## OVERVIEW

---

The McKinna 62 Express Yacht exemplifies the pinnacle of luxury and performance. Built on the renowned Howard Apollonio-designed hull, this vessel shares its foundation with other successful McKinna models, particularly the 60-foot Express, known for their exceptional seaworthiness and comfort.

The cockpit is designed for convenience, featuring two spacious lockers with removable bins that provide easy access to the Onan 21.5 kW generator, rudders, and steering systems. Oversized freeing ports and elegant teak steps lead to expansive side decks, which are equipped with sturdy double lifelines and robust upper rails. The anchor windlass is cleverly recessed and includes protective hatches, with remote control capabilities from the helm. Access to the engine room is user-friendly, thanks to a dedicated door in the cockpit console, a thoughtful design choice compared to many express cruisers that rely on hatches and ladders.

Step into the engine room, and you'll find an impressive 6.5 feet of headroom, allowing for easy maneuverability around the powerful 1,015-horsepower Caterpillar C18 diesels. This yacht is outfitted with top-tier equipment, including Racor filters, Groco through-hulls, and a Sea-Fire halon system, all presented in a sleek, easy-to-clean glossy white finish with nonslip flooring for added safety.

Ascending the molded staircase from the cockpit, what could have been a sunpad area has been transformed into a stylish alfresco settee and table, partially shaded by a hardtop. Inside the stainless steel sliding doors of the pilothouse version, the air-conditioned bridge features a comfortable settee along the port side and a wet bar opposite, complete with twin bar stools.

An alternative open version is also available, showcasing a cleverly arranged bar with forward-facing stools, a counter for the settee, and a U-shaped wet bar, creating a vibrant social hub. Both configurations boast an expansive

electrically operated sunroof, allowing for fresh air and natural light.

The helm is elegantly designed, featuring a recessed, aircraft-style instrument panel with a slight cowling to minimize reflections. There is ample space for large flat-screen displays, and the yacht comes equipped with advanced electronics, including a computerized monitoring system, radar, GPS, VHF, autopilot, and satellite receivers. Visibility from the helm is outstanding in all directions.

Below deck, you are greeted by an expansive interior with impressive headroom. The salon spans the full 17-foot, 3-inch beam, adorned with a trio of lozenge-shaped ports on each side that flood the space with light.

A wraparound lounge faces a Pioneer 42-inch pop-up TV to port, while the aft port corner is dedicated to a well-appointed galley, featuring a granite countertop that doubles as a breakfast bar with three stools. The open design allows for a skylight effect, enabling guests in the salon to engage with those on the bridge.

The galley is equipped with high-quality appliances, including a Kenyon four-burner cooktop, a full-size Sub-Zero refrigerator, and twin Sub-Zero freezer drawers. Just aft of the salon and down a step lies the master suite, which takes full advantage of the beam, featuring a walkaround queen-sized berth, large ports, and cedar-lined lockers. Built-in nightstands complement the headboard, which combines padding and beveled mirrors, while a vanity is conveniently tucked into one corner.

A pocket door provides access to the master head, which boasts a marble floor and countertop, a combination shower and tub, and a Headhunter toilet.

Forward, the VIP stateroom also features a queen-sized walkaround berth, a vanity, and built-in drawers. The guest head, equipped with a shower, serves as a day head with access from both the VIP and the salon.

The McKinna 62 Express showcases a high-gloss African cherry interior that exudes warmth and sophistication, with an optional pale anigre finish

available. Noteworthy details include slotted paneling for air conditioning outlets, enhancing the yacht's elegant aesthetic.

At 2000 rpm, she glides along at 27 knots with a mere 70 decibels, making the 62 Express an ideal choice for exploring the Bahamas. Simply cast off, set the throttles for a leisurely cruise, and you'll be snorkeling the vibrant reefs in no time.

The standard equipment list for the McKinna 62 Express is extensive and impressive, featuring Glendinning Cablemasters, a complete satellite TV system, bow docking lights, a bow thruster, underwater lights, a Muir 3,500-pound windlass, a Charles Industries Isoboost transformer, and Nibral 5-blade Fast props. This yacht is exceptionally well-equipped for discerning buyers.

The McKinna 62 Express is truly a remarkable yacht, offering the spaciousness of a large vessel while maintaining the charm of a smaller boat. Whether you're looking to buy a yacht or explore yacht sales in the current boat location, this vessel stands out as a premier choice.























