Having cruised exclusively on the Great Lakes (freshwater) since 2010, and prior to that only in Kentucky's freshwater, this vessel has been maintained with exceptional care. Resolute presents in impeccable condition after sixteen years under the stewardship of an experienced Great Lakes yachtsman, and she is wintered for roughly seven months each year in heated, indoor storage within a secure condo facility where diligent maintenance and tasteful upgrades are routinely completed. Her exterior paintwork shows beautifully, and the interior has been refreshed to feel updated, fresh, and immaculate. This meticulously kept motor yacht is the product of consistently attentive ownership and is well worth the journey to Michigan — an outstanding opportunity for the discerning buyer right now.

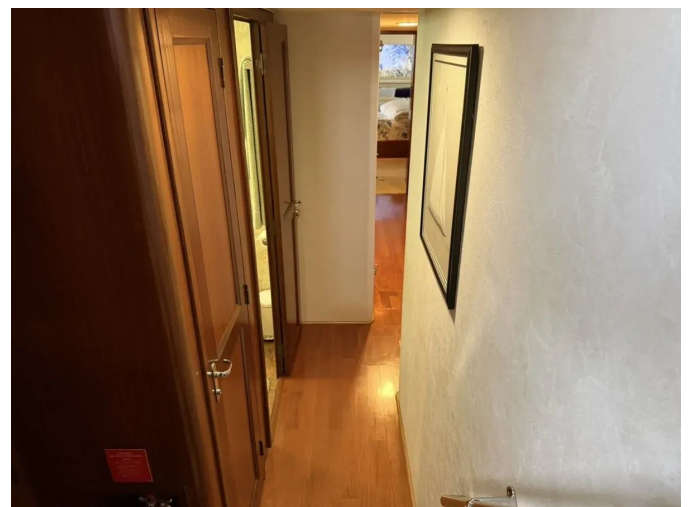










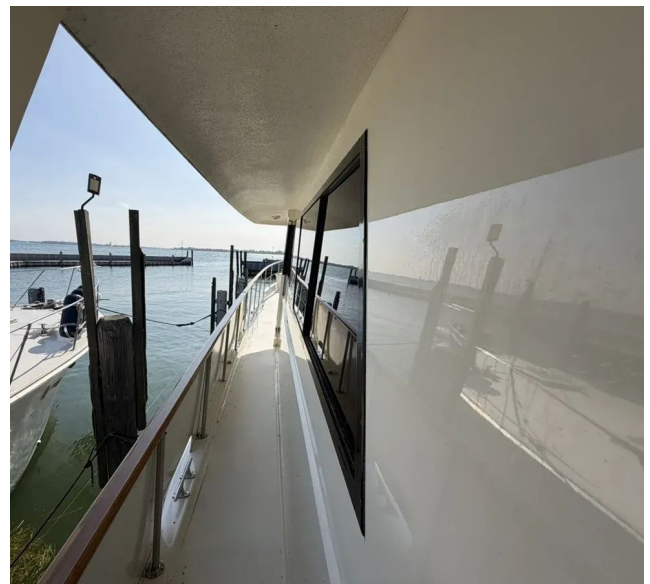




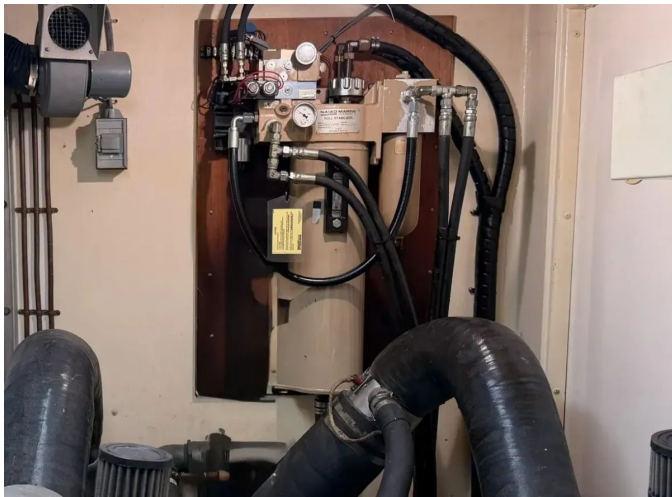
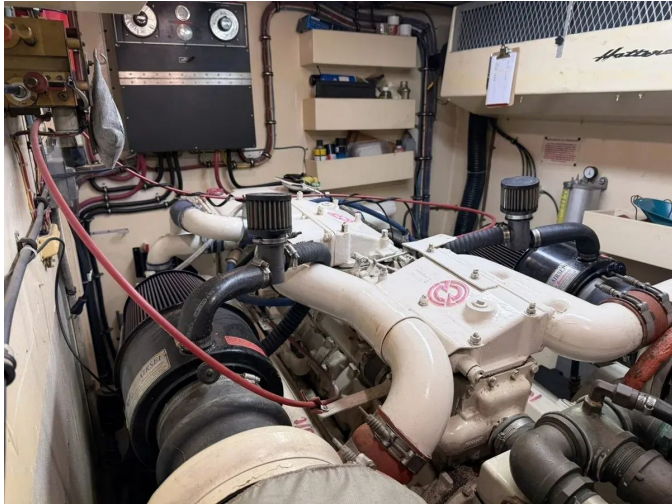












DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Vessel walkthrough

Access Resolute via either the port or starboard sliding side doors into the combined lower helm and salon, where a comprehensive electronics suite occupies the command station. Immediately aft of the helm, an expansive salon invites the sea air through opening windows on both sides and flows aft through a doorway onto a generous aft deck, which is fully enclosed across the stern with EZ2CY and set within sliding glass windows to port and starboard. From the starboard aft corner, three steps descend to the cockpit, and a transom door provides direct passage to the fiberglass swim platform. From the aft deck guests may return to the salon or leave by the port or starboard wing doors onto wide walk around decks that lead forward to a foredeck designed for comfort and storage, featuring two bow boxes, a large built in bow seat and a capacious sunning pad.

From the starboard side of the lower helm, a short walk forward and down a few steps brings you into the generous galley, equipped with full size appliances and a built in dining table that seats four. Immediately forward of the galley is the third stateroom, suitable as crew's quarters, while aft of the galley and down one level are the second stateroom and the master suite; the second guest stateroom sits midship to port. Proceeding further aft are the two main engine rooms, and beyond them the full beam master, appointed with its own en suite head.

Main salon

Situated aft of the helm area, the main salon eschews a full-height separation bulkhead, producing a gracious, open environment with uninterrupted

exterior sightlines. The distinction between salon and lower station is rendered with understated refinement through the presence of the helm seat and an integrated entertainment center; on the salon side of the helm seat a large mounted smart TV is paired with stereo equipment and built-in storage cabinets. The floor is fully carpeted and anchored in the aft port corner by a custom L-shaped suede sectional, accompanied by a wooden end table and lamp, while a bespoke barrel chair is positioned forward. Directly in front of the couch a high-gloss varnished hi/lo teak coffee table with fold-out leaves provides a polished focal point. To starboard, two upholstered swivel chairs are arranged with a wooden table and lamp between them, and the window treatments blend horizontal blinds with fabric-covered cornice boards for a refined, cohesive finish.

Galley

Meticulously outfitted for both form and function, the galley is equipped with a full-size Kenmore refrigerator and freezer alongside a Modern Maid four-burner stove with oven and a Modern Maid dishwasher, all set beneath sleek granite countertops. An under-mount stainless steel sink with disposal provides practical convenience, while a built-in Panasonic microwave oven adds effortless efficiency. The floor is finished in oak parquet hardwood, imparting warmth and timeless yacht character throughout the space. To starboard, a comfortable dinette booth with a bespoke wood table creates an intimate spot for relaxed dining, and large opening windows on either side, fitted with custom fabric blinds, fill the area with abundant natural light and fresh sea air.

Master stateroom

Accessed via a companionway finished in wood planking, the accommodations

are carpeted for comfort while the heads are fitted with durable vinyl underfoot. The master is anchored by a king-sized bed with a bespoke, fabric-covered headboard and is elegantly dressed in a coordinated bedspread, shams, curtains and valances. To port, a three-quarter-height dresser offers plentiful drawer storage and houses a smart television and stereo system, accompanied by two cedar-lined closets; to starboard, a matching three-quarter-height dresser is paired with a refined settee to create a harmonious, functional layout. The head is appointed with a custom enclosed toilet, an enclosed shower/tub and a full mirrored vanity with an opening porthole and storage concealed behind it. This generous stateroom is bright and airy, benefitting from four opening portholes and a large opening window in the aft bulkhead.

Guest stateroom - forward

The forward guest stateroom is a fully carpeted sanctuary appointed with twin berths clad in bespoke canvas covers, tailored bedspreads and matching shams, all set off by warm teak joinery and refined vinyl wall coverings. Beneath is a solid wooden floor and a built-in dresser that marries practical storage with elegant finish. A forward hatch provides direct access to the rope locker serving the windlass, while a private ensuite with a stall shower and a cedar-lined hanging locker delivers added comfort and organized clothing care. Abundant daylight and sea breezes are drawn through three opening portholes and an overhead opening hatch, creating a bright, airy retreat.

Guest stateroom - midship

This elegant midship guest stateroom presents twin berths dressed in bespoke bedspreads and coordinated shams with matching draperies, anchored by an integrated nightstand between the beds and topped with a designer lamp. A

generous cedar lined hanging closet is complemented by abundant drawers and overhead storage, while a Toshiba television is custom mounted for onboard entertainment. The full head across the companionway serves this stateroom and also acts as the day head, and immediately forward of it is a cedar lined linen closet alongside a stacked Kenmore washer and dryer.

Wheelhouse

Designed for assured long-distance navigation, the wheelhouse is appointed with a full suite of professional electronics including a Furuno FCR-1411 72-mile color radar paired with a Garmin GPSMAP 7212 chartplotter and a Garmin GHC 10 autopilot, while precise handling is supported by a Naiad Marine stabilizer control panel and a Robertson RI 101 rudder angle indicator. Communications are entrusted to an Icom IC M100 VHF marine radio with an Icom Command-mic 11, and traditional bearing is provided by a Danforth 8-inch Constellation compass set in a stainless binnacle. Auxiliary systems such as a Cybernet CTX 1000 hailer/horn, a Datamarine International Offshore depth sounder, Jabsco searchlight control and an overhead remote chart light further enhance situational awareness. The helm keeps vital systems immediately accessible with engine gauges, fuel tank gauges and intuitive engine controls prominently displayed, while the captain's comfort is assured by a generous helm seat with a fold-out footrest and integrated chart drawers. The space is elegantly finished with warm parquet flooring and a mounted Samsung TV for onboard entertainment.

Flybridge

Reached via a teak-tread ladder from the aft deck, the expansive flybridge is appointed with a deliberate layout that marries relaxed entertaining with practical seafaring functionality. Aft on deck rests a 13' 1986 Boston Whaler

with outboard, poised for immediate use and handled by an electric low profile davit. An L-shaped cushioned lounge, fitted with protective covers and generous under-seat stowage, separates the tender bay from the forward social area, while additional covered seating mirrors this arrangement to the opposite side, combining protection and convenience. Centering the space is a large L-shaped varnished table that invites convivial gatherings, and forward a varnished-top wet bar equipped with an icemaker and refrigerator makes service effortless. To starboard, a built-in stainless Char-grill barbeque enhances al fresco dining, and three Pomanette helm chairs, each with cushions and covers, provide sumptuous, authoritative seating at the helm. The helm itself is thoughtfully protected by Lexan instrument covers, a Lexan windscreen and a black canvas Bimini top to shield occupants from wind and spray. The electronics package is comprehensive and navigation-ready, featuring a Garmin GPSMAP 7212 chart plotter, Furuno NavNet, Robertson RI 101 Rudder Angle Indicator, Datamarine depth sounder repeater, Sony stereo, Icom IC M80 VHF marine radio, Icom Ic M504 VHF Marine radio, a Danforth 8" Constellation compass in Stainless Brinicle and Jabsco Searchlight Control, delivering assured control and clear situational awareness underway.

Aft deck

Completely enclosed to ensure comfort in any weather, the aft deck provides two wing doors to the forward walkways and is fitted with sliding glass side panels and EZ2CY enclosures aft, forming a bright, protected retreat. Entertaining is effortless with a full wet bar equipped with an ice maker, refrigerator and ample storage, while the seating area—anchored by an area rug, a couch, two chairs and two wood end tables—invites relaxed conversation. Thoughtful effects lighting and a brass ship's bell underscore the nautical ambiance, and convenient access connects both the bridge and the cockpit.

Cockpit

Two generously overstuffed wicker chairs invite you to relax in the cockpit, arranged around a perfectly matched wicker end table for effortless conversation or morning coffee. The space balances refinement with function, incorporating two flush-mounted rod holders, discreet cockpit lighting and a freshwater washdown, while providing easy access to the illuminated lazarette. Through the transom door lies the fiberglass swim platform, equipped with a stainless steel swim ladder, two mounts dedicated for mooring whips and a pair of cleats for securing a tender.

Deck and hull equipment

Forward, a sculpted fiberglass pulpit with an inset of teak anchors the bow, flanked by a substantial bow rail and a dedicated freshwater washdown. Ground tackle is entrusted to a CQR anchor and a Galley Maid windlass, spooled with two hundred feet of chain. Marquipt boarding steps and a ladder are neatly stowed on each side beneath the varnished side deck handrails, which offer a refined, glossy finish. The foredeck has been thoughtfully arranged with two dunnage boxes on the bow, a forward seat furnished with cushions and a protective cover, and an expansive sunning pad complete with its own cover.

Engine and mechanical

Crafted for dependable operation, the machinery spaces are fitted with a Glendenning synchronizer to orchestrate the main engines and are supported by two 20kw Onan generators. Climate comfort is delivered through five Cruisair air conditioning/heat pump units, each managed by its own thermostat with variable fan speed control positioned in the salon, galley,

forward stateroom, side stateroom and master stateroom. Fuel delivery and cleanliness are assured by dual Racor fuel filters on the main engines and Racor filtration for the generators, while Air Seps on the mains improve engine breathing. Freshwater is treated through dedicated water filters, and routine servicing is simplified by on-board oil change systems for both engines and generators, electric fuel priming pumps for the engines, and a custom-mounted tool box. Handling and sea-keeping have been refined with Bennett trim tabs, Naiad stabilizers, hydraulic steering and Hynotic engine controls, and the propulsion package is prepared for cold starts with engine block heaters. Additional deck and utility equipment includes a Jabsco searchlight, GalleyMaid heads, a Kenmore stack clothes washer and dryer, a 40-gallon White water heater and a GalleyMaid electric windlass.

Comments and exclusions

This yacht has been kept in the freshwater of the Great Lakes since 2010, a provenance that attests to a benign environment and meticulous stewardship. Resolute is distinguished by her exceptional condition, having been in the long-term ownership of a seasoned Great Lakes yachtsman. Each year she is wintered in heated storage for approximately seven months, during which time all required maintenance and upgrades are carried out. Her paint remains in good condition and the recently refreshed interior is clean and tasteful, making a trip to Michigan well worthwhile. Courtesy showings for out-of-state brokers are welcomed. Owner's personal belongings are excluded; a complete inventory can be provided upon request.

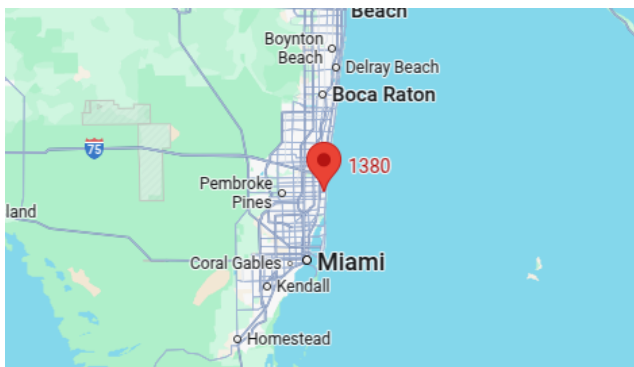
