OVERVIEW

2018 63' Viking Cockpit Motor Yacht – Refined Liveboard & Cruising Platform
Experience a harmonious marriage of home-like comfort and assured seagoing capability aboard this 63 foot Viking Cockpit Motor Yacht. Designed for prolonged cruising and effortless entertaining, she pairs Viking's renowned structural integrity with tasteful updates and owner-focused refinements, creating a vessel equally suited to full-time living, coastal passages, or extended bluewater ventures.

True full-walkaround side decks provide confident line handling and secure movement from bow to cockpit, while the full-beam owner's suite is a private sanctuary featuring a king berth, a cozy lounge, a dedicated staircase and a spacious ensuite appointed with a full-size Jacuzzi tub/shower. Forward of the companionways, three guest staterooms await, served by two heads, each fitted with stall showers for guest comfort and convenience.

The galley-up layout emphasizes sociability and practicality, with all-new appliances and contemporary finishes that flow naturally into the salon for seamless hosting. The main salon has been reimagined to feel bright, modern and inviting, and the flybridge serves as the social center—fully enclosed in Strataglass, arranged with table seating and offering direct, easy access to the salon.

Systems and engineering have been thoughtfully enhanced for dependable, long-range autonomy: upgraded Naiad stabilizers deliver composed passages; an air-conditioned, walk-in engine room simplifies maintenance; dual generators ensure redundancy; a 4,000W Magnum inverter with AGS paired with lithium batteries expands off-grid capability; and a comprehensive Garmin suite—chart plotters, HD radar, autopilot with wireless remotes, AIS, depth and wind instrumentation—provides confident navigation and situational awareness. Additional equipment includes a 1,500 lb davit, life raft, a dedicated

laundry room and numerous other practical touches.

Every upgrade was chosen to raise reliability, self-sufficiency and refinement. Whether cruising the shore, venturing offshore, or making this yacht your primary residence, this Cockpit Motor Yacht fulfills each requirement with grace and capability.

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Accommodations

Step through the double sliding glass doors into a welcoming salon where a wet bar with a dedicated ice maker and a handsome coffee table invite effortless entertaining, while digital air-conditioner control maintains perfect comfort and a graceful staircase leads to the flybridge. The gourmet-ready galley showcases marble countertops, a full-size refrigerator with ice maker and a full-sized dishwasher, both new in 2025, complemented by a microwave, four-burner stove, oven and an abundance of cabinetry and storage. Aft, the private master stateroom is a serene retreat with a king-size bed and seating area, huge cedar closets, generous under bed storage, and an ensuite head featuring a full-size Jacuzzi tub and shower; two large dressers, large glass-faced cabinets, a flat-panel TV and LED lighting complete the space. Forward of the aft master, a dedicated laundry and utility room offers an LG washer and LG dryer, large storage cabinets, a large linen closet across the hallway and direct engine room access. In the forward bow stateroom, bunk beds and a seating area pair with a private head with stall shower, a large cedar closet, built in drawers and cabinets including drawers under the bed, three portholes and LED lighting. Midship, the third stateroom provides a double bed, a large cedar closet, a Jack & Jill head with stall shower, built in drawers under the bed, built in cabinets, two portholes and LED lighting, while the fourth midship stateroom offers bunk beds, a large cedar closet, a Jack & Jill head with stall shower, built in drawers under the bed, a built in desk table, two portholes and LED lighting.

Pilot house

Command with confidence from a well-appointed pilot house centered on a

Garmin 8212 MFD, flanked by a Garmin GHC20 autopilot control with wireless autopilot remote, Garmin wind display and Garmin AIS for clear situational awareness. Communication is crisp via a Standard Horizon GX1800 VHF with built in GPS, while Naiad stabilizer controls, a Wesmar bow thruster control and trim tab controls deliver precise low speed and running attitude management. Full engine gauges and a dedicated water tank gauge keep vital systems in view, with electrical panels and a chart drawer close at hand. Digital air conditioner control and LED lighting enhance comfort and clarity for every passage.

Flybridge

Designed for all weather enjoyment, the flybridge is encased by a full enclosure with Sunbrella tops and a clear view through Strataglass and acrylic windows. A generous table with wraparound seating for eight anchors the social heart of the deck, opposite reclining captain's and mate's chairs with armrests and headrests. Entertaining is effortless with a 5 cu ft chest freezer and refrigerator, while duplicate helm equipment—Naiad stabilizer controls, a Wesmar bow thruster control, trim tab controls, a Garmin 8612 MFD, a Garmin GHC20 autopilot control with wireless remote, Garmin wind display, Garmin AIS and a Standard Horizon GX1800 VHF with built in GPS—ensures confident operation aloft.

Deck

The full walk around deck makes line handling and anchoring effortless, led by a robust Light House double windlass and a remote spotlight mounted at the tip of the bow pulpit for precise night operations. Forward, two large line storage boxes are topped with Sunbrella cushions, and a generous front seating area with matching Sunbrella cushions hides substantial storage

beneath. Fender holders keep gear orderly, while blue LED lighting casts an elegant glow after dark.

Cockpit

A broad cockpit is framed by deep, full width cabinets crowned with Corian countertops, while large stairs with an electric lift reveal dedicated scuba tank storage racks beneath. Oversized hatches open to a huge volume of storage under the cockpit, and at hand engine and bow thruster controls simplify docking. Under the cockpit sit an Onan 13.5 kW generator and spare propellers, with underwater LED lights adding drama at anchor. Outriggers and rod holders stand ready for sport, and the life raft carries certification dated 09 2022.

Engine room

A massive, air conditioned walk in engine room showcases mechanical pedigree with twin Detroit 8V92 Forward Plan engines rated at 735 hp each and showing 452 hours, benefitting from a 2019 crank up rebuild costing \$127,000 and paired with Allison transmissions. Ship's power is backed by an Onan 20 kW generator, while long range autonomy is enhanced by a 600 GPD water maker and a Mach 5 freshwater pump. Monitoring and upkeep are simplified by 2 cameras, an IsoTemp water heater, Naiad 254 stabilizers with upgraded 6 sq ft fins, an oil changing system and a fuel priming system, all arranged for clear access and efficient service.
