Designed by renowned naval architect Donald Blount and constructed by esteemed Carolina builder Jim Pollatte, she was jig-built with traditional cold-molded techniques to produce the classic Carolina flare and the soft, dry, fuel-efficient ride that defines the finest examples of Carolina custom craftsmanship.

Stepping inside reveals a beautifully executed cherrywood interior featuring four generous staterooms and three heads, all preserved in impeccable condition. The fit and finish exhibit artisanal joinery and a level of detail that speaks to quiet luxury and exacting standards; thoughtful layout and elegant woodwork combine to create an environment that is both sumptuous and inherently practical for extended passages.

Whether your plans include offshore sportfishing, long-range cruising, or campaigning as a tournament-capable convertible, ROMPEOLA delivers the bluewater performance, seakeeping, and pedigree discriminating owners expect. 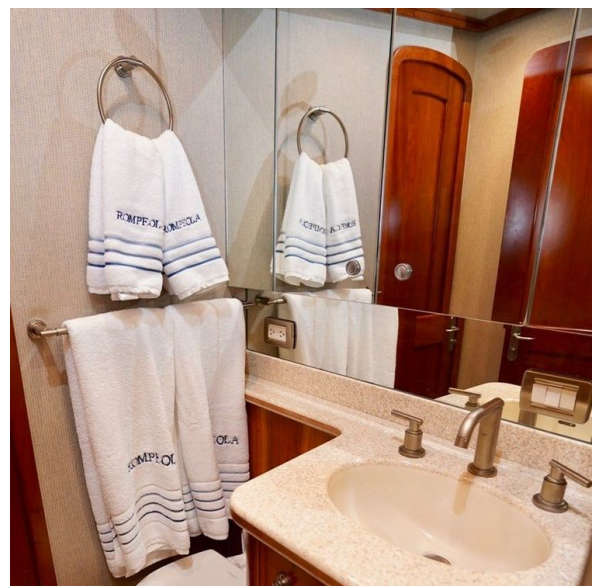

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Recent updates

Maintained to the highest standards, the yacht was hauled out of the water in 2023 for comprehensive service, during which she received fresh bottom paint, Prop Speed applied to the running gear and new cutlass bearings; she also underwent a full detail in 2022. On the tech front, the vessel benefits from an upgraded Garmin electronics package, while recent Caterpillar servicing provides added assurance of mechanical reliability.

Featured highlights

Powered by a Caterpillar C30 1550 with low hours, this yacht combines dependable performance with integrated Garmin electronics to inspire confident command. The cockpit's mezzanine seating offers a raised, comfortable vantage for enjoying the action, while classic teak decks and covering boards provide timeless elegance and superb traction underfoot. A warm cherry interior, rich with handcrafted detail, creates an inviting ambiance, and at the heart of the yacht a carefully configured island galley enhances both entertaining and everyday convenience.

Layout and accommodations

Beneath its graceful lines the yacht accommodates four generously proportioned staterooms served by three full heads, each laid out for both comfort and seclusion. The master suite is situated aft to port and includes its own en-suite head for private living quarters; forward the VIP stateroom is appointed with a double crossover berth over a lower single and also enjoys a private en-suite head. To starboard, two bunk cabins fitted with double

over-under berths share a head, providing a versatile sleeping configuration that makes the most of the interior space without sacrificing convenience.

Salon

Clad in sumptuous cherry veneers, the salon is a sanctuary for relaxation, centered around an L-shaped settee with cleverly integrated storage and paired with a handcrafted teak dining table and coordinating end table that make entertaining effortless. Generous cabinet space preserves the room's uncluttered elegance, while plush carpeting beneathfoot and custom-fitted blinds at the windows enhance both comfort and privacy. Concealed within the woodwork, a motorized pop-up LG television rises at the touch of a button, delivering a discreet yet sophisticated media experience that complements the room's clean, refined aesthetic.

Galley

At the yacht's center, an island galley has been thoughtfully arranged for entertaining, with sleek Corian countertops surrounding a stainless sink fitted with a disposal and an exhaust fan to keep the air fresh. Ample cabinets and drawers provide orderly storage for every implement, while four Sub Zero drawer-style refrigeration drawers and a wine cooler fridge bar ensure provisions are kept perfectly chilled. A GE Profile range, a Panasonic microwave and a Wolfe toaster oven answer every culinary need; two bar stools at the island create a casual perch and a dinette with integrated storage comfortably seats six. The space is grounded by a Teak and Holly sole and enriched with warm cherry veneers, imparting timeless sophistication.

Master stateroom

Situated aft on the port side, the master stateroom features a centerline queen berth with discreet concealed storage, creating a tranquil private retreat framed by a mirrored bulkhead and rich cherry veneers. Twin lighted end tables border the bed while two generous hanging lockers and plentiful drawer storage provide ample organization; plush carpet and carefully selected designer soft goods heighten the luxurious ambiance. Practical conveniences include efficient LED lighting, conveniently placed GFI outlets, and a television for effortless comfort and entertainment.

Master head

The master head is elegantly outfitted with a vanity that provides generous storage and features a seamlessly integrated flush-mounted sink, enhanced by an illuminated mirror that bathes the space in a refined glow. A Vacu-Flush fixture ensures reliable operation, while the enclosed shower with a door creates a private, spa-like sanctuary. Underfoot, an Amptico sole pairs with rich cherry veneers to impart a warm, contemporary sophistication throughout.

VIP forward stateroom

Exquisitely appointed for both relaxation and versatility, the VIP forward stateroom features an over-under berth, with a double on the upper level and a single below, accompanied by a single hanging locker and plentiful drawer storage to keep personal effects neatly stowed. Underfoot, plush carpeting and warm cherry veneers create an inviting atmosphere, while discreet LED lighting offers efficient, gentle illumination. Designer soft goods lend a polished, upscale touch, and a conveniently located GFI outlet provides safe, reliable power for phones and other devices.

VIP head

This en-suite refuge is outfitted with a vanity offering ample storage, a flush-mounted sink and an illuminated mirror that blends refined aesthetics with everyday practicality. A reliable Vacu-Flush system ensures effortless operation, while the fully enclosed shower with a proper door delivers complete privacy and comfort. Underfoot, the durable Amptico sole provides a polished, long-wearing surface, and sumptuous cherry veneers lend the space warm, yacht-grade sophistication.

Bunk rooms

The starboard stateroom features an over-under double berth accompanied by a single hanging locker and generous drawer storage, all cushioned by soft carpeting underfoot. Rich cherry veneers provide a refined backdrop while carefully chosen designer soft goods elevate the atmosphere; practical conveniences include LED lighting, a GFI outlet and a television.

Mirroring this thoughtful layout, the port guest stateroom also offers an over-under double berth with one hanging locker and ample drawer storage, set atop plush carpeting and surrounded by warm cherry veneers and designer soft goods. LED lighting, a GFI outlet and a television complete this inviting guest accommodation.

Shared head

Meticulously designed for both utility and elegance, the shared head features a vanity with generous stowage and a flush-mounted sink positioned beneath an illuminated mirror to create a crisp, contemporary ambience. A Vacu-Flush toilet provides dependable, efficient operation, while a fully enclosed shower with a door delivers privacy and ease of use. Warm cherry veneers and a

resilient Amptico sole introduce rich, tactile surfaces that underscore the yacht's superior craftsmanship.

Flybridge

Bespoke for both command and conviviality, the flybridge is sheltered by a three-sided enclosure and revolves around a pair of helm chairs that offer unobstructed sightlines and assured handling. Carefully configured seating with integrated storage maintains a clean, guest-ready environment, while a belly band equipped with rod holders underscores the yacht's fishing credentials. Additional brow compartments and a storage-equipped console increase capacity for essential equipment, and a robust handrail provides steady support when underway.

Electronics and navigation

Navigation and entertainment systems are seamlessly blended, anchored by a Garmin Electronics black box that supports an integrated suite of radar, sounder and GPS for precise situational awareness. Reliable ship-to-shore and onboard communications are provided by two VHF radios, while onboard leisure is refined by a Bose surround-sound stereo and LG televisions, all delivered via a single KVH TV antenna to guarantee consistent reception.

Miscellaneous deck and hull

The foredeck presents a assured, secure profile, edged by a substantial bow rail and a teak pulpit safeguarded by a stainless guard, while anchoring duties are made effortless by a Maxwell windlass. Ground tackle is comprehensive: a single Max stainless-steel plow anchor is partnered with 300 feet of 3/8-inch chain, and a Danforth anchor with its own rode provides an alternative holding

option. Exterior finishes are executed in sumptuous teak—toe rail, hand rail, covering boards and a full teak deck—blending robust construction with timeless elegance.

Engine room

A mirrored ceiling amplifies ambient light and sightlines in this immaculate machinery space, drawing attention to the pair of Caterpillar turbo diesel inboard engines—Model C30—each rated at 1,550 HP and serving as the vessel’s mechanical centerpiece. These engines record original hours of 1,750 as of 3-20-23, with the port unit marked #CLX00504 and the starboard #CLX00501, and the aftercoolers having received service at 1,700 hours. Propulsion and torque transfer are handled by ZF Marine transmissions, while ship’s services rely on two Northern Lights generator sets rated at 21 KW, the port generator showing 3,941 hours and the starboard 3,882 hours. Practicality and safety have been carefully considered, including a Fireboy FE 241 fire suppression system and a neatly arranged tool box for maintenance readiness.

Electrical system

A custom backlit electrical panel commands the yacht’s power distribution, paired with a pair of Northern Lights generator sets, each rated at 21 kW, and twin 50-amp, 240 VAC shore-power connections for dependable marina hookup. The 12 VDC network handles engine starting and onboard services, drawing from ten AGM marine batteries housed in bespoke battery boxes and maintained at optimal charge by a single 60-amp battery charger.

Cockpit

Crafted for leisurely days afloat, the cockpit marries plush comfort with

thoughtful functionality, featuring mezzanine-level cushioned seating tucked beneath an extended overhang for sheltered relaxation. Underfoot, sumptuous teak decking and matching teak covering boards imbue the space with refined warmth, while an onboard freezer and a dedicated drink box ensure provisions remain perfectly chilled. An in-deck fish box with an integrated ice dump simplifies catch handling, and the well-considered layout is rounded out by hawse pipes, efficient scuppers and a robust transom door that provide safe, seamless access.

Fishing

Engineered for serious sportfishing pursuits, this yacht is outfitted with a commanding PipeWelders tower and precision outriggers to provide exceptional sightlines and an ideal spread. Strategically placed teaser reels are ready to entice the strike, while dedicated 24V outlets deliver dependable power to electric reels and other onboard accessories. Expansive tackle lockers and integrated rod storage keep equipment protected, impeccably organized and immediately at hand when the action heats up.

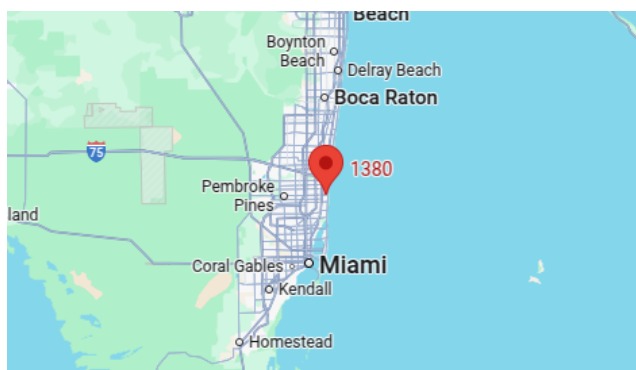
