Her open flush deck arrangement fosters a seamless, welcoming flow throughout the vessel, while a spacious stand up engine room provides superb access to machinery and simplifies routine maintenance. Onboard systems include a modern navigation suite, active stabilization for a composed ride at sea, twin generators and a dedicated watermaker, all tied into comprehensive ship systems designed for true bluewater, long range motoryacht cruising. Blending timeless craftsmanship with purposeful engineering, this meticulously serviced and beautifully kept Grand Alaskan 64 pilothouse trawler is turnkey and ready for immediate departure on refined coastal passages or discerning long distance adventures.

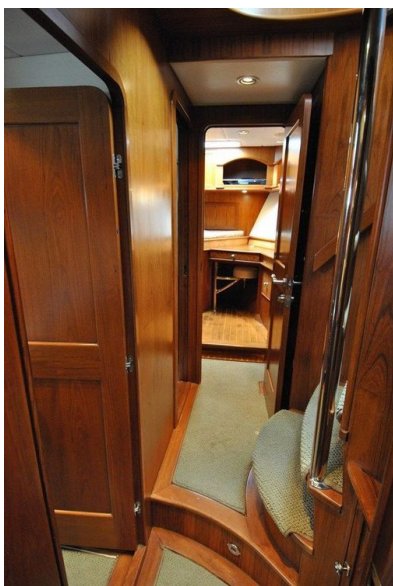

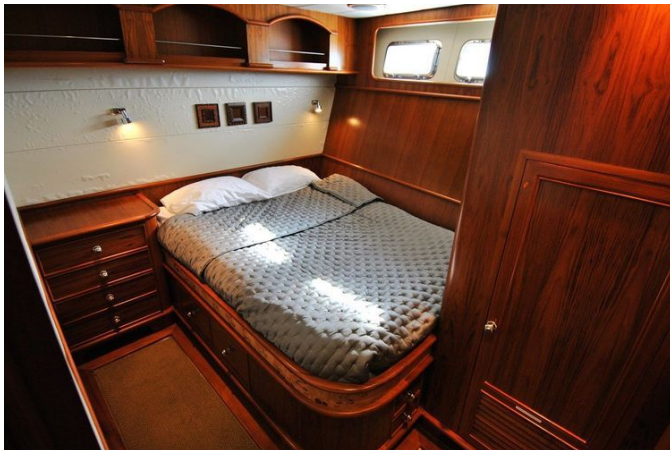

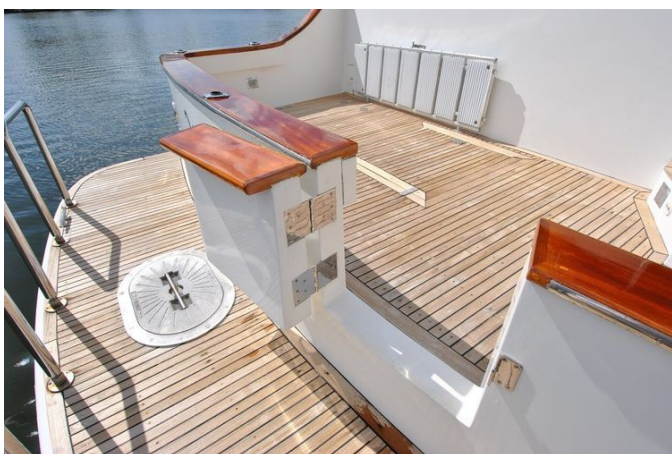

# DETAILED DESCRIPTION

---

## Overview

---

WANDERER is a distinguished example of the Grand Alaskan 64 flush deck lineage, combining enduring, classic lines with generous living spaces, long range capability and an exceptionally quiet, stable ride. The interior offers four staterooms and four heads, centered on an expansive full beam master suite, while a voluminous salon opens seamlessly to a high spec galley fitted with premium appliances, granite countertops and plentiful storage, accompanied by a convenient day head and a dedicated pilothouse. Entertainment and outdoor living are effortless aboard the large aft deck, full walk around side decks and an extremely spacious flybridge laid out for easy socializing. Systems access is excellent thanks to a large, full beam, stand up aft engine room that affords superb reach to all machinery. Propulsion is provided by twin Caterpillar diesel engines, which cruise economically at 10 knots and yield an estimated range of roughly 600 nautical miles, supported by a turnkey equipment package that includes Naiad stabilizers, dual generators, a bow thruster and recent servicing. Navigation and safety systems are comprehensive, led by advanced Furuno electronics augmented with a FLIR thermal camera and a Simrad autopilot, delivering confidence whether enjoying weekend escapes or undertaking extended passages.

## Accommodations

---

WANDERER's flush-deck configuration creates an open, airy environment and houses four generously sized staterooms. The VIP cabin is located amidships to port and benefits from its own en suite, while forward a twin guest cabin to port and a single twin/crew cabin in the bow share a head. Located aft, the master stateroom provides a notably smooth ride and tranquil

accommodation, with abundant space and storage, an extra-large queen berth with en suite head, exceptional drawer and hanging-locker capacity, and straightforward access to the aft portion of the engine room.

## Salon

---

The salon is crafted for leisurely indulgence, featuring an integrated television complemented by a sumptuous, immersive home theater system that elevates time at anchor or underway into a polished, cinema-quality experience.

## Day head

---

The day head features a Planus freshwater flush head set within a refined interior, where a black granite countertop and a stainless wash basin are paired with a mirror, blending luxurious finishes and dependable functionality to form an inviting onboard retreat.

## Galley

---

Designed for the gourmet entertainer, the galley showcases a KitchenAid four-burner ceramic glass cooktop and a full-size KitchenAid refrigerator, accompanied by a Bosch stainless dishwasher, all arranged against a striking black granite countertop finished with stainless fiddles. A double-basin stainless sink is equipped with a hot-and-cold faucet sprayer, an instant hot water spigot, a built-in soap dispenser and an InSinkErator garbage disposal to make cleanup effortless. For quick toasting, broiling and reheating, the space is furnished with a GE stainless toaster, a Black and Decker toaster oven/broiler and a GE convection microwave oven.

## Pilothouse and lower helm

---

The pilothouse and lower helm form an elegant command center, where an L-shaped aft settee with a varnished teak table provides a comfortable setting for conversation opposite a Stidd helm chair situated before a full complement of navigation and control electronics. A varnished teak-and-holly sole lends classic warmth beneath, while the thoughtful layout offers direct aft access to the galley, day head and salon, stairs ascending to the flybridge and a passage below that leads forward to guest and crew accommodations. Port and starboard wing doors add protection and make movement effortless in all conditions.

## Owner's stateroom and ensuite

---

Privately reached via its own separate companionway aft of the salon, the owner's stateroom is a tranquil sanctuary centered on a centerline queen walkaround berth. Meticulous finishes include abundant locker and drawer storage, a plush carpeted sole, and opening ports that admit generous natural light and refreshing sea air. Functionality is elegantly woven into the layout with direct access to a lower foyer fitted with a washer and dryer, as well as a dedicated entrance to the engine room for routine inspections. The private ensuite head completes the suite with both a tub and a shower, ensuring luxurious comfort after a day on the water.

## VIP stateroom

---

A sanctuary of refined privacy and comfort, the VIP stateroom is anchored by a queen-size offset berth and brightened by two opening ports that welcome natural light; two adjustable reading lamps provide intimate, tailored illumination. Entertainment is seamless with a TV, DVD player and integrated

sound system, while abundant locker and drawer storage ensures garments and personal items remain discreetly and elegantly stowed.

## Guest stateroom

---

The guest stateroom has been fashioned as an elegant sanctuary, fitted with a TV/VCR combo and an integrated sound system to provide refined in-cabin entertainment. Ingeniously configured crisscross single berths maximize the available footprint without compromising comfort, while a generous hanging locker and plentiful drawer storage offer room for belongings on extended passages. Opening ports draw in natural light and a fresh sea breeze, enhancing the tranquil, airy atmosphere.

## Crew quarters and guest cabin

---

Designed for versatility and comfort, this cabin features a single fore-and-aft berth to port with convenient drawer storage beneath, paired with a practical writing desk fitted with a swing-out stool. Generous locker and drawer space allows personal belongings to be neatly stowed, while the warm teak-and-holly sole enriches the cabin's refined ambiance. Natural light and fresh air are welcomed through a large opening overhead hatch and two opening ports, and onboard entertainment is provided by a TV with DVD player.

## Guest head

---

Thoughtfully arranged to serve the yacht's three guest cabins, the guest head marries refined aesthetics with practical detailing, boasting a dedicated stall shower and an opening port that ushers in natural light and ventilation, while a warm teak-and-holly sole rests underfoot. A dramatic black granite countertop is contrasted by a stainless wash basin for a crisp, contemporary finish, and a

Planus freshwater-flush head provides whisper-quiet, dependable operation.

## Aft deck

---

An inviting aft seat, appointed with generous cushions and discrete storage beneath, anchors the deck and provides an elegant spot to relax or ready gear. New enclosure screens and blackout shades installed in 2025 offer immediate privacy and comfort, while boarding gates to port and starboard ensure effortless side access. Safety is thoughtfully addressed with a readily accessible throwable life ring, and a seamlessly integrated cabinet contains organized drawers alongside a dedicated trash bin to keep the space tidy and highly functional.

## Flybridge

---

The flybridge is crafted for elegant alfresco living, anchored by a stainless Solaire propane grill that simplifies open-air cooking and a pair of Stidd helm chairs that combine luxurious support with confident command at the wheel. A comprehensive suite of electronics provides assured navigation and thorough systems oversight. An L-shaped settee embraces a versatile high-low table ideal for dining or cocktails, and a brand-new ice maker—currently not hooked up—awaits final commissioning.

## Hull and deck equipment

---

A sense of assurance under way begins with a Portuguese bridge that incorporates a door forward to the bow, and embarking is made effortless by Marquipt folding boarding stairs. Fresh water washdowns serve the foredeck, aft deck, engine room and flybridge, while an opening cockpit transom door provides streamlined access to the water. Ground tackle is substantial, with a

Maxwell windlass delivering chain rode to a stainless plow anchor, and onboard safety gear includes a Switlik liferaft that is not currently certified. The decks combine timeless elegance and sure footing with teak laid over fiberglass, complemented by an assortment of fenders, lines and throwable devices. Comfort aloft was enhanced with a new three-quarter enclosure in 2024, and tender operations are simplified by a Nautical Structures EZ1500 LB tender davit; the yacht is offered with a Novurania tender fitted with a 60 hp engine and cradle, plus a jetski cradle for additional versatility.

## Electronics and navigation

---

Command is effortless from a bridge outfitted with two Furuno TZTouch Black Box navigation units driving two Furuno TZTouch 14" displays, anchored by a Furuno GP330B GPS antenna and a Furuno XN12A 4' open array radar for long-range detection. Absolute positional accuracy and situational awareness are reinforced by a Furuno satellite compass, a Furuno TruEcho CHIRP fish finder/depth sounder, a Furuno NavNet 2D Ethernet hub and a Furuno NX-500 Navtex receiver. Instrumentation and system data are rendered with clarity on two Maretron DSM250-01 multi-function colour displays and four Simrad IS40 colour digital instruments, while a Maretron ultrasonic wind and weather station and three Hatteland 15" series X standard monitors provide comprehensive environmental and system visualization. Precise helm control is delivered by a Simrad AP20 autopilot in concert with a Glendenning wired remote engine control console, and safety and communication capabilities are heightened with an FLIR M-324XP thermal camera, a McMurdo SmartFind AIS Class A transponder and an Icom VHF radio with command mic located at the bridge. Signalling and searchlight capability are assured by a Kahlenberg Zero series chrome dual air horn and a Carlisle and Finch 200-watt xenon searchlight, supported by a Kahlenberg 24v marine air compressor and tank, while critical electronics are safeguarded by a Newport battery backup and

surge protector for the PC. Practicality for daily operation is attended to with pilothouse windshield wipers and a tank tender monitor for five tanks.

## Machinery and electrical

---

Beneath the yacht's elegant lines, propulsion is delivered by twin Caterpillar 3126 diesel engines rated at 450 hp each; both engines received full service in March 2026 and, as of May 2026, register approximately 2,500 hours on the port engine and 3,600 hours on the starboard. Power is transmitted through two Twin Disk transmissions, complemented by dripless shaft seals, with exhaust blankets installed in 2026. Onboard electrical generation is provided by an 8 kW Northern Lights generator with 2,968 hours as of May 2026 and a 16 kW Northern Lights generator showing 4,583 hours as of May 2026, all managed by a Mastervolt Mass Combi inverter/charger system equipped with a remote monitor. The yacht's charging architecture includes dedicated Mastervolt 24 V and 12 V battery chargers as well as a Mastervolt 48 V charger specifically for the Wesmar 10 hp 48 V bow thruster. The DC bank comprises seven 8D batteries replaced in August 2025 and two Group 21 batteries renewed in February 2025, while onboard systems for service and comfort include a Reverso oil change system, Naiad stabilizers, a Village Marine 800 GPD watermaker, five air-conditioning compressors, a Bosch 500 Series clothes washer/dryer and four electric bilge pumps.

## Broker remarks

---

Grand Alaskan 64 models rarely appear on the market, and when they do they seldom remain available long; WANDERER is therefore a particularly uncommon find. Meticulously updated and with all mechanical services fully current, she is turnkey and ready to cruise this summer. Offered as her owner elects to spend more time ashore, she presents in very nice shape and will not

disappoint upon inspection.

Across successive owners WANDERER has proven her capabilities time and again, cruising the U.S. West Coast and Alaska, voyaging to South America and transiting the Panama Canal, exploring the entirety of the Caribbean and the Bahamas, and ranging along the U.S. East Coast and the Chesapeake. She has even navigated to the Great Lakes via the Hudson River and Champlain Canal, and under current ownership has again covered the East Coast as well as the Florida Gulf Coast. True to her name, this vessel has indeed been a wanderer.

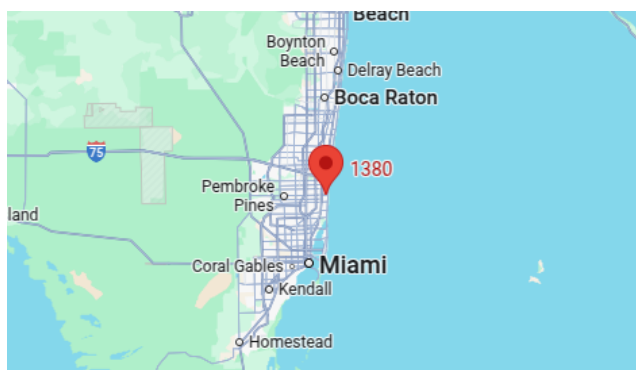
