OVERVIEW

Pershing 64 (2008) — Performance, Craftsmanship, and Italian Poise

A paragon of engineering and Italian refinement, this 2008 Pershing 64 from the Ferretti Group embodies the spirit of the contemporary open sport yacht. Penetrating lines conceived by Fulvio De Simoni marry advanced naval architecture with aesthetic grace, producing an express cruiser that thrills at the helm and soothes in its finishes. With a dramatic silhouette, sumptuous appointments, and a purposeful bearing, the 64 established a high-water mark for luxury sport yachts.

From every vantage the boat reads as deliberately low and streamlined, each sweep of hull and deck crafted for both velocity and beauty. Pershing's signature metallic paintwork underscores its athletic intent, while oversized hull windows flood the interior with daylight. The aft glass bulkhead lowers completely to erase the boundary between salon and cockpit, creating a single, airy lounge that fosters a true indoor-outdoor connection ideal for Mediterranean day trips or elegant nights at anchor.

A retractable hardtop invites the sky aboard at the touch of a switch, while under the sculpted deck lies formidable propulsion: twin MAN V12 diesels, 1,550 hp each, showing just 1,450 hours, coupled to Arneson Surface Drives that deliver exhilarating acceleration. This high-performance motor yacht can reach approximately 45 knots and cruises comfortably at 36–38 knots, offering razor-sharp, confidence-inspiring handling that feels more sports car than displacement yacht.

Beneath her performance lies substance — a deep-V hull and vacuum-bagged GRP construction that yield stiffness, hydrodynamic efficiency, and a composed ride as speeds climb. Inside, the mood is unmistakably Italian: refined, contemporary, and impeccably executed. The salon is appointed with Poltrona Frau leather seating, finely finished joinery, and thoughtful modern

detailing that favors restrained elegance over ostentation.

Accommodation is set up for extended cruising with three en-suite cabins, including a full-beam owner's suite amidships with panoramic windows, a forward VIP, and a twin guest cabin, each delivering privacy, polished comfort, and ample storage. Whether imagined as a fast family motor yacht or a sleek weekend sports cruiser, the Pershing 64 offers a rare fusion of speed, style, and sophistication for those who expect the exceptional.



DETAILED DESCRIPTION

M/Y PAX

Pershing 64 (2008) — power, precision, and Italian elegance converge in M/Y PAX, a yacht that perfectly marries high performance engineering from Pershing, part of the Ferretti Group, with the refined aesthetic of Fulvio De Simoni. From the first glance her lines are unmistakable: sleek, aggressive, and fluid, each curve sculpted to channel air for performance and to create a seamless visual harmony between hull and superstructure, while the signature Pershing silver finish underscores her sporting DNA and large side windows flood the interior with natural light. A hallmark of this model is the effortless connection between inside and out: the glass aft bulkhead slides down completely, uniting salon and cockpit into a single expansive entertainment space, and the retractable hardtop opens the yacht to the sky in true Pershing style. Beneath the sculpted exterior lies serious capability: twin MAN V12 diesel engines producing 1,550 horsepower each, with only 1,450 hours on each unit, coupled to Arneson Surface Drives to deliver exhilarating performance — turnkey ready to cruise at forty knots and capable of reaching up to forty five knots. Acceleration, agility, and stability at sea are exceptional for a yacht of this size, and at a steady thirty six to thirty eight knots the handling remains precise and composed, giving the captain a sports car like sense of control. The deep V hull and vacuum bagged fiberglass construction ensure strength, efficiency, and a remarkably smooth ride. Inside, craftsmanship is unmistakably Italian: the salon exudes understated luxury with premium Poltrona Frau leather, fine wood cabinetry, and modern detailing throughout, while the intelligent layout offers three en suite cabins sleeping six guests — a full beam master amidships with panoramic windows, a forward VIP, and a twin guest cabin — each designed for privacy and comfort on extended

cruises, and a separate cabin for the captain or crew adds practicality for longer passages and effortless guest service. Meticulous, year-round service has been performed proactively across every system so ownership remains as effortless as the yacht's performance. PAX is comprehensively equipped with desirable extras including two generators, a stern thruster, and a watermaker, while the tender "PAX" is a Williams 3.25 Jet with 100 HP neatly stowed in the spacious garage. This Pershing 64 redefines the modern open sport yacht, marrying aerodynamic styling and advanced naval architecture with the thrill of pure speed and the calm assurance of impeccable engineering.
