OVERVIEW

This Ferretti 62 Flybridge has been meticulously maintained by her sole owner since new, presenting as an elegant U.S.-spec luxury cruiser. She offers a three-cabin, three-head layout comfortably accommodating six guests, with a full beam owner's suite that boasts an en suite bathroom with a separate shower. Aft, the galley and buffet bar sit adjacent to a hinged glass window that opens to the cockpit, producing a seamless connection between interior and exterior spaces and creating a generously open salon ideal for effortless entertaining. The flybridge has been enhanced with a custom Pipewelders hardtop with full enclosure, an electric grill and ample seating and sun lounging areas for life underway, while the bow provides expansive sunpads for relaxing in warm conditions. Additional highlights include a Furuno navigation suite with aft cameras, a teak cockpit beneath an extended custom top, satellite TV and much more. This vessel is easy to view in Fort Lauderdale.

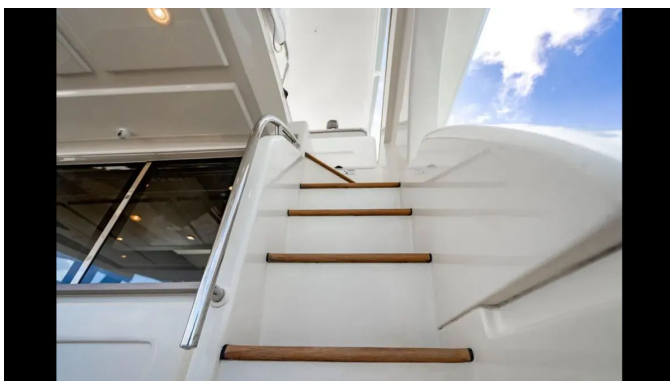

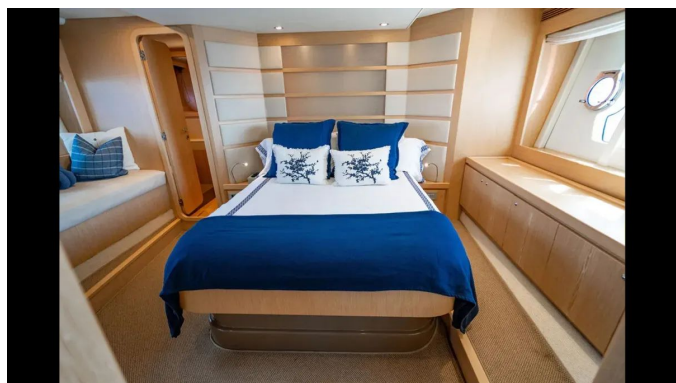


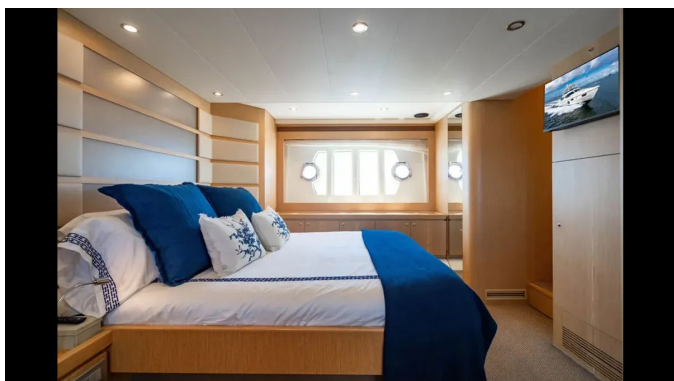
















DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Highlights

Meticulously refreshed throughout, this yacht now offers updated Furuno electronics to enhance navigation, a new Fusion audio system with full controls accessible from the salon, master and flybridge, refreshed upholstery across the bow, cockpit and flybridge cushions, and a range of modern conveniences including a new barbecue, upgraded televisions, a new air-conditioning system and a new microwave.

Cockpit

Beneath warm, richly grained teak decks the cockpit is arranged for effortless pleasure and command: a generous teak cockpit table sets the scene for leisurely socializing while a sweeping teak staircase ascends gracefully to the bridge. A bespoke aft brow sculpts the profile and casts a welcome shade over the cockpit, where intuitive helm and deck controls—including a bow thruster—keep handling straightforward. A polished stainless steel entry door provides a secure, elegant passage into the interior, and a newly fitted Fusion audio system with full controls in the salon, master and flying bridge fills the yacht with music through strategically placed stereo speakers, all under the glow of soft overhead lighting. Ample, discreet storage preserves the uncluttered aesthetic, and dedicated davit controls make launching and stowing the tender effortless, completing a cockpit that balances refined style with practical, seamless functionality.

Bridge features

Sheltered beneath the custom Pipewelders hardtop and fully enclosed for

all-weather comfort, the bridge is conceived for year-round living and elegant entertaining. Secure access is provided via a stairway fiberglass bridge security door that opens into an inviting social area centered on a molded fiberglass bridge table and equipped with an electric grill for effortless alfresco dining. A forward bridge sunpad offers a tranquil spot for sunlit repose, while aft cockpit seating extends the entertaining zone, allowing conversation to move seamlessly between bridge and cockpit.

Bridge helm station

From this elevated vantage, taking command feels effortless: plush, ergonomically sculpted helm seating faces a comprehensive, modern Furuno suite—featuring a Furuno Navnet 3D monitor/chartplotter, Furuno radar, Furuno Nav Pilot, Furuno Tri Data for depth, speed and trip, and a Furuno VHF for clear communications. Precise handling is assured by ZF electronic controls and a Side Power thruster, supported by analog engine gauges, a rudder indicator and remote spotlight control, while the electric helm closure system provides added protection and convenience. For onboard entertainment and connectivity, a Fusion AM/FM radio with Bluetooth completes the bridge.

Galley

Designed with entertaining in mind, the galley combines generous storage and a built-in microwave for swift convenience. A Bosch four-burner electric cooktop is paired with a Bosch dishwasher to ensure cooking and cleanup are effortless, while a stainless-steel sink equipped with a pullout sprayer delivers residential-style functionality. Provisions are preserved in a dedicated refrigerator and freezer, and climate comfort is maintained via its own AC control. An aft window that hinges open to the cockpit creates a seamless indoor-outdoor flow, complemented by a port-side bar and buffet area

offering extra storage for service and display. The ambiance is elevated by a Bose 3-2-1 surround-sound entertainment system, filling the space with rich, immersive audio.

Salon

Step into the salon where a sumptuous port-side sofa faces a streamlined storage cabinet concealing a remote-controlled flat-screen television, creating a refined centerpiece for both serene relaxation and lively entertainment. To starboard, an exquisitely appointed dinette with a glass-topped table provides an elegant setting for dining or intimate conversation. Rich hardwood floors lend warmth and sophistication beneathfoot while shades with block-outs offer precise control over light and privacy. A premium Bose surround sound system fills the space with high-fidelity audio, subtle overhead lighting sculpts the ambiance from day into night, and strategically placed outlets ensure effortless connectivity throughout.

Lower helm

From the single helm chair the captain presides over a meticulously arranged console fitted with a Furuno NavNet 3D Monitor Chartplotter, Furuno Radar, Furuno Nav Pilot, Furuno Tri Data and Furuno VHF, while a Side Power Bow Thruster and Quick Chain Counter provide precise support for close quarters maneuvering and anchoring. Propulsion and gear selection are handled through ZF Electric Controls in concert with three N Digital Engine Controls, and a Compass, Jabsco Remote Spotlight Control and the Main Distribution Switch Panels are all positioned within easy reach to ensure confident, effortless command.

Forward VIP stateroom

The forward VIP stateroom is appointed around a sumptuous island berth and offers ample storage including dedicated hanging lockers, individual AC control for bespoke comfort, and a JVC flat-screen TV for onboard entertainment; conveniently located outlets accommodate charging of personal devices, while tasteful shades afford privacy and refined light control, an overhead skylight invites abundant natural daylight, and carefully positioned overhead lighting cultivates a warm, welcoming evening atmosphere.

Guest head

Thoughtfully arranged for both comfort and ease, the guest head features a separate shower for unhurried refreshment, a toilet, and a refined vanity outfitted with a sink, mirror and an integrated storage cabinet for toiletries. Discreetly placed outlets accommodate grooming essentials, while dedicated hooks for towels and robes and a devoted toilet paper holder ensure everything remains organized and within reach.

Guest stateroom

This welcoming guest stateroom is appointed with twin single berths that provide flexible sleeping arrangements, a hanging locker to keep garments neatly stored, and a window shade that ensures privacy and the option of complete darkness for restful sleep. Entertainment is supplied by a JVC flat-screen TV, while carefully positioned overhead lighting and a well placed mirror enhance both atmosphere and usability, composing an elegant sanctuary for family and friends.

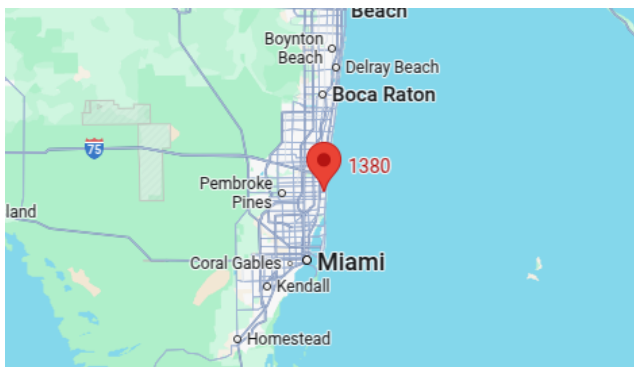
