

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Flybridge helm

From the elevated helm, commanding the yacht is effortless and precise, every instrument arranged for confident oversight and calm decision making. An upgraded Raymarine touch chartplotter anchors the navigation suite, presenting clear charts and responsive controls, while the upgraded Raymarine Autohelm keeps courses true with quiet confidence, letting you trust the route even in changing conditions. Joystick control adds fingertip finesse for close quarters maneuvers, translating subtle inputs into exact movement, and the responsive throttles turn intent into smooth, predictable acceleration. Clear VHF communication keeps you connected at all times, ensuring coordination with crew and vessels around you and turning every passage into a composed, intuitive experience.

Flybridge

At the heart of open air living, the flybridge is designed for long, languid days at sea, where comfort and conviviality coexist seamlessly. A grill, sink, and fridge form a convenient alfresco galley that effortlessly serves the expansive U shaped seating gathered around a fixed table, a place where conversations linger into golden evenings and meals become an event. Speakers discreetly bathe the space in your chosen soundtrack while the bimini casts cool shade when the sun is high, and a large sun bed aft invites unhurried relaxation as the horizon rolls by. Thoughtful storage is woven into the layout so everything remains shipshape and immediately at hand.

Cockpit & swim platform

Welcoming and practical, the cockpit flows onto a teak deck that feels warm underfoot and invites barefoot comfort as you move between sea and salon. Side access gates and robust mooring winches simplify every arrival and departure, while integrated speakers enrich the ambiance and discreet downlights create an elegant evening mood as the sun sets. A hydraulic passerelle extends a gracious invitation shoreward, bench seating offers an easy perch for conversation, and the swim ladder on the platform completes the scene for effortless dips between anchorages, making every shore visit and swim as gracious as it is uncomplicated.

Side decks & bow area

Safe, generous side decks to port and starboard guide you forward with easy passage and secure footing, leading naturally to the bow where a bathing pad invites sunlit lounging and uninterrupted views to the horizon. The electric windlass stands ready to set and weigh anchor with minimal effort, its smooth operation underscoring the yacht's commitment to ease and refinement both underway and at rest.

Lower helm

In the protected lower helm, technology and tactility converge to create a commanding yet comfortable command center. A Raymarine touch chart plotter offers crisp, intuitive navigation alongside a Raymarine VHF for clear communications, while joystick control delivers precise handling in marinas and tight quarters. Raymarine Tri Data keeps speed, depth, and log at a glance, and a classic compass, responsive trim controls, and authoritative engine controls ensure the helmsman's command is assured in all conditions, whether

cruising open water or executing delicate dockings.

Saloon

The saloon is an inviting social hub, thoughtfully integrated with a fully equipped galley to facilitate effortless living aboard. An electric four burner hob, microwave oven, and a combined fridge/freezer make hosting and provisioning straightforward, while the sink and ample storage keep the space orderly and refined. It is a setting made for unhurried meals, lingering conversations, and the quiet luxury of life afloat, where every surface and sightline contributes to a relaxed, elegant atmosphere.

Galley

Purpose built for effortless provisioning and gracious entertaining, the galley features an electric four burner hob, a convenient microwave oven, and a fridge/freezer to keep ingredients perfectly fresh. The sink stands ready for swift clean ups, and intelligent storage ensures everything has its place, elevating everyday culinary rituals at sea into a streamlined, pleasurable routine.

Master cabin / head

The master cabin is a sanctuary forward, centered on a V shaped double berth that follows the graceful contours of the bow to create a restful, enveloping sleeping space. A dedicated control panel and efficient air conditioning keep the environment finely tuned to your preference, while the adjoining head is appointed for comfort with a proper toilet, a vanity sink, and a shower, bringing the quiet ease and refined appointments of a boutique suite to life at sea.

VIP guest cabin

Your guests are indulged with a VIP haven featuring a central island berth that provides an elegant focal point and generous comfort, opening port holes that invite sea breeze and natural light, and a large mirror that amplifies the sense of space. Abundant storage keeps travel wardrobes pristine, and the private en suite includes a toilet and sink for effortless independence and comfort throughout their stay.

Guest cabin 1

Thoughtfully arranged for flexibility, the guest cabin offers twin single berths that adapt to varying needs, a handy bedside table, and an opening port hole that frames the sea just beyond. Mirrors enhance brightness and depth, while a hanging locker provides proper space for evening wear and essentials, ensuring every voyage feels effortlessly civilized.

Crew cabin

Discreet and practical, the crew cabin provides a comfortable crew berth with immediate access to dedicated crew heads, designed to preserve privacy and efficiency so the team can rest and operate without compromise throughout the voyage.

Engineering

Beneath the refined finish lies purposeful power: twin Caterpillar C18 engines delivering 1000 hp each, driven through robust shaft drives to ensure confident, long legged passages and dependable cruising performance. Precision docking is assured with both bow thruster and stern thruster for

nimble low speed handling, while a Kohler 20 kW generator quietly sustains onboard comforts and systems, making true independence at sea as natural as the act of cruising itself.


