She is an elegant express motor yacht with the soul of a performance cruiser, a hardtop powerboat designed to thrill and to soothe in equal measure.

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

63 Marquis propulsion

Power is delivered by twin VOLVO IPS D13 diesel engines, each producing 900 Hp (662 kW) at 2300 rpm to provide effortless acceleration and long range poise, while matched four blade NiBral propellers, thirty inch in diameter and counter rotational, translate that power into a silky, cavitation free drive. Four electric stainless steel trim tabs, each measuring 36 x 9, allow precise attitude refinement for maximum efficiency and comfort, and an underwater engine exhaust discharge with automatic bypass keeps operations quiet and fume free under way and at rest. Intuitive fingertip maneuvering is provided by the Volvo Penta IPS joystick control system, making docking and tight quarter turns simple and confidence inspiring.

63 Marquis electrical system

The yacht's electrical architecture is engineered for seamless, automated power management, beginning with an Automatic Shore/Generator Switch Gear that selects the optimal source without interruption and extending into formidable reserve capacity: eight Douglas 8D series marine 12V batteries deliver a 1375 amp cold cranking rating, 430 minutes of reserve capacity at a 25 amp draw, and a 200 amp/hour rating, apportioned between four engine starting and four ship service roles. Complementing these are two 8D Absorbed Glass Mat AGM accessory batteries, four 31 Series AGM engine starting batteries, and one 31 Series AGM generator starting battery, while charging is comprehensive with an 80 amp accessory charger, a 60 amp accessory charger built into the inverter, an 80 amp engine charger, and a 25 amp generator charger. A Shore 1 to Shore 2 combiner switch and dual Glendenning Cablemasters add dockside flexibility and effortless shore power

handling, LED courtesy lights provide crisp, efficient illumination, and a CATV dockside inlet includes a 50 ft (15.2 m) white cord. Power generation is entrusted to a 20 kW 50 Hz KOHLER generator with sound shield, supported by a dedicated 31 Series AGM battery and automatic power source control for quiet, reliable autonomy.

63 Marquis water & waste

A thoughtfully designed water and waste suite streamlines life aboard, featuring an overboard discharge system for compliant disposal where permitted, a fresh water washdown system to keep decks and gear pristine, and a convenient cockpit shower that delivers spa-like refreshment directly to the swim platform experience.

63 Marquis safety & navigation

Confidence comes standard with a comprehensive Bridge and Lower Helm Navigation Package complete with radar, mirrored by a Bridge and Lower Helm Monitor System that keeps critical data in clear view at both stations. The autopilot lightens the helm on passage by maintaining precise courses with minimal intervention, while a Ritchie Navigator 4.5" (11.4 cm) illuminated flush-mount compass provides steadfast, analog clarity when you want it most.

63 Marquis exterior amenities

An exterior curated for both allure and utility begins with Aston Brown Metallic Paint that shimmers with depth and is protected below the waterline by a single coat of black hull bottom protection, while underwater lights transform evenings at anchor into a theater of reflected color. A hydraulic lifting platform,

a swimming ladder, and a passerelle make water access and boarding effortless, and situational awareness is supported by a Bridge and Lower Monitor System as the bridge itself invites relaxation with a lounge and sunpad beneath a hard top crowned by an opening sunroof. The Exterior Upgrade Package refines every touchpoint with a bridge stereo that supplies the soundtrack, teak decking on the swim platform for warm, non-skid elegance, and helm and seat covers to preserve finishes between voyages; a cockpit table and a foredeck sunpad anchor alfresco moments, while entertaining is made simple with a single grill for the bridge wet bar, a bridge ice maker, and a refrigerator for the bridge wet bar. Ground tackle is authoritative: a windlass with capstan and a Windlass package built around a Quick Antares 1500 are paired with a 75 lb (34 kg) stainless steel plow anchor and 300' (91.4 m) of 3/8" (9.5 mm) grade 40 chain, assisted by dual stern capstan winches and secure mooring cleats, and finishing touches include exterior décor pillows and a dedicated mechanism for the bridge TV that deploys viewing at the touch of a button.

63 Marquis interior amenities

Inside, the Valentina Designer Contemporary Interior sets an elegant tone with tailored lines and curated textures, beautifully complemented by rich walnut wood that brings warmth, depth, and a timeless nautical pedigree to every living space.

63 Marquis salon

The salon opens to the sea through opening salon portholes that invite breeze and light, framing a lounge anchored by a forty-two inch LCD TV and a stereo with a surround system for cinematic evenings afloat, while everyday comfort is heightened by a built-in dishwasher that keeps entertaining effortless and a

central vacuum system that makes housekeeping swift and discreet.

63 Marquis galley

The galley is a showcase of gourmet intention, with granite countertops and matching granite flooring that provide both elegance and durability, abundant electrical outlets to keep every appliance at the ready, and a built in Sharp microwave/convection oven/broiler in a brushed stainless steel finish paired with an electric three burner range featuring a Ceran top and a brushed stainless steel backsplash. A brushed stainless steel range hood with two lights, an exhaust fan, and an outside vent keep air fresh, cold storage is generous with a Jenn Air full size French door refrigerator/freezer with bottom freezer in brushed stainless steel, and a two basin under mounted stainless steel sink streamlines prep and cleanup, supported by nine storage cabinets and eight storage drawers to keep provisions and cookware perfectly organized.

63 Marquis cabin amenities

This is the four guest cabin version, thoughtfully arranged to welcome family and friends in style; the master stateroom indulges with a thirty two inch TV and DVD, a master stateroom stereo with Apple iPod dock, and a spa like ensuite featuring a teak head shower and a teak seat in the master shower. The VIP stateroom enjoys a nineteen inch TV and DVD along with a VIP stateroom stereo with Apple iPod dock, the third stateroom mirrors the experience with its own nineteen inch TV and DVD and a third stateroom stereo with Apple iPod dock, and a dedicated fourth stateroom adds flexibility with a fifteen inch TV for private unwinding. Practicality matches luxury with an onboard washer and dryer, while professional grade support comes from double crew quarters equipped with a fifteen inch TV and DVD/Radio, plus a

crew quarter refrigerator and a crew quarter microwave to ensure the team is as comfortable and capable as you are.

63 Marquis miscellaneous

Certified for European standards, this yacht meets rigorous requirements to broaden your cruising horizons with confidence across international waters.
