Cherished by her original owners since delivery, she has received ongoing upgrades and meticulous engineering attention to ensure peak reliability, comfort, and true bluewater capability, rendering her tournament-ready for offshore expeditions. Propulsion is delivered by robust C32 CATs with all services carried out by ACE Marine. Notable equipment includes a 2024 Seakeeper 26, MAQ sonar, dual generators, twin ice chippers, a watermaker with purifier, Sea Strong pumps fitted with an ElectroSea strainer, Rite Air, and more—positioning this luxury motor yacht, enclosed-bridge flybridge sportfish, and convertible cruiser as a turnkey, high-performance standout.



# DETAILED DESCRIPTION

---

## Layout

---

A four-stateroom layout elevates privacy and comfort for owners and guests alike, all wrapped in a rich, yacht-wide gloss finish that amplifies natural light and showcases the craftsmanship at every turn.

## Decor

---

Thoughtful details define the interior, beginning with salon door-type catches on every stateroom door for a secure, silent close. The lounging experience is elevated by an upgraded Dewberry-style sofa in Ultraleather Brisa Distressed Muslin with a storage arm and a tight channel back, complemented by an additional Ultraleather Brisa Distressed channel-back sofa to mirror the aesthetic across the salon. Wrapped hatch carpet installation and carpet throughout in Fabrica River Song lend a tailored foundation, while custom wallpaper and a custom headliner material throughout the boat create an effortlessly cohesive atmosphere. Brushed nickel hardware, brushed nickel cover plates for switches and receptacles, and satin nickel interior light trim continue the refined metalwork theme, with LED interior lighting throughout for modern efficiency and mood. Interior doors are crafted stile-and-rail in random teak, and curtain boards with wood panel inserts integrate warm, architectural accents. At the helm, a black helm chair pairs with a companion seat in Kidskin Opal with self welt, while the mezzanine cushions—back and seat in Sunbrella Bella Linen with neck and knee lumbar in Cocoa—promise enduring outdoor elegance. Barstools without backs in Kidskin Opal with welt in Ultraleather Brisa Distressed complete the bar scene with luxurious texture and durability.

## Salon

---

The salon welcomes with a powered salon door for effortless entry and a timeless cocktail table at the heart of the space. Ambiance is tuned to perfection via dimmers for quartz lighting and a separate dimmer for overhead LED lights, all set against rich S&I teak trim, teak valances, and teak strips in the headliner that frame the room with handcrafted warmth. Practical luxury meets durability at the entrance with custom Amtico flooring, while dining is anchored by a teak dinette table on a teak pedestal. Entertainment is immersive with a Bose V35 system featuring Blu-ray, and day-to-day convenience is enhanced by a discreet day head within the salon.

## Salon day head

---

The salon day head is finished in custom Amtico flooring and features a bespoke Cambria Windermere vanity top with a precise 1/4" beveled edge, blending everyday utility with yacht-level refinement.

## Galley/dinette

---

The galley is tailored for seagoing culinary excellence with custom Amtico flooring underfoot and a stainless-steel undermount sink paired to a satin nickel faucet beneath a bespoke Cambria Windermere countertop with a crisp 1/4" beveled edge. Power access is intuitive, with a 110V outlet placed beside the switch at the bottom of the upper cabinet above the sink and an A/C receptacle tucked beneath the dinette table. A compacting trash system tidies waste at the touch of a button, while meals gather naturally around a teak dinette table on a pedestal to make every service feel relaxed and refined.

---

## Master stateroom

---

The master stateroom exudes calm sophistication, highlighted by teak end table tops that feel timeless to the touch and anchored by a luxurious 46" flat-screen television, professionally installed for effortless viewing from the berth.

---

## Master head

---

A sanctuary of practicality and polish, the master head features custom Amtico flooring and a bespoke Cambria Windermere vanity top with a clean 1/4" beveled edge. Satin nickel shower fixtures and a satin nickel faucet offer a cool, modern contrast to the warm teak face on the lower vanity, with a mirror surrounding the upper vanity insert and a mirrored ceiling that expand light and space. Brushed nickel towel bars and rings complete the spa-like presentation with enduring resilience.

---

## Forward stateroom

---

The forward stateroom is crisply appointed and fitted with a 19" flat-screen television, adding modern entertainment to a serene private retreat.

---

## Forward stateroom head

---

Tailored finishes define the forward head with custom Amtico flooring and a custom Cambria Windermere vanity top edged in a precise 1/4" bevel. A custom one-piece frameless shower door showcases satin nickel shower fixtures and a satin nickel faucet, while a teak face on the lower vanity brings warmth. A mirror around the upper vanity insert, brushed nickel towel bars and rings, and a mirrored ceiling deliver a bright, spa-inspired ambiance.

## Starboard stateroom

---

The starboard stateroom is thoughtfully equipped with a 19" flat-screen television and crowned with a refined teak locker top, pairing function with artisanal finish.

## Starboard stateroom head

---

In the starboard head, a custom Cambria Windermere vanity top with a 1/4" beveled edge meets a chrome shower door for a crisp, contemporary note. Satin nickel shower fixtures and a satin nickel faucet provide tactile luxury against the teak face of the lower vanity, while a mirror surrounding the upper vanity insert and a mirrored ceiling open the room to light. Brushed nickel towel bars and rings complete the refined, salt-air-resilient detailing.

## Crew stateroom

---

Designed for comfort on passage, the crew stateroom includes a 19" flat-screen television and a teak locker top, ensuring the team enjoys the same quality finishes as guests.

## Crew head

---

The crew head is finished to shipyard standards with custom Amtico flooring and a Cambria Windermere vanity top cut with a precise 1/4" beveled edge. A chrome shower door frames satin nickel shower fixtures and a satin nickel faucet, complemented by a teak face on the lower vanity and a mirror around the upper vanity insert. Brushed nickel towel bars and rings and a mirrored ceiling deliver durability and a bright, open feel.

## Cockpit

---

Purpose-built for action and après, the mezzanine cockpit integrates three rod holders in each haunch and both two 24V outlets and two 12V outlets forward under the coaming, one on each side, keeping tackle and tech ready at hand. An Awlgrip-finished lazarette, a Y-valve for fresh and salt-water washdowns, and storage lockers under the port and starboard coamings bring professional-grade utility, while the starboard mezzanine undermounted step box is refrigerated for quick-grab provisions. A split lid for the cockpit fish box and a transom box plumbed as a live well without window or light cater to serious angling, as freezer storage in the mezzanine seat extends your time on the bite. Tri-color LED lights in red, white, and blue illuminate the cockpit overhang, and a teak cockpit sole and mezzanine set the scene with timeless yachting elegance.

## Flybridge

---

The enclosed flybridge commands with electronic trolling valves and a single Stidd helm chair, bringing precision and posture together at the helm. A powder-coated bridge ladder, teak bridge table, and an additional Moppa burl table elevate the environment, while a 19" flat-screen television adds a lounge-worthy touch. Control is intuitive with single-lever controls featuring bow thruster buttons for the aft station, and S&I US9 HDR teaser reels with remotes in the tower keep the spread flawlessly managed. VHF communication comes via the Icom-604 for crisp, reliable reach.

## Electronics

---

Connectivity begins with STARLINK to keep you online far beyond the horizon. Navigation confidence is anchored by a Furuno NavNet 3D suite with a Furuno

6' radar array and Furuno plotter, while plotting expands via a Furuno TZT BB plotter processor, a Furuno MCU002 TZT remote control, a Furuno GPS antenna, and a Furuno IF NMEA2K interface; a complementary plotting solution runs Nobeltec TZ Trident software. NavNet peripherals include a Furuno NavNet Ethernet hub and Furuno LAN cable, along with a Shakespeare Phase III 6396 4' antenna and a Shakespeare Phase III 6420 AM/FM antenna for crystal-clear reception. Sonar intelligence comes from a Furuno CHIRP sounder with an Airmar 1kW transducer, while digital depth and temperature are displayed via a Furuno data organizer and display paired to a Furuno transducer. VHF communication is delivered by ICOM VHF radio equipment with ICOM VHF flush mount, a Shakespeare Phase III 18' VHF antenna, an AME tower/hardtop Rupp mount, and a 3/4" antenna standoff pipe. At the helm, three Beetratics displays (2026) present data with sharp clarity. Visual awareness is enhanced by four GOST PM Mini Ball cameras and a Black Oak night vision camera (2026), and an ACR spotlight stands ready to pierce the dark. Security is safeguarded by GOST Phantom 2.1 AME security tracking, including one GOST Phantom head unit. The aft station mirrors capability with Furuno NavNet, while after-hours allure gleams from Lumishore color changing lights with controller—two FF UWL lights paired to the E.O.S controller for effortless ambiance control.

## **Palm Beach Tuna Tower**

---

The Palm Beach Tuna Tower crowns the profile with a tower tailored to a 66' enclosed bridge in brushed pipe, featuring two antennas with stand-offs and halyards and a center ladder seamlessly recessed by cutting and patching the aft enclosed-bridge hardtop overhang. The molded standing platform carries a coupler box, with two molded single LED spreader light pods with stainless-steel bezels on the aft platform and a single molded LED spreader light with stainless-steel bezel forward. A 63" control box with a flush-mounted

compass, a recessed electronics box with lids, and a satin black control box finish ensure clean ergonomics, while a molded tower sunshade with internal tracks, three welded antenna mounts, and a black sunshade frame provide shade and strength; an antenna mount supports a SAT TV dome. Lighting is fully integrated with a stern light molded into the aft bridge overhang, three spreader lights, an anchor light on the sunshade, and a masthead light beneath the control box, plus recessed tri-color lights in the tower platform and sunshade wired to power both. Rupp 43' outriggers with three-spreader "Big Riggs HD" and a heavy aft bar include Rupp rollers installed in place of eye bolts. A three-sided bridge rail with a double aft one and one quarter inch pipe, eight polished rod holders, CAT controls and steering, and navigation lights molded port and starboard into the platform underscore total control. At hand are a trim tab switch on the control box, a bow thruster joystick on the control box, and a fresh water outlet in the tower. Comfort is considered with two corner seats with cushions below the belly ring and a corner seat with cushion at the aft bridge rail, while two CAT Mini MPD engine displays and flag staffs beneath each side platform perimeter rail complete this impeccably integrated tower.

## Hull/deck

---

Underfoot and underway, the performance package sharpens responses, aided by prop pockets that reduce draft and the assurance of a DC bow thruster. Extended range comes courtesy of an additional forward fuel tank for a total of three tanks, while oval (linear) exhaust outlets and fiberglass side thru hulls keep the profile sleek and the systems resilient. Everyday utility shines with a fresh water washdown at the bow inside the anchor locker, an anchor bracket within the locker, stainless steel gas springs for the anchor locker hatch, and recessed trim tab covers. A salon forward window mask and side mounted handrails that trace the top of the salon window refine both

aesthetics and safety, completing a hull and deck package ready for open water ambitions.

## Engine room

---

Engineered for endurance, the machinery space carries an additional 21.5 kW generator, with generator gas/water separators serving both the optional and the standard generators for quiet, clean operation. A run line from the oil change system to the cockpit dockside box simplifies service, while dual power steering pumps in place of the standard single on the port engine add redundancy and fingertip control. Fresh water is delivered by a Headhunter pump, with a 110V outlet on the aft bulkhead at the entrance for convenient tools. An access door to the crew's quarters and clear acrylic shaft log access covers round out a space designed for smart maintenance and reliable passage making.
