Presented at this year's Sanctuary Cove International Boat Show from 21–24 May 2026 and berthed on I ARM in the marina, this 2021 Princess S62 sportbridge motor yacht is an exceptional, near-new example of the S-Class pedigree, combining a sleek contemporary profile with dynamic performance and lavish accommodation. The generous glazing in both hull and superstructure floods the main salon with daylight, while the aft galley is laid out to flow seamlessly into the cockpit, creating effortless spaces for entertaining. Below deck, three beautifully appointed cabins include a full beam owner's suite, offering privacy and comfort for extended cruises. Driven by low hour twin MAN diesel engines and extensively specified throughout, this luxury yacht delivers composed, assured performance and turnkey entertaining across expansive interior and exterior social areas.

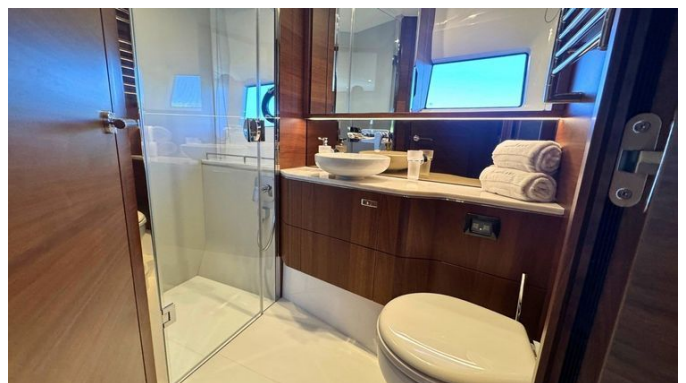

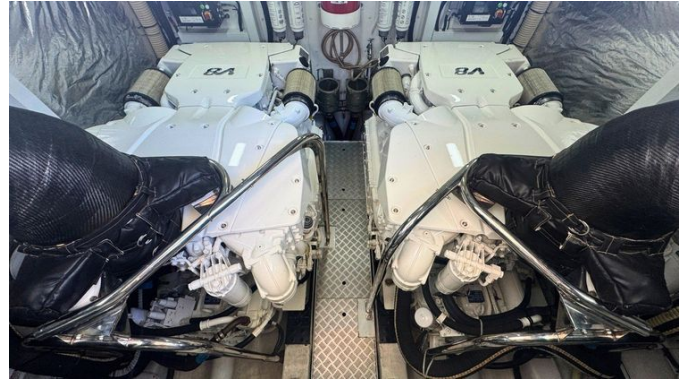














DETAILED DESCRIPTION

2021 63' Princess S62 yacht 'B III'

B III is a striking interpretation of the Princess sports bridge concept, marrying contemporary, aerodynamic styling with powerful seagoing capability and luxurious accommodation. Built by Princess Yachts in the United Kingdom, the S62 is distinguished by its elegant profile, advanced naval architecture and a layout conceived to enhance both entertaining and extended cruising. At just over 19 metres in length the yacht carries Princess's signature sweeping exterior lines, expansive hull glazing and broad saloon windows that bathe the interior in daylight, while refined satin walnut joinery, textured fabrics and premium leather detailing create a calm, contemporary atmosphere below deck.

The main deck is arranged around a practical galley-aft format that unites cockpit and saloon into a single, sociable environment. Wide stacker doors and a clever hopper window enable the interior bar and galley to service both inside and out with effortless flow, making the space ideal for relaxed gatherings or formal entertaining. Accommodation is arranged over three well-proportioned cabins to ensure comfortable living on longer passages: a full-beam master suite positioned amidships for optimal stability and privacy, complete with generous storage, large hull windows and a private ensuite; a forward VIP stateroom that welcomes guests in style; and a versatile third cabin suitable for family or additional guests.

Outdoor living is a focal point of the sports bridge arrangement, with a cockpit designed for alfresco dining and lounging, including a substantial sunpad, and an upper sports flybridge that houses a secondary helm fitted with a comprehensive Raymarine navigation suite, extensive seating and a wet bar, all set beneath sweeping views. The foredeck offers an additional sunning

area, while the hydraulic swim platform simplifies swimming, diving and tender operations. Practical refinements such as a deck shower, bow sunlounges, a retractable sunroof, an electric aft awning and a hydraulic tender garage further enhance life on deck. Propulsion is provided by twin MAN V8 engines producing 1,200 horsepower each, delivering the responsive handling and assured cruising performance expected of the S-Class; with low engine hours and the benefit of a gyro stabiliser, B III promises notably smooth passages and reduced roll both underway and at anchor. Highly specified with an array of factory and aftermarket options and maintained to an exacting standard, this Princess S62 is an attractive proposition for those seeking a modern luxury motor yacht ready for cruising in the Mediterranean, the Whitsundays or along Australia's east coast.
