OVERVIEW

The inaugural MV19, a 19.50 metre motor yacht, represents the natural progression of the MV13, conceived in collaboration between Francesco Paszkowski Design and Baglietto. Its exterior proportions and interior atmosphere converse as one, a seamless interplay of line and light that conceals rigorous engineering. Baglietto's in-house technical team penned the planing hull and specified the onboard systems and propulsion, marrying assured performance with the refinement demanded of a premium open yacht, a sporty cruiser and a high performance dayboat.

The MV series draws inspiration from the MAS boats of the First and Second World Wars, paying tribute to the naval prototypes that forged the Ligurian shipyard's reputation. Those unmistakable silhouettes are reinterpreted with a crisp, contemporary restraint and layered with architectural cues from the open yacht genre, producing a modern express cruiser that balances military bred character with the polish and presence of a superyacht.

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Electrical equipment

Reliable shore power inlet supports dockside energy needs, complemented by a Kohler 13 kW generator showing just 26 hours to deliver quiet, efficient autonomy under way, while a high capacity inverter bridges loads seamlessly to keep sensitive electronics and hotel services running cleanly and uninterrupted regardless of the source.

Electronics

A fully integrated electronics suite is centered on Furuno instrumentation, combining an echo sounder, radar, log speedometer, GPS, compass, autopilot and VHF to ensure confident navigation and reliable communications, while onboard entertainment and ambiance are elevated by a TV set, a CD player and clear cockpit speakers, and a dependable radio completes the system for everyday convenience.

Inside equipment

Close quarters control is provided by a Side Power SE170-250T bow thruster, while onboard comfort is assured by a Veco air conditioning system rated at 50,000 BTU, a 75 L hot water system and premium refrigeration by Gaggenau; long range independence is delivered by a Supermini Idromar fresh water maker producing 8,600 l/day, and life aboard is kept effortlessly self sufficient thanks to a washing machine and a robust battery charger.

Outside equipment

Expanses of teak on the cockpit and sidedecks create an inviting exterior, complemented by a refreshing cockpit shower and a hydraulic gangway for elegant boarding; leisure is effortless with a tender driven by an electric engine, a liferaft for 10 persons, comfortable cockpit cushions and a sturdy cockpit table, while a swimming ladder provides easy access to the water for sunning and swimming.

Additional information

Propulsion and control are refined through a ZF 2070V gearbox driving water lubricated Marinox 17 shafts of 90 mm diameter, guided by an electro hydraulic rudder control system for precise helm response; ground tackle is robust with a 24V anchor windlass, a 40 kg hook type anchor on 75 m of 10 mm chain and a 24V mooring capstan to ensure secure, stress free docking. Entertainment and connectivity impress with Apple TV avt, an IR Kit receiver, Bluetooth speakers and an internal Wi Fi network tied to the main rack with 3 access points. Culinary arrangements are professional grade, featuring a Gaggenau VI electric hob paired with a Foster Domino S400 Ghost hood, a Vitifrigo icemaker, a Frigonautica cockpit fridge and a dedicated glass washer, while the exterior finish in Awlcraft/Dupont keeps the hull gleaming. Two Seakeeper stabilizers preserve comfort when seas build, and a full list of works is available upon request.
