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OVERVIEW

Striking in presence yet gracious in motion, the 2020 Prestige 590 Flybridge delivers an elevated yachting experience that pairs classic lines with contemporary convenience. Measuring roughly 62 feet overall with a generous 15-foot beam, her semi-displacement fiberglass hull from Prestige Engineering offers a composed, quiet ride that comfortably cruises at 24 knots and can be pushed to around 29 knots when desired. Outdoor living is a defining feature — an expansive flybridge, a welcoming cockpit and an inviting foredeck lounge create a succession of al fresco settings for dining, sunbathing and sweeping, panoramic passages along the United States coastline. Twin inboard diesel engines provide the dependable propulsion owners expect, while ample fuel and water stores make longer voyages well within reach.

Inside, the atmosphere by Garroni Design feels both luminous and sociable, with large panoramic windows bathing the salon in natural light and a convivial galley that fluidly links interior comfort with open-air entertaining.

Accommodation is arranged for up to six guests in three beautifully finished staterooms served by three heads, highlighted by a private, full beam owner's suite that enhances life at anchor. A discreet two person crew cabin reinforces the yacht's suitability for extended cruising, helping maintain service and privacy on board. With meticulous craftsmanship, refined fit and finish, and the adaptable luxury expected of top-tier motor yachts, this 2020 Prestige 590 Flybridge represents an attractive proposition for those who value performance, comfort and lasting elegance.

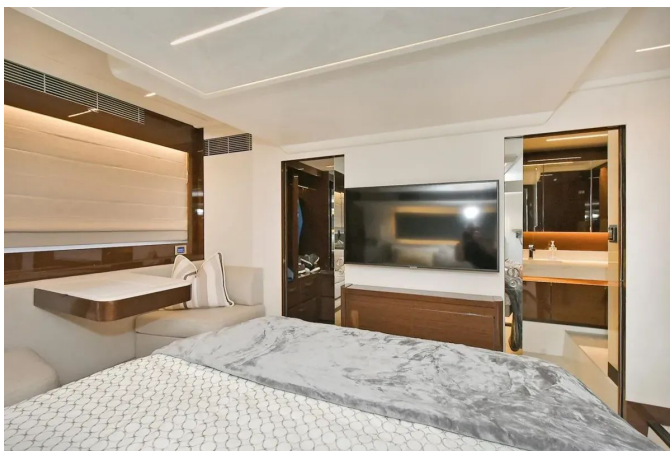
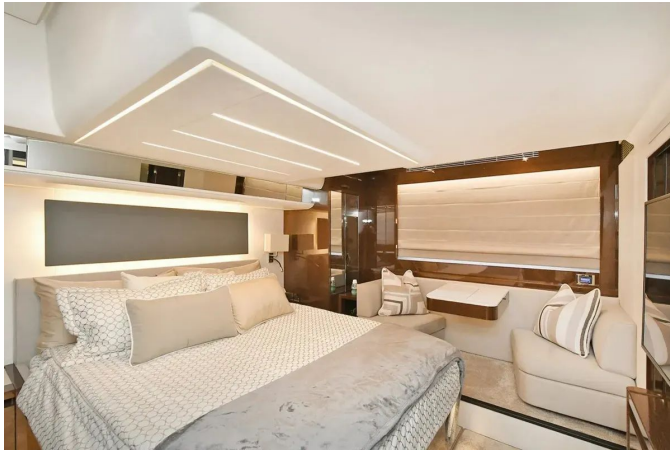






















DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Description

Presented at the lowest price in the U.S.A., this 2020 Prestige 590 Flybridge marries refined luxury with everyday comfort and exceptional value. The interior is configured with three gracious staterooms and two well-appointed heads, complemented by air-conditioned crew quarters for added convenience. Climate control is superb, provided by a 84,000 BTU tropical A/C system, while the finish work exudes sophistication with high-gloss wenge joinery and brushed light oak flooring throughout. The yacht benefits from the upgraded Elite Décor Package complete with Vogue carpeting, and is fitted with practical conveniences including a washer/dryer, central vacuum system, and electric heads, all accentuated by a premium lighting package. Meticulously maintained and comprehensively serviced with full service records on file, this Prestige 590 is turnkey and ready to embark on her next adventure.

Accommodations

Fitted with a rich wenge gloss finish, this fully equipped 2020 Prestige 590 marries modern refinement with intelligent systems, including Seakeeper stabilization, KVH 7 satellite, tropical air-conditioning, dual-access WiFi, a bespoke sound system and notably low engine hours. The interior plan provides three guest cabins plus a dedicated captain's quarter, offering flexibility and privacy for extended voyages.

A three-panel sliding door reveals the salon's elegant living area, appointed with white leather Devon sofas, Roman blinds and electrically operated port windows that flood the space with daylight. A 32-inch flatscreen TV and an

electrically adjustable salon table allow seamless transition between relaxed lounging and formal dining. The lower helm is designed for comfort and clarity, featuring bench seating, a defogger, two windshield wipers and a windshield sundodger that supplies shade both underway and at anchor.

Meal preparation and service benefit from upgraded galley countertops complemented by a VitriFrigo refrigerator, an electric cooktop and a Miele microwave, all arranged to maintain a natural connection with the yacht's social zones.

The full-beam master suite aft is reached by its own private staircase and presents an enlarged walk-around berth flanked by illuminated nightstands, a cozy settee area with a 49-inch table, a flatscreen TV, a Bower & Wilkins system complemented by BOSE speakers, and expansive hull-side windows that bathe the suite in light. The owner's ensuite completes the retreat with a dedicated head and a stall shower.

Forward, the VIP stateroom provides a walk-around berth, a hanging locker, a 24-inch overhead hatch, a flatscreen TV and direct access to the guest head, ensuring discreet comfort for family or visitors.

Mechanical

Engineered for composed handling and hushed, efficient operation, the yacht employs Zeus pods complemented by a bow thruster to deliver precise low speed maneuvering, while an engine-room Seakeeper 9 21 suppresses roll when you are underway. Onboard electrical requirements are supplied by a 5 kW generator and a 24-115 V, 2000 W inverter, with a dedicated battery charger and an integrated battery monitoring system keeping power status visible at a glance. A generously sized holding tank further enhances autonomy for extended cruising.

Electronics and navigational equipment

The helm exudes decisive control and refined clarity, anchored by two Raymarine Axiom 12" multi-GPS displays at the main station and matched by two additional units at the lower helm integrated with the Cummins engine interface. Long-range detection and reliable communications are provided by the Quantum radar Ray 91 and a dual-station VHF, while an AIS receiver and KVH HD7 satellite system broaden situational awareness and onboard connectivity. Close-quarters confidence comes from the intuitive joystick control and responsive trim tabs, ensuring precise maneuvering in every condition.

Additional equipment

Carefully specified to make every hour aboard effortless and elegant, this yacht is equipped with a retractable sun awning that shades both the cockpit and deck, alongside a cockpit docking station that provides pinpoint control for close-quarters maneuvering. An upgraded Bower & Wilkins sound package delivers rich, detailed audio through waterproof speakers forward, while blue underwater lighting creates a dramatic nighttime ambiance visible from the cockpit, flybridge and salon. Daytime relaxation is guaranteed by a spacious foredeck sunpad and a cockpit laid in fine teak, and a teak hydraulic swim platform makes boarding from the water seamless. Practical essentials are comprehensively addressed with a windlass fitted for both line and chain, a hot-and-cold transom shower, a stainless-steel bow protector and a responsive bow thruster, and shore-side services are simplified by a Cablemaster dockside water inlet.

Dinghy

This nimble tender is appointed with a five-seat console trimmed in elegant gray and propelled by a Honda 40 hp motor, protected by a five-year warranty. Onboard entertainment is handled by a Fusion stereo system paired with two Fusion speakers, while a Garmin seven-inch GPS with depth finder provides confident navigation. Thoughtful practical touches include sliding mounting chocks, a Bimini top perfectly color-matched to the boat's trim and an oyster-colored boat cover, and the ensemble is completed by a four-person safety kit with anchor.

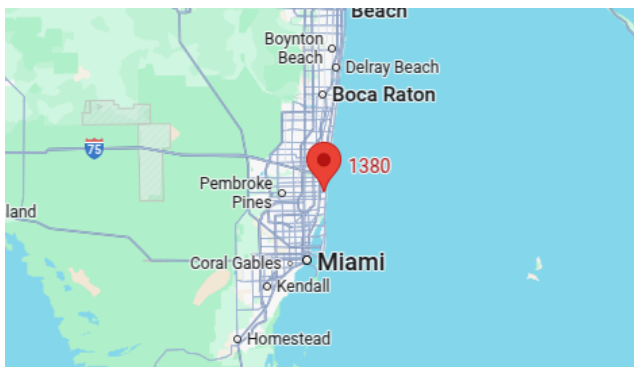
