Belize represents Riviera's most exclusive, semi-custom collection, a boutique series manufactured in deliberately limited numbers each year to preserve rarity and ensure meticulous hands-on quality control. The 66 Sedan marries timeless Downeast-inspired lines that evoke the golden age of yachting with thoroughly contemporary engineering, performance, and creature comforts. Delivered to an exact owner brief and maintained with uncompromising attention from the first day, LYRICA has enjoyed a carefully managed life confined to New England waters, wintered indoors and cruised locally each summer, never exposed to the intense southern sun of Florida or the Bahamas. Built by Riviera Australia, her sleek hardtop silhouette conceals an expansive interior and long-range capability, while bespoke, superyacht-grade joinery below decks presents refined radii, immaculate metal finishes, and substantial acoustic insulation that keeps vibration and noise to an almost imperceptible level. Propulsion comes from twin Volvo Penta D13 IPS1350 pod drives with joystick docking and dynamic positioning, all integrated with Glass Cockpit navigation, CZone digital switching, and Sentinel Marine monitoring. The custom three-stateroom, three-head layout includes a teak cockpit with tender garage and a salon arranged around a generous U-shaped galley beneath an electric sunroof. Specified new to measure and maintained with exacting care, LYRICA presents beautifully today.

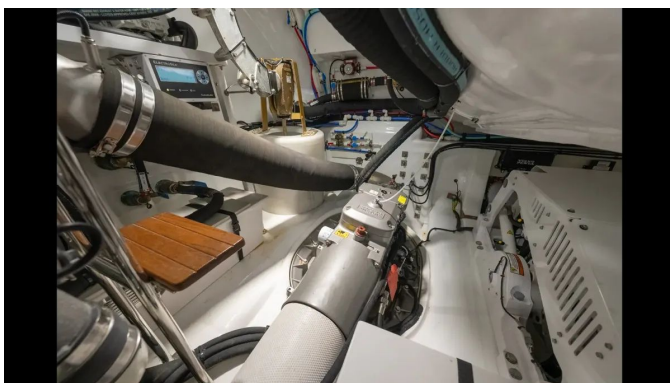














DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Equipment list

This yacht is configured in an elegant Presidential arrangement with three cabins, a lower salon and an aft master bathroom, the full beam master enhanced by a dedicated desk, and a starboard lounge positioned as far forward as practicable to optimize interior flow. The lower lounge converts to a sleeping berth via an infill, backed by a reinforced support panel and additional upholstered pads for comfort. Underway handling and stability are assured by a bow thruster and a Seakeeper 16 gyro stabilizer, while seawater treatment is managed by an ElectroSea system. Navigation and situational awareness have been upgraded with a Garmin AIS 800 transceiver paired with a GA 38 GPS/GLONASS antenna to provide full AIS receive-and-transmit capability, a Garmin GMR Fantom CHIRP 24 closed array radar, and a FLIR M232 thermal camera with tilt/pan and JCU controller mounted in a custom forward, recessed position on the cabin top, set deliberately ahead of the sunroof. Exterior lighting is refined and purposeful, with Lumitec SeaBlaze blue/white underwater lights and a pair of Lumitec Trunnion H60 floodlights affixed beneath the aft frame to the awning's oval stainless crossmember. Communications and signaling are covered by a VHF antenna, an AM/FM radio antenna and a short navigation light mast that preserves a sleek profile. Deck surfaces feature teak on the bow and side decks, and the hardtop is fitted with electric riggers. The interior is finished in satin finished walnut, and practical bespoke upgrades include a nine drawer custom unit replacing the master chaise lounge and three custom fuel fill indicators at the filler stations. Entertainment infrastructure is prepared with SAT TV pre wiring, and helm ergonomics have been thoughtfully enhanced by a dash modification to accept a transverse backrest and the installation of an enlarged air conditioning

outlet grille atop the dash to increase airflow.

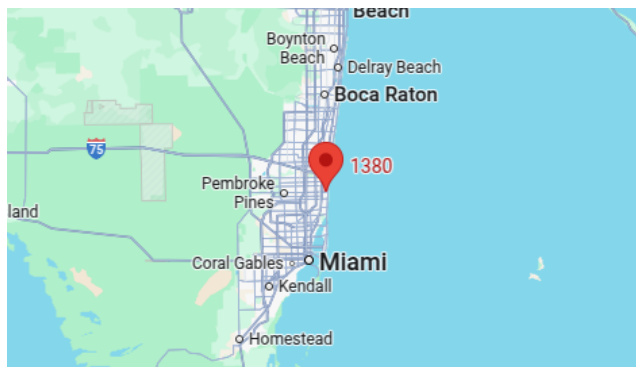
