DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Auxiliary machinery & electrical system

Designed for robust, whisper-quiet performance at sea, the premium electrical backbone is anchored by a KOHLER® 20 kW 50 Hz generator with a full sound shield, a dedicated 31 Series AGM starting battery, an automatic power source control module, and a five-year warranty that speaks to long-term confidence; dockside connectivity is seamless through a CATV inlet complete with 50' (15.2 m) of white cord, while Dual Glendenning Cablemasters manage shore power with elegant ease. Energy reserves are substantial and deliberately configured: eight Douglas 8D marine batteries (12 V) with a cold-cranking rating of 1,375 A, a reserve capacity of 430 min at a 25 A draw, and a 200 A/hr rating apportioned as four for engine starting and four for ship service, supplemented by two 8D AGM accessory batteries plus four 31 Series AGM engine-start batteries and one 31 Series AGM generator-start battery to ensure reliable redundancy and rapid starts. LED courtesy lighting enhances safety and ambiance throughout the yacht, and a comprehensive charging suite keeps every circuit topped and ready, comprising one 80 A accessory charger, one 60 A accessory charger integrated into the inverter, one 80 A engine charger, and one 25 A generator charger, while a Shore 1 to Shore 2 combiner switch affords flexible, protected power management in any marina.

Navigation & communication equipment

Confidence at the helm arises from a fully integrated bridge and lower helm navigation package with radar, a capability mirrored by a dual-station monitor system that keeps critical data always in view at both stations, while precision course-keeping is assured by an autopilot that eases long passages and reduces helm fatigue; a Ritchie® Navigator 4.5" (11.4 cm) flush-mount,

illuminated, dual-read compass provides an immediate, night-readable heading reference that complements the electronic suite.

Exterior amenities

The hull's sleek presence is accented by a single black bottom coat and dramatic underwater lights that create a memorable night profile, while a hydraulic lifting platform, a swimming ladder, and a passerelle extend effortless access to the water and the quay for boarding, tender handling, and leisure; life on deck is elevated by bridge and lower monitor systems, a bridge lounge with a generous sunpad beneath a hard top with an opening sunroof, and an Exterior Upgrade Package that refines every touchpoint. Entertainment is served by a bridge stereo, helm and seat covers preserve the finishes, and teak decking on the swim platform adds warm, surefooted elegance at the waterline. A cockpit table and a foredeck sunpad invite open-air dining and repose, while the bridge wet bar is uniquely equipped with a single grill, an icemaker, and a refrigerator to keep service effortless; exterior décor pillows provide a tailored flourish and a dedicated mechanism for the bridge TV completes the alfresco entertainment suite. Ground tackle is professional grade, specified with a windlass with capstan at the bow, dual stern capstan winches for precise aft handling, robust mooring cleats, and a windlass package centered on a Quick Antarres® 1500 paired with a 75 lb. (34 kg) stainless steel plow anchor and 300' (91.4 m) of 3/8" (9.5 mm) grade 40 chain.

Interior amenities

A Valentina Designer Contemporary Interior sets an elegant, modern tone throughout the yacht, beautifully realized in rich walnut wood that wraps the spaces with warmth, depth, and bespoke yacht craftsmanship to create an inviting environment that harmonizes refined style with durable, marine-grade

finishes suited to both intimate living and gracious entertaining.

Salon

The salon welcomes with opening portholes that breathe sea air into a refined living space anchored by a 42" LCD TV and a stereo with surround system for cinematic evenings onboard, while practical luxury is thoughtfully integrated with a dishwasher to ease entertaining and a central vacuum system that keeps every finish immaculate with minimal effort.

Galley

The galley is a chef's showcase, finished with granite countertops and matching granite flooring that create a cohesive, elegant workspace with abundant electrical outlets and premium appliances; a built-in Sharp® microwave/convection oven/broiler in brushed stainless steel pairs with an electric three-burner range featuring a Ceran® top and a brushed stainless backsplash, all ventilated by a matching hood with two lights, an exhaust fan, and an outside vent. Cold storage is exceptional with a full-size JennAir® French-door refrigerator/freezer with a bottom freezer in brushed stainless steel, a stainless under-mounted two-basin sink streamlines preparation and cleanup, and generous stowage—nine storage cabinets and eight storage drawers—keeps provisions and cookware neatly organized.

Cabin amenities

This is the coveted four-guest-cabin version, curated for private retreats and effortless hosting, where the master stateroom indulges with a 32" TV with DVD and a stereo complete with an Apple iPod dock, complemented by a teak head shower and a teak seat in the master shower for spa-like comfort; the VIP

stateroom mirrors the experience with a 19" TV with DVD and its own stereo with Apple iPod dock, the third stateroom is equally well appointed with a 19" TV with DVD and a stereo with Apple iPod dock, and a fourth stateroom expands flexibility with a 15" TV for personal downtime. Practical onboard living is enhanced by a washer and dryer, and professional crew can settle into double crew quarters outfitted with a 15" TV with DVD/radio plus a dedicated refrigerator and microwave for independent convenience.


