OVERVIEW

Widely regarded as one of the era's finest large sportfishing hulls, the Viking 65 Convertible has long been a standard-bearer among bluewater sportfish and convertible flybridge motor yachts. More than eighty hulls were built before the model was succeeded by the 68 Convertible in 2006. Purpose-designed for tournament intensity yet finished with accommodations worthy of extended cruising, the 65C pairs a capacious, competition-ready cockpit with an elegant four-stateroom, three-head interior and the high-performance diesel pedigree capable of sustaining cruising speeds in excess of 30 knots. Equal parts offshore fishing platform and luxurious cruising yacht, the Viking 65 Convertible remains a coveted choice for serious anglers and discerning yachtsmen.

This 2000 Viking 65 Convertible offers a rare opportunity to restore a legendary sportfisher at an attractive entry point. Acquired by the present owner during the COVID period after a prior sinking, the hull received structural repairs, was returned to flotation, and was moved to Quincy, Massachusetts. The yacht remained afloat there for roughly two years while initial refit work began; during that interval the electrical distribution panels were rebuilt, cleaned and re-energized, establishing important electrical groundwork for a comprehensive restoration. The boat is now land-stored and presented as an in-progress project, ready for an owner who values Viking's celebrated ride, range and fishability to carry the next phase of renewal.

Originally driven by twin MTU diesel engines, both powerplants are believed to be seized; one engine has been partially disassembled and related components are included with the sale. Prospective buyers should plan for a full mechanical repower or a comprehensive engine rebuild. Structurally,

however, her hull, flybridge and superstructure, tournament cockpit and generous interior layout remain excellent foundations for a tailored refit—whether the buyer envisions a hard-charging offshore sportfisher, an opulent cruising yacht, or a versatile convertible that blends both ambitions. No trailer is included in this sale; any transport equipment will need to be arranged separately. Nationwide and international logistics can be coordinated through established marine transport partners, with options for custom cradles and port delivery to facilitate shipment and export.
