OVERVIEW

Turkish-flagged and quietly refined, this 2002 Azimut 62 Fly is a timeless flybridge motor yacht that received a full refit in 2017, restoring her to a fresh and contemporary state. Measuring 18.90 m overall with a generous 5.05 m beam and a 1.45 m draft, she offers the swift, planing lines and balanced silhouette expected of a premium 60 foot yacht, equally at home as a Mediterranean cruiser or an elegant family motor cruiser.

The interior is arranged for comfortable extended cruising, with three welcoming guest cabins served by three fully equipped bathrooms with WC and shower, and a separate crew cabin for discreet onboard service. The yacht is presented in excellent working order; all systems are reported fully operational with no known technical issues. The sole exception noted is the flybridge crane remote control, which is currently not onboard but can be supplied upon request.

Propulsion is provided by twin MTU diesels of 900 HP each, showing approximately 3,600 hours, while an Onan 22 kW generator with roughly 7,000 hours attends the hotel loads at anchor. Manoeuvring in tight spaces is simplified by bow and stern thrusters, and climate comfort is assured by a dual Cruise Air air conditioning system that functions without fault. A watermaker increases autonomy, and the hot water boiler holds approximately 60–80 liters. Tankage supports longer passages with 1,000 liters of fresh water, 1,000 liters of black water and 200 liters of grey water.

Deck equipment is robust and reassuring: a Quick windlass with 120 meters of 12 mm chain secures anchoring operations, while the helm enjoys a comprehensive navigation suite—including autopilot and surface radar—allowing confident passage management from either station. A Capelli 3.50 m tender powered by a lively 40 HP Yamaha outboard broadens the yacht's reach from secluded coves to fashionable marinas.

Marrying Azimut's hallmark Italian craftsmanship with turnkey practicality, this flybridge vessel presents as a luxurious, planing motor yacht ready for coastal and offshore ventures in refined style—an appealing choice for those seeking a premium Flybridge, Motor Yacht, Luxury Yacht and Cruiser experience.

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Azimut 62 fly

Flying the Turkish flag, this 2002 Azimut 62 Fly presents as a finely refit motor yacht, comprehensively renewed in 2017 and measured to impress with an overall length of 18.90 m, a generous 5.05 m beam, and a confident 1.45 m draft, purpose-built as a motor yacht that marries Italian elegance with robust capability to offer the ideal platform for relaxed cruising and effortless entertaining. On board, three inviting guest cabins are complemented by three bathrooms with WC and shower, while a dedicated crew cabin ensures discreet service and smooth operations, and the yacht's general condition inspires confidence: all systems are fully operational with no known technical issues, although the flybridge crane remote control is currently not available and can be supplied upon request to suit your cruising plans. Performance and reliability come from twin MTU main engines rated at 900 HP each with 3,600 engine hours, supported by an Onan generator delivering 22 kW with 7,000 hours, and low-speed handling is assured with both bow and stern thrusters for poised, precise close-quarters maneuvering. For all-season comfort a dual Cruise Air air-conditioning system is fully operational, extended autonomy is bolstered by an onboard watermaker and a boiler with a capacity of 60–80 liters, and thoughtful tankage underpins long-range practicality with 1,000 liters of fresh water capacity, 1,000 liters for black water and 200 liters for grey water. On deck a Quick windlass works in tandem with a 12 mm anchor chain stretching 120 meters to deliver steadfast holding and dependable ground tackle management, navigation is comprehensive with autopilot, surface radar and a full suite of navigation equipment to keep you in command in all conditions, and completing the package a Capelli 3.50 m tender powered by a Yamaha 40 HP outboard is ready for swift shore transfers and carefree

exploration, underscoring the Azimut 62 Fly's seamless blend of luxury, performance and practicality.
