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OVERVIEW

Meticulously maintained and actively voyaged by experienced owners, this Sirena 68 arrives after more than 100 consecutive days exploring the Bahamas, a testament to careful ownership and thoughtful upgrades. She exemplifies Sirena's approach to refined motor yacht living: crafted for relaxed, long range passagemaking yet capable of accelerating to cover distance when schedules or weather demand.

At an economical displacement speed near 10 knots she delivers an estimated 1,200 nautical mile range, perfectly suited to extended coastal cruising and offshore runs. When greater speed is required, twin Volvo D13 1000 hp engines on shaft drives carry her at a comfortable cruise near 16 knots and propel her beyond 22 knots at full throttle, marrying efficiency with confident performance.

Constructed to CE Category A Ocean standards, the Sirena 68 inspires confidence for serious voyaging while retaining the generous interior volume and calm, luxurious ambiance expected of contemporary flybridge yachts. Wide side decks, tall bulwarks, excellent sightlines from both helm stations and plentiful, well concealed storage contribute to her suitability for owner operators and for extended life aboard.

Below decks the layout is intelligently arranged with four staterooms and three heads, anchored by a full beam primary suite that offers privacy and space, a sizable VIP, a twin guest cabin and an over under bunk cabin. Practical systems support comfortable long term cruising, including a dedicated laundry area with separate Miele washer and dryer units, while the privately accessed crew accommodation to aft sleeps two and includes its own head, shower and compact galley to ensure seamless service underway.

The salon and galley are light filled, open to the sea and designed for both convivial entertaining and serious provisioning, with full size domestic

refrigeration, dishwasher, oven, cooktop, wine cooler and abundant storage for extended passages. Outside, multiple entertaining areas invite relaxation: a generous aft deck flows to an expansive flybridge and a comfortable foredeck lounge, and an oversized hydraulic swim platform makes tender handling and water access effortless.

Her specification balances capability and comfort: CE Category A Ocean classification; twin Volvo D13 1000 hp engines on shaft drives; approximately 1,200 NM range at 10 knots; an efficient 16 knot cruise and more than 22 knots at top speed; Volvo joystick docking with bow and stern thrusters for precise close quarters handling; Seakeeper stabilization for composed behavior at anchor and underway; twin Cummins Onan generators for redundant power; and a watermaker for extended independence. Connectivity and daily convenience are assured with Starlink plus WiFi extenders, a commercial duty Frigibar freezer for provisioning, and a galley fitted with full size Miele appliances and a dedicated wine cooler. The flybridge is equipped for entertaining with a BBQ, refrigerator, ice maker and wet bar, navigation is supported by a large Garmin electronics suite, and ongoing care has been maintained by a full time crew.

Having completed a yard maintenance period in June 2026, she is turnkey and ready to cruise, offering a compelling opportunity for owners seeking a contemporary long range flybridge motor yacht with expansive volume, practical systems and the flexibility to run efficiently or accelerate when the passage calls for speed.

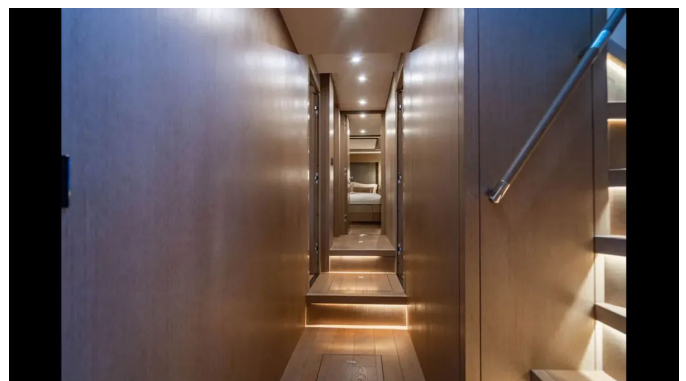
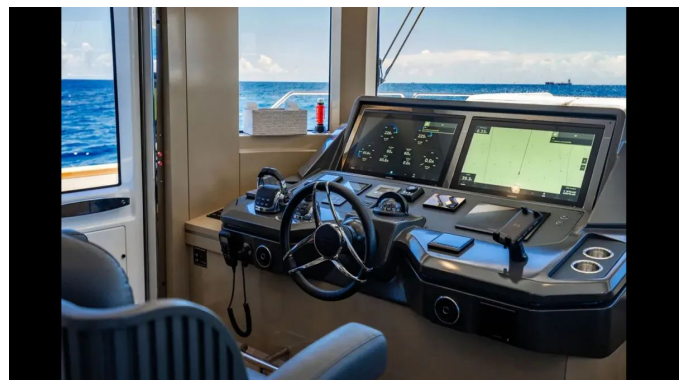


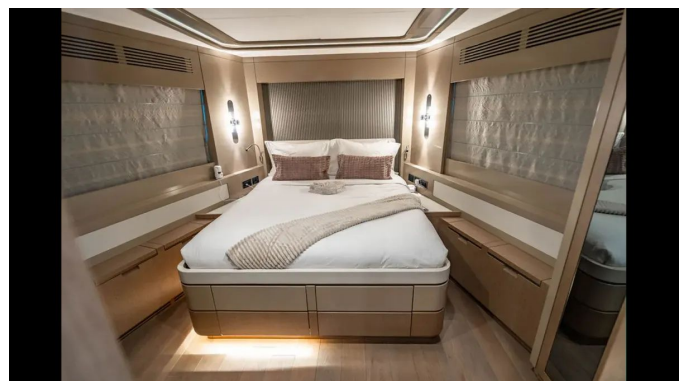


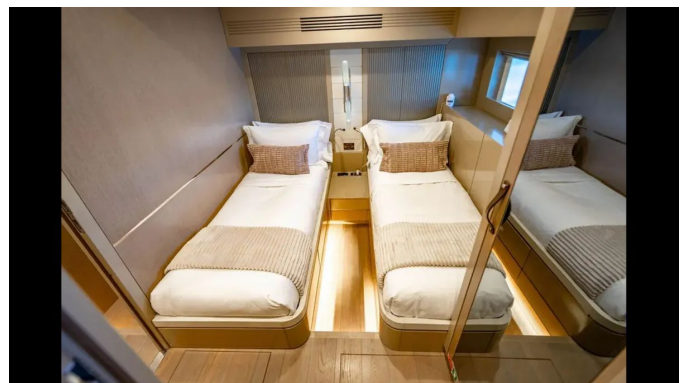
















DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Hull & deck

Built to marry structural integrity with refined performance, this yacht features a resin infused FRP/carbon hull and a resin infused FRP/carbon deck, each cored with closed cell foam and tied into a resin infused structural FRP grid embedded in closed cell foam. The superstructure is likewise resin infused FRP and carbon for significant weight savings, topped by a resin infused carbon hardtop fitted with an electric sunroof. The exterior silhouette is enhanced by a bespoke boot stripe and a custom painted mast, satellite domes and radar array, while teak side decks, a teak cockpit sole and a teak flybridge sole lend warmth and elegance beneathfoot. The aft cockpit is equipped with two electric capstans and finished with a teak ensign staff for a classic maritime touch.

Outdoor living is orchestrated with deliberate attention to comfort and atmosphere, beginning forward with a generous foredeck sunpad and companion foredeck seating arranged around a hi lo cocktail table beneath a custom foredeck sun awning. Pop up and courtesy lighting across the main foredeck create subtle ambiance, and after dusk two bi color underwater lights in the transom together with additional floodlights on the flybridge allow evenings to continue in style. Safety and convenience are integrated discreetly via custom safety gates in the aft cockpit, an aft cockpit hi lo vertical sunshade and an integral ladder upgrade between the swim platform and the stern.

Entertaining is effortless aboard, with three high gloss finished teak exterior tables, a hi lo table for the port forward flybridge table, an aft cockpit dinette that seats six and four custom folding cockpit chairs that stow neatly when not in use. Culinary and service features include a flybridge refrigeration upgrade, a flybridge ice maker, an aft cockpit ice maker on the main deck level and an

aft amenity area equipped with an ice maker and electric grill. Teak chocks are fitted to secure a jet ski, and the generous aft cockpit with its teak sole becomes an inviting stage for every gathering.

Flybridge

Teak decking runs beneathfoot across the entire flybridge, harmonizing with a carbon fiber T-top fitted with an electric sunroof, while an integral outdoor shower discreetly integrated into the mast provides instant refreshment. The entertainment package centers on a Fusion Apollo RA 770 audio system with an additional subwoofer and a 42-inch flat-screen LED TV on a lift, creating a fully immersive media experience. Seating is supremely comfortable with cushions upholstered in white Sunbrella fabric and an upgraded large U-shaped settee aft that encourages relaxed conversation.

To starboard, an L-shaped outdoor galley in high-gloss teak is appointed with black granite countertops, an integral countertop grill, a stainless-steel under-mount sink, a refrigerator, an ice maker, and a single-lever faucet, while to port an L-shaped bar echoes the same high-gloss teak and matching black granite surfaces. Dining and social areas include a U-shaped dinette to starboard with a satin-finished teak table and a forward dinette to port featuring a hi-lo convertible teak table finished in satin. The full upper helm station offers dual helm seats adorned with a Bentley diamond-stitch pattern, protected by an isinglass enclosure with opening curtains to port, forward, and starboard and a smoked acrylic wraparound windscreen, complemented by a large Frigibar commercial-grade freezer and a custom sun awning that extends shade and comfort whether at anchor or underway.

Main salon

The expansive main salon delivers uninterrupted 360-degree views and is

elegantly finished with the Serenity decor package; Venetian blinds are installed throughout and a light honey wood cabin sole finished in satin brings warmth and subtle sophistication. A layered illumination design sets the mood with overhead tray lighting throughout supported by overhead LED lighting, rope lighting beneath the toe kicks throughout, and refined wall sconces throughout. Audio-visual enjoyment is assured by a Bowers and Wilkins AV system throughout paired with a 50" LED TV. To starboard, a dinette for six is centered on a dual-pedestal smoked glass table detailed with silver accents and wood trim, accompanied by three white leather dinette chairs and outboard bench seating upholstered in white leather, while a built-in credenza forward of the dinette is finished in white for a crisp, integrated look. To port, a gracious U-shaped settee provides a relaxing lounge around twin smoked glass cocktail tables with matching silver accents and wood trim.

Galley

Situated aft to port, the galley is appointed throughout in Serenity Decor, where upgraded marble countertops and a light honey wood cabin sole finished in satin establish a tone of refined luxury. Culinary operations are streamlined by a Miele induction cooktop and a Miele dishwasher, while a dual-basin stainless-steel undermount sink paired with a stainless-steel gooseneck single-lever faucet offers both elegance and practicality. Two built-in refrigerator/freezers provide ample cold storage, and rope lighting tucked beneath the toe kicks casts a warm, inviting glow across the space. Generous storage is integrated throughout to maintain an orderly, efficient workspace ideal for extended cruising.

Pilothouse

At the heart of the pilothouse, command is centered at the port forward helm

where a dual bench seat faces a large, ergonomically designed navigation station. Directly aft of the helm, the electrical distribution panel is discreetly housed behind a smoked acrylic door, keeping vital systems immediately accessible yet elegantly concealed. A substantial watertight wing door to port provides secure side deck access, while to starboard a forward settee comfortably accommodates three. The space is refined by the Serenity decor package and softened by overhead LED lighting, all set on a light honey toned wood cabin sole finished in satin to cast a warm, sophisticated glow throughout.

Electronics

The pilothouse is appointed with a refined array of Garmin displays—two 22-inch MFDs alongside a single 10-inch MFD—while the flybridge offers comparable capability through two 16-inch Garmin MFDs and an additional 10-inch Garmin MFD, creating seamless helm-to-helm integration.

Comprehensive situational awareness is delivered by a Garmin Fantom 54 open-array radar complemented by two Garmin Autopilot controls and Garmin IR cameras that continuously monitor the engine room and cockpit. Onboard entertainment and connectivity are elevated by KVH TracVision 6, and navigation plus sportfishing functionality are reinforced by a Class B AIS transceiver and a Garmin Fishfinder.

Master stateroom

The Serenity decor package bathes the master in a serene palette, set off by a light honey wood cabin sole finished in satin, while a generous centerline berth becomes the focal point flanked by built-in nightstands to port and starboard and reading lights mounted above the berth on both sides for effortless evening reading. Privacy and mood are controlled at the touch of a button with

motorized blinds that include blackout capability and a convenient remote, and to port a vanity upgrade introduces a lighted flip-up mirror and a comfortable ottoman where a built-in dress to starboard offers streamlined storage for garments. Lighting is thoughtfully layered and luxurious, combining overhead tray illumination, LED overhead fixtures throughout, elegant wall sconces and discreet rope lighting beneath the toe kicks, and entertainment is provided by a 42-inch flat-screen TV.

Master head

Dressed throughout in the Serenity decor package, the master head is a sanctuary of calm and understated luxury, where a light honey wood cabin sole finished in satin is paired with an upgraded marble cabin sole and matching upgraded marble countertops, all centered by a sculptural marble top-mount sink. The shower is finished with Corian Glacier Ice walls, while a flush mirror with radiused corners and integrated “beauty lighting” above the sink lend a tailored, high-end finish. Premium Grohe fixtures—comprising a single-lever faucet, a Rain shower fixture and a handheld shower fixture—ensure refined functionality, and an Aquamare fresh water marine head provides dependable performance. Overhead LED lighting bathes the space in clear illumination, and subtle rope lighting beneath the toe kicks adds a warm, contemporary glow.

VIP stateroom

The Serenity decor package continues through the VIP stateroom, where a satin-finished light honey wood cabin sole sets a warm, refined tone. A centerline Queen berth serves as the room’s centerpiece, accompanied by an upgraded vanity with a lighted flip-up mirror and a matching ottoman for effortless preparation. Lighting is thoughtfully layered for ambiance and

function, with overhead tray illumination, two wall sconces and rope lighting beneath the toe kicks, while dedicated reading lights to port and starboard above the berth provide precise task lighting. Motorized blackout blinds operated by remote deliver privacy and comfort at the touch of a button, and a 32-inch LED flat-screen TV provides onboard entertainment. Large opening hull ports flood the space with natural light and sea breezes, and a hanging locker to port plus generous storage throughout ensure everything has its place.

VIP head

Finished in the Serenity decor package, the VIP head combines a light honey wood cabin sole with a satin finish alongside an upgraded marble cabin sole to evoke a warm, sophisticated atmosphere. An upgraded marble countertop supports a marble top-mount sink beneath an over-sink mirror, all paired with a Grohe single-lever faucet for refined function. The shower is sheathed in Corian Glacier Ice and appointed with a Grohe rain shower fixture and a Grohe handheld shower nozzle, while an opening hull port in the shower admits natural light and ventilation. Overhead LED lighting is thoughtfully layered with subtle rope lighting beneath the toe kicks, and an Aquamare fresh water marine head completes this elegant and highly functional space.

Fourth stateroom

Fitted throughout with the Serenity decor package, the fourth stateroom radiates calm, enhanced by a light honey wood cabin sole presented in a satin finish. Space is efficiently utilized with upper and lower bunk-style berths arranged for comfort and practicality, while two hanging lockers provide ample wardrobe storage. Discreet rope lighting tucked beneath the toe kicks, combined with comprehensive overhead lighting, casts a gentle, welcoming glow at any hour.

Third stateroom

The third stateroom is finished throughout with the Serenity decor package and features a light honey wood cabin sole lacquered in a satin sheen, while twin berths provide flexible sleeping arrangements. Storage has been thoughtfully addressed with two hanging lockers, and a 32-inch LED flat-screen TV offers onboard entertainment. Soft rope lighting concealed beneath the toe kicks, paired with overhead lighting distributed throughout the space, bathes the cabin in a warm, inviting glow.

Crew's quarters

Finished in the Serenity décor package, the crew's quarters provide a tranquil, contemporary interior illuminated by overhead lighting throughout. Thoughtful design blends practicality and comfort with upper and lower bunk-style berths and a portside dinette that serves for meals or off-watch planning, while a vanity with sink and mirror supports everyday routines. The compact galley places a white Corian sink to port with a single-lever chrome faucet and includes below-counter refrigeration for provisions. An Aquamare fresh-water head delivers dependable convenience, and onboard systems — a Fusion RA210 audio system paired with a 10-inch Garmin MFD — keep the team connected and informed while underway.

Guest head

Finished to an exacting standard, the guest head presents an upgraded marble countertop paired with a marble top-mount sink, both set above an upgraded marble cabin sole for a cohesive, luxurious feel. Shower walls clad in Corian Glacier Ice provide a crisp, luminous backdrop, while an over-sink mirror and a flush-mount medicine cabinet with mirrored doors offer clean, practical

storage. Premium appointments include a Grohe single-lever faucet and a Grohe handheld shower nozzle, and an Aquamare fresh water marine head delivers reliable performance at sea. Lighting has been considered for both atmosphere and function, with recessed overhead LED illumination throughout and discreet rope lighting beneath the toe kick that bathes the space in a soft, welcoming glow.

Mechanical

Powered by twin Volvo D-13 1000 HP main engines mated to ZF 500 IV marine gears and maneuvered from dual joystick controls at both the upper and lower stations, this yacht offers precise, fingertip handling in every condition. Offshore stability is provided by a Seakeeper 18 gyro stabilizer, while an additional upgraded 21.5 kW Onan generator effortlessly carries hotel loads in concert with a six-zone air conditioning system. Close-quarters handling and docking are made simple by two aft capstans, a 24V anchor windlass and variable-speed bow and stern thrusters. Long-range autonomy is supported by an upgraded forty-seven GPH water maker, an upgraded fresh water deck wash down and robust 24V domestic fresh water pumps, complemented by dedicated 24V grey water and 24V black water pumps. Maintenance and reliability benefit from a Reverso oil change system, upgraded isolation pump mounts throughout and additional sound insulation installed across the vessel. Everyday conveniences include a Miele washer and Miele dryer, and night operations are aided by an ACR remote spotlight.

Electrical

Two 220V/50A shore power services form the backbone of the yacht's electrical arrangement, supplying a heavy duty 220V distribution network while 110V receptacles are thoughtfully located throughout the vessel for everyday use.

Isolation transformers preserve power quality and protect onboard systems, and redundancy is assured by twin Onan 21.5KW 220V AC generators. A dedicated 24V house distribution system reliably serves all domestic consumers.

Safety

Every voyage is underpinned by uncompromising safety, beginning with a 65 lb claw anchor secured to 300' of 5/8" high-tensile chain to deliver steadfast holding in demanding conditions. The inventory of lifesaving equipment includes 12 USCG-approved PFDs, a USCG-approved flare kit, a comprehensive first aid kit and a readily accessible throwable device, while an 8-man liferaft stands ready for swift deployment should the need arise. For sound signaling the yacht carries a manual sound-producing device alongside a ship's bell to ensure clear, compliant communication, and dockside operations are equally well appointed with 6 dock lines and 4 fenders to guarantee secure, confident mooring at every port.

Recent work and upgrades

A comprehensive program of enhancements and meticulous maintenance has refined this yacht's reliability, performance and onboard comfort. In June 2026 a full bottom job was completed, with PropSpeed applied to the running gear and the propellers precision balanced; cutlass bearings were renewed in 2026 and the rudder shaft seals were replaced in 2025. The swim platform hydraulics were fully serviced and replaced to ensure flawless operation. Mechanical care has been equally thorough: a 1,000 hour engine service was carried out in late 2025, complete engine and generator services were performed in June 2026, the SeaKeeper was serviced in December 2025, and all tanks were flushed during 2026. Climate control received a full refresh when

every AC unit and the system were serviced and flushed in June 2026, a new salon AC unit was fitted and four new blowers were installed during the June 2026 yard period. Comfort and capability have been elevated with the addition of a commercial duty FB fridgebar/freezer valued at \$12,000, a reverse osmosis drinking water filtration system in the galley, and a new windlass motor. Connectivity and entertainment have also been upgraded with Starlink and Wi-Fi extenders to blanket the vessel, and a new salon TV was installed in May 2026.

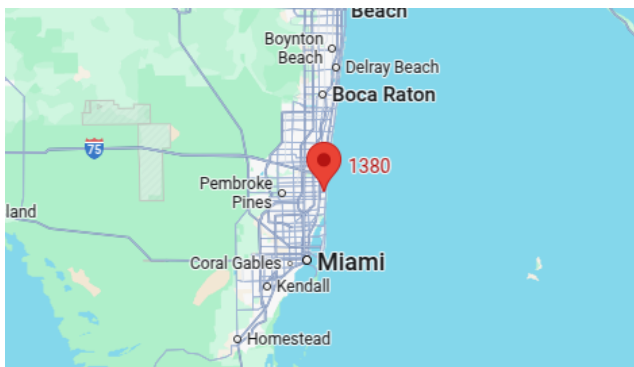
