# OVERVIEW

## A VOYAGE INTO THE ELEGANCE OF NAVETTA 62

Step aboard the Navetta 62 by Absolute and enter a renewed chapter of Italian sophistication. This contemporary emblem of luxury motor yachting condenses innovation, craftsmanship and sea-kindly performance into a single, arresting profile. Meticulously engineered and sumptuously finished, she marries semi-displacement efficiency with generous comfort, offering a cruising experience in which the hallmark Absolute atmosphere permeates every compartment. Conceived as a flybridge yacht for long-range voyages and bluewater assurance, the Navetta 62 lifts the lineage to a loftier level of prestige.

## THE CALL OF THE OCEAN: BREATHTAKING EXTERIORS

Beyond the saloon, form and purpose converge to shape an inspired life on deck. The open aft cockpit unfolds toward the horizon, creating a seamless communion with the sea. Expansive glazing and subtly angled panels that frame the cockpit draw abundant daylight and broaden each outlook, bathing guests in a bright, uplifting ambience. Outdoors, modularity governs the arrangement: adaptable furnishings move with ease from tranquil daytime lounging to refined evening entertaining, responding to mood and moment with simple elegance. Small, considered features — the glass-finished stern platform and discreetly recessed LED lighting among them — lend contemporary refinement, transforming every alfresco nook into a stylish retreat for conviviality or repose. Atop it all, the flybridge performs as a raised terrace above the water: an airy, panoramic salon beneath the sky. Generous seating, a welcoming sunpad ensemble and a fully outfitted bar compose a setting ideal for sunset aperitifs, lively gatherings or solitary relaxation. This open-air heart of the yacht guarantees freedom and comfort at every turn.

## A REFUGE OF REFINED CALM AND CONTEMPORARY COMFORT

Inside, the Navetta 62 receives guests with a soft radiance and considered elegance. Carefully chosen materials and balanced textures establish a composed tone while a thoughtfully arranged layout enhances daily life aboard. Full-height pleated draperies and floor-to-ceiling pleated treatments elevate the décor, tempering light and amplifying the sense of volume and ease. The open galley, fitted with modern appliances and a cooktop with integrated extraction, supports both gourmet preparation and casual service, flowing naturally into the salon to encourage convivial living. The salon itself is an ode to comfort: deeply cushioned sofas embrace occupants and an electrically adjustable table glides from coffee to dining height with effortless precision, creating a space that feels immediately welcoming — warm, stylish and perfectly attuned to life at sea.

The accommodations reveal the vessel's most intimate expression of luxury. Each stateroom becomes an elegant sanctuary designed for privacy and restorative quiet. Forward, the owner's suite projects composure with a king-size berth, generous storage solutions and refined finishes. The treatments at every window heighten calm and proportion, underscoring the suite's serene character. The VIP and guest cabins are equally resolved, offering generous volume, carefully selected fabrics and supremely comfortable berths. Every element is devoted to rest and wellbeing so that nights at anchor or underway remain as indulgent as they are peaceful. Purpose-built for extended cruising, the Navetta 62 is an owner-operator friendly, charter-ready, flybridge motor yacht that fuses long-range practicality with a superyacht sensibility. More than a vessel, she is the quintessential contemporary passagemaker — where style, space and seaworthiness find perfect balance.

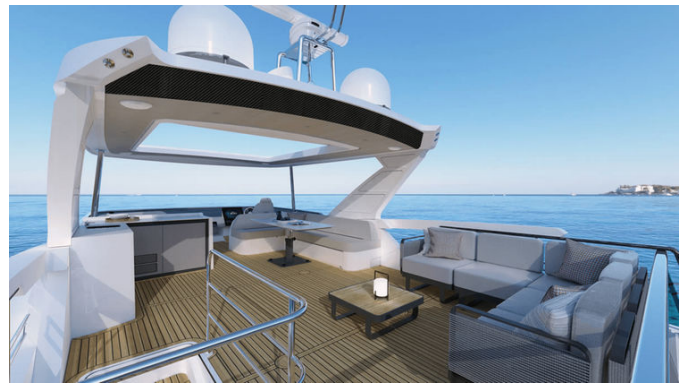

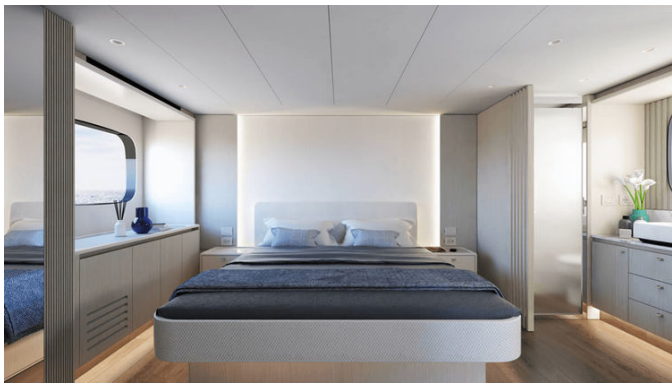

# DETAILED DESCRIPTION

---

## Factory installed options

---

Specified to an exceptional standard, this yacht is delivered with the "Full" display configuration comprising two raised 19 inch wheelhouse displays and two 19 inch flybridge helm displays, all supported by a 5G data connection equipped with two SIM cards. Ground tackle has been upgraded to a 60 kg (132 lbs) Ultra stainless steel anchor with a non foul chain bar, twister and safety lock. The interior is appointed with a salon armchair in light sand coloured leather, an Audio premium package, three bathroom countertops in Calacatta marble in lieu of Corian and a round coffee table with an Atlas ceramic surface for the sofa area; the dining area is elevated with six chairs in light sand coloured leather replacing the standard fabric chairs. Soft goods include a bed cover and pillow for the crew cabin and bed covers and pillows for the master cabin and the mid ship cabins, namely two double cabins and two single cabins. Al fresco entertaining is enhanced by a BBQ and icemaker with icebox integrated into the flybridge wet bar configured for 60 Hz power and by a cockpit wet bar fitted with a Corian countertop, sink with folding mixer tap, storage compartment, refrigerator, set up for an additional mooring station and protective cover, alongside a covers kit for the wet bar and sofas on the flybridge. Forward, the bow dinette features an extensible table with a stone effect laminate surface and an aluminium leg, accompanied by a cover and backrest for the sunpad. Precision manoeuvring is assured by a bow thruster and a stern thruster each with progressive action brushless motors and dedicated automatic fire extinguishing systems, Volvo Assisted Docking, Volvo Interceptor Active and the Volvo Joystick Driving interface with autopilot offering speed variation and a crash stop function; propulsion is provided by Volvo Penta twin D13 IPS1350 engines producing two times 735

kW. Practical enhancements include a built in inflator/deflator at the entrance to the crew cabin; two Cablemasters rated 50A at 60 Hz with remote control and shore power adapter; a damping seat base for the flybridge driving seat instead of a fixed leg with a maximum weight capacity of 120 kg (265 lbs) and an additional driving seat on the flybridge dashboard with a damping leg and the same maximum weight capacity, both supplied with covers; deck cleaning via fresh water and a quay connection located in a compartment with a door; a dishwasher in the galley; an electrical awning for the cockpit with integrated lighting and a privacy shade; and an electrical searching light with dual control at the main deck and flybridge dashboards. Navigation and safety are elevated by an Electronic/Navigation Instruments "Safety" Package, a radar employing solid state technology, the Garmin Surround View system and a gyroscopic stabilizer Seakeeper 18 Gyro with integrated ConnectBox. Above, a fibreglass Hard Top integrates a photovoltaic solar panel system with an energy production monitoring system tied into the on board domotics, while its microfiber coated ceiling panels are fitted with dimmable lights. Additional comforts comprise flyscreens for lower deck portholes, a furniture kit, a greywater tank with a three way valve for the bypass, hand spray showers on the flybridge and bow area, a heated towel rack in the bow master bathroom and woven Roman blinds for the VIP cabin and central cabin in place of venetian blinds. The cockpit is fitted with a height adjustable table featuring a stone effect laminate surface, aluminium leg and foldable wings, nondismountable, with adjustable position and cover; two manual privacy sunshades at the cockpit sides; side access doors on both side walkways; TF Terrace atmosphere modules with covers, available with or without storage bases, for the cockpit area and for the flybridge aft area. The specification continues with a white hull, a hydraulic platform with a 600 kg (1.323 lbs) lifting capacity featuring automatic access stairs integrated into the platform itself, a lighting kit and lower deck cabin flooring in natural woven oak instead of carpet; the Luxury Pack adds a salon dining table with a ceramic surface, a

marble effect ceramic wall behind the headboard in the bow master cabin and a geometric pattern fabric wall behind the headboard in the VIP cabin, while manual gathered curtains in the salon replace venetian blinds. Entertainment is comprehensive with a radio stereo in the bow master cabin with two loudspeakers and an optical digital input; an upgraded radio stereo in the salon with four loudspeakers and a subwoofer; and an electrical TV lift mechanism in the salon, complemented by a refrigerated bottle holder located in the cabinet next to the dining table on the main deck and a 24V wine cooler in the lower deck companionway. Thoughtful details include a removable stainless steel handle for the swim ladder, safes in the bow master cabin and in the aft area of the VIP cabin, a storage unit with mirror in the lower deck companionway and a table with two ottomans on the port side of the bow master cabin; the crew domain benefits from a second bed in the crew cabin, a separated washing machine and tumble dryer for 60 Hz with a service drawer in the crew cabin, and a tilting manual window in the crew cabin towards the aft equipped with an open window sensor. Mooring and daily operation are simplified by a third mooring station in the cockpit on the starboard side, smartphone wireless chargers on the main deck and flybridge dashboards (two), and side access doors on both side walkways; power and connectivity extend outside via watertight sockets 120V at 60 Hz in the cockpit and flybridge aft area. Accents of distinction include eight multicolour RGBW underwater lights with a display for intensity and shade adjustment and two chairs with teak structures and covers for the flybridge dining table; the specification is completed by a set of crockery, cutlery, cups and glasses personalised with the Absolute logo for six people in dedicated housing and a watertight door providing direct access to the engine room from the crew cabin.
