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OVERVIEW

KATRIN I, a 2025 Ferretti Yachts 670, unites Italian design, impeccable craftsmanship, and a spirited sense of performance to create a refined motor yacht ideal for discerning owners and families. Her expansive arrangement affords generous alfresco entertaining areas, a luminous salon framed by sweeping windows, a comprehensively equipped galley, and four tasteful staterooms highlighted by a full-beam owner's suite. The capacious flybridge offers multiple lounging configurations, an alfresco dining area, a wet bar and an upper helm, while the hydraulic bathing platform provides seamless access for swimming, launching a tender and enjoying watersports. Propelled by twin MAN V8 diesels, KATRIN I cruises comfortably in the high twenties and attains a top speed of 32 knots, making her an exceptional flybridge motor yacht for Bahamas cruises, New England summer passages, or extended Mediterranean voyages and island-hopping adventures. 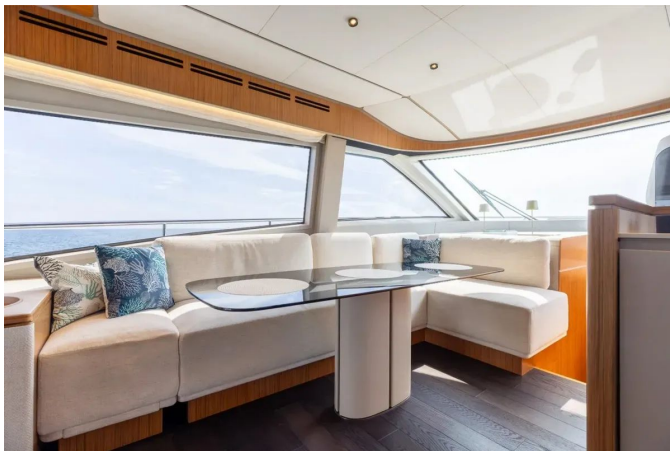

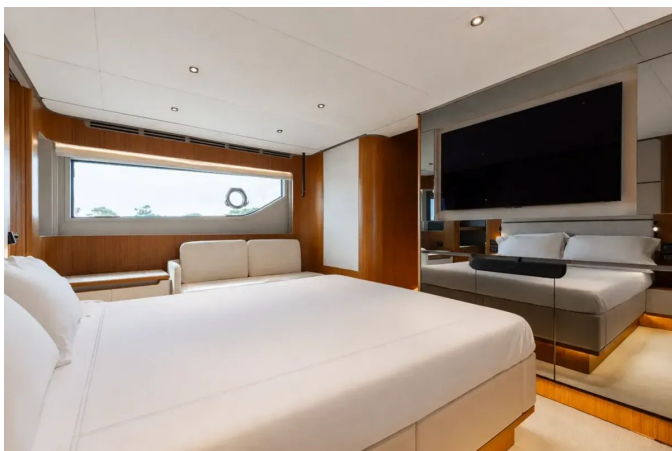

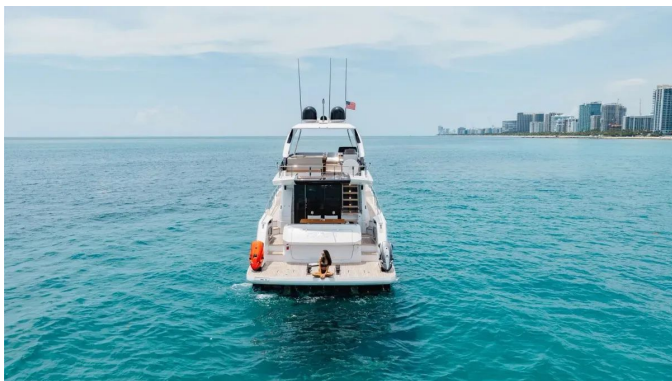












DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Overview

KATRIN I, a 2025 Ferretti Yachts 670, showcases the refined aesthetics, advanced engineering, and artisanal build quality that define Ferretti Yachts. Italian styling and smart naval architecture combine to deliver the presence, comfort, and handling of a much larger vessel while remaining perfectly manageable for owner-operators and welcoming to family life. The aft cockpit invites relaxed al fresco living with a generous teak dining table and abundant seating arranged beneath the protective flybridge overhang, creating a space that transitions from daytime lounging at anchor to elegant evenings outdoors. Wide side decks with elevated bulwarks provide safe passage to the foredeck lounge, where oversized sun pads and a cushioned settee form a private vantage point for sun-soaked reprieves and sweeping seascapes.

Sliding glass doors open to a salon defined by an extraordinary sense of light and openness; full-height glazing frames unbroken ocean views while interiors of warm woods, soft neutral palettes, and contemporary Italian furnishings cultivate a sophisticated yet inviting atmosphere. A spacious aft lounge encourages casual relaxation and a formal dining area amidships accommodates intimate indoor entertaining, while the fully equipped galley forward is positioned for efficient service without disturbing the flow between social zones and guest accommodations.

Below decks, KATRIN I reveals a thoughtfully executed four-stateroom layout that prioritizes privacy and comfort. The full-beam master suite benefits from oversized hull windows that flood the cabin with natural light, generous storage and a roomy ensuite. Forward, the VIP stateroom features a centerline queen berth and private ensuite access, and two additional guest cabins with twin berths provide comfortable lodging for family or friends. Crew quarters

are located aft with their own separate entrance for discreet operation. Above, the flybridge acts as the yacht's convivial heart with multiple lounging zones, a large dining table, a fully fitted wet bar, plentiful sun pads and an upper helm offering excellent visibility and an open plan that keeps guests connected to the experience of cruising. A hydraulic swim platform to stern ensures easy water access and serves as an ideal launch point for a tender or water toys. Motivated by twin MAN V8 diesel engines on conventional shafts, KATRIN I confidently delivers the performance expected of a Ferretti, cruising comfortably in the high-20-knot range and reaching a top speed of approximately 32 knots, equally at ease in the Bahamas, New England, or the Mediterranean.

Special condition options

This yacht has been outfitted with an electro-hydraulic passerelle (gangway) and an ANG frequency converter, while the onboard entertainment package is anchored by a KVH TV6 satellite TV system with SAT TV wiring to the cabins, a refined 50-inch salon television on an electric lift and a 43-inch screen in the master cabin. Command and safety systems have been elevated with a Simrad NAIS500 AIS transponder (RX/TX), joystick control at both helm stations with proportional bow and stern thrusters, a digital chain counter, an additional engine room camera and a cockpit docking station. Navigation is enhanced by a Simrad display upgrade comprising three 16-inch screens at the main helm and two 12-inch screens at the flybridge, complemented by Simrad autopilot control on the flybridge. Sea-keeping comfort is ensured by a pair of Seakeeper NG6 stabilizers.

Extra options

Thoughtfully selected enhancements raise the level of comfort, autonomy and

refinement throughout the yacht. A tropical air conditioning system cools the salon, guest cabins and crew quarters for consistent comfort in warm climates, while the master cabin is fitted with electric blackout blinds and each guest stateroom has its own blackout blinds to ensure privacy and restorative sleep. In the main living area, electric blinds and subtle interior courtesy lighting create an inviting atmosphere, complemented externally by discreet deck courtesy lights and striking underwater illumination that amplifies the vessel's presence after dusk. Sun and shade are managed with ease thanks to a sliding hardtop and a carbon-fiber bow bimini, and richly finished teak decks with contrasting black caulking extend across the swim platform, side decks and foredeck; the teak bow table converts simply into a sunpad for lounging. Durable waterproof exterior covers protect finishes while at rest and a convenient shore water connection makes marina stays straightforward, while close-quarters maneuvering is assisted by a pair of stern warping winches. The flybridge is arranged for effortless entertaining with a grill and refrigerator, and the navigation instruments are presented beneath a refined painted finish; a Poltrona Frau co-pilot seat at the helm adds elevated comfort on passage. Beneath decks, an inverter/battery charger and an upgraded generator support onboard systems, a watertight door separates the crew area from the engine room for added safety and serviceability, and the crew cabin features a fold-down berth for flexible accommodation. Everyday conveniences are handled with a washer/dryer combo and dishwasher, independence at sea is provided by a 180 L/h watermaker with helm control, and little luxuries such as a freshwater bidet spray for the toilets and a cockpit ice maker ensure guests remain comfortable and refreshed.

Interior decor & finishes

Designer headliners run continuously through the interior, their understated elegance anchored by brushed European oak parquet flooring across the main

deck, while full-boat curtains allow precisely tailored control of natural light. The galley is appointed with a Platinum White Royal Stone countertop, and the dining area features a smoked glass dining table accompanied by Magis Aviva dining chairs and custom dining upholstery; in the salon, Homedecor Must upholstery creates a warm, sophisticated atmosphere, and the helm benefits from premium dashboard finishes paired with a Poltrona Frau helm seat for an elevated piloting experience. Accommodation areas are executed to an exceptional specification, with premium master cabin finishes alongside premium VIP and guest cabin finishes, all softened underfoot by Vanity Twist carpet on the lower deck and dressed with GM Ostrica bed linens, while Florim Calacatta Oro countertops and shower finishes introduce a luminous, sculptural quality. Externally, Olympus Silicio exterior upholstery and Talenti Chic exterior chairs complete the refined, cohesive aesthetic.

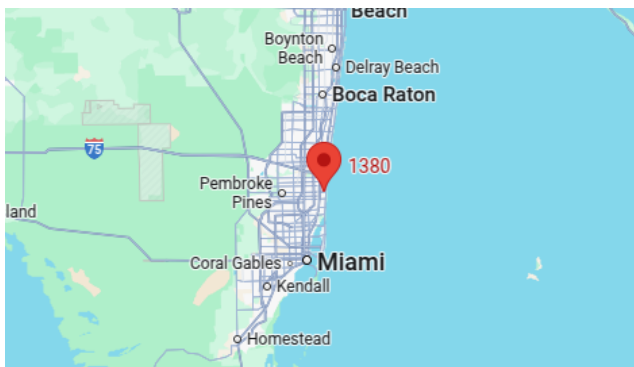
