Balanced between spirited performance and gracious accommodation, she unfolds naturally from sociable exterior entertaining areas to a luminous, finely finished salon—perfect for long weekends or elegant nights at anchor.

Step aboard to find a warm, contemporary interior where superior joinery, expansive glazing, and carefully considered lighting converge to form a welcoming retreat. The main salon invites relaxed lounging and flows openly to a well-equipped galley and dining area, creating an ideal environment for hosting with ease. Below decks, multiple staterooms are serviced by a rare four-head layout that enhances privacy and convenience for family and guests. Beneath the surface, twin MAN diesel inboards provide assured propulsion and a comfortable 19-knot cruising rhythm, while the modified deep V hull instills confidence with a composed, dry ride. Built in robust, low maintenance GRP, she carries generous tankage to support extended coastal cruising with fewer fuel stops and ample freshwater for longer passages.

Outdoor living is thoughtfully arranged: an inviting aft deck for alfresco dining, safe and wide side decks for easy passage, and a broad swim platform that simplifies water access and tender handling. Whether embarking on a tranquil island weekend or an unhurried coastal passage, she marries capability and comfort in equal measure.

With distinguished pedigree, efficient diesel power, and a layout that elevates life aboard, this yacht remains an elegant choice for discerning owners seeking a proven, luxurious platform in the 60-foot class.

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Description

Preliminary listing: this Princess 61 is being introduced ahead of a full presentation, with comprehensive specifications, service history, and high-resolution photography to follow. Details are provided in good faith and remain subject to refinement as the vessel is prepared for market.

Other details

Princess 61, built in 2002 by Princess Yachts in Plymouth to a celebrated hull design by Bernard Olesinski, presents the enduring quality and sea-keeping for which the marque is renowned. Her construction is in GRP for the hull, deck, and superstructure, with teak to the cockpit, side decks, and bathing platform, the latter areas noted as requiring replacement. Dimensions underscore her purposeful stance with an LOA of 18.35 metres, a beam of 4.80 metres, and a draft of 2.09 metres, and all figures are approximate. Power is delivered by twin MAN LE 403 diesel engines rated at 800 hp each, showing approximately 1450 hours on both port and starboard as of May 2025, for an effortless cruising speed of about 22 knots and a top speed in the region of 31 knots. Handling is refined and confidence-inspiring thanks to trim tabs, hydraulic steering, and both bow and stern thrusters with dual-station operation and remote control. Routine underwater attention has included anode work noted in June 2025. The company offers the details of this vessel in good faith but cannot guarantee or warrant the accuracy of this information nor warrant the condition of the vessel; a buyer should instruct agents or surveyors to investigate such details as desired. This vessel is offered subject to prior sale, price change, or withdrawal without notice.

Propulsion

Power comes from twin inboard MAN LE 403 diesel engines, each developing 800 hp, delivering the dependable thrust and range expected of the Princess 61. Both engines show approximately 1450 hours, with the port and starboard units matching as of the May 2025 reading, underscoring balanced use and consistent maintenance.

Specifications

With a measured cruising speed of 19.12 knots, the yacht balances performance and efficiency. Her principal dimensions include a length overall of 61 ft and a length on deck of 60.58 ft, with a beam of 15.75 ft and a maximum draft of 6.83 ft. The dry weight is 57,330 lb, and seating is arranged for 12 guests. The hull is fiberglass with a modified-V form that softens the ride and tracks true. Tankage includes 166 gallons of fresh water and 660 gallons of fuel, supporting extended passages. Accommodation has been thoughtfully planned with 3 guest cabins and 4 heads to provide privacy and comfort on board.
