The feel and acoustics of genuine wood underfoot, the richness of traditional joinery and the pleasing curves of her lines create an inviting, tactile environment that synthetic materials struggle to equal. Below decks, abundant natural light washes across finely worked joinery and an expansive salon that accommodates effortless entertaining or quiet, comfortable living. A well-appointed galley is prepared for intimate dinners or celebratory meals, while private accommodations deliver restful retreats for owner and guests with ample storage and meticulous detailing throughout, an interior that reads as luxurious yet perfectly lived-in.

Underway, twin inboard MAN diesels provide smooth, reliable propulsion, offering the torque and efficiency seasoned yachtsmen prize. Diesel power gives confident, composed passage-making whether meandering sheltered waterways or stretching a coastal itinerary, and the inherent poise of her wooden hull contributes to a notably solid, quiet ride that reflects honest construction and seaworthy temperament. Equally suited for weekend escapes or extended voyages, she is an inspired liveaboard prospect, a graceful entertaining platform and a discerning choice for those drawn to the authenticity of wood allied with quality engineering.
