced situational awareness, and the installation of two new

SeaKeeper units carrying a Platinum Warranty through 2030 and registering zero hours. Exterior social zones shine with new mezzanine teak, new teak paint, newly varnished teak completed in 2025 and a new bow rub rail installed in 2025, while onboard comfort was further refined with new cushions and interior fabrics, new rugs and curtains, new AC blowers, updated lighting and a freshly repainted fighting chair. Daily life aboard is enriched by an ice maker and an Eskimo Ice Chipper producing five hundred pounds per day, cockpit seating cooled by dedicated air conditioning, the precision of an electric bow thruster, and a chef pleasing Gaggenau cockpit BBQ. Purpose-built fishability is underlined by Rupp outriggers, a Bluewater fighting chair and a sweeping three-hundred sixty-degree salon view that brings the seascape to every gathering. Propulsion

Power is provided by Caterpillar C18 engines installed in 2022, delivering a combined output of 1175 horsepower with 500 hours recorded; the installation is inboard with a stern drive configuration and the engines run on diesel fuel.

Specifications

She confidently cruises at thirty knots and reaches a maximum speed of thirty-five knots, with a hull length overall of sixty-one feet and a length on deck of sixty-one feet. The yacht has a maximum bridge clearance of thirty-five feet, a maximum draft of five feet and a minimum draft of 4.67 feet, freeboard

of 8.25 feet, a beam of eighteen feet and generous seven feet of cabin headroom. Dry weight is sixty-eight thousand pounds, the hull is fiberglass with a fifty-nine-degree deadrise at the transom, and tankage includes 250 gallons of fresh water, 1480 gallons of fuel and a 50 gallon holding tank. Accommodations include three guest cabins and three guest heads to comfortably welcome family, crew and tournament teams.

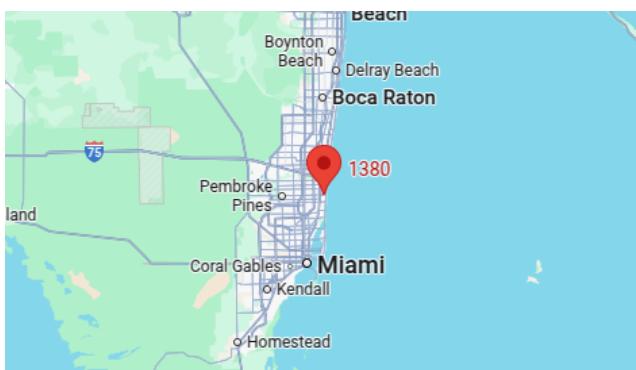
