## OVERVIEW

---

The 1954 Trumpy 68' Motor Yacht is a living testament to American yachting tradition, a vessel whose handcrafted wooden hull and wood decks glow with the kind of fine joinery and attention to detail that marked the golden era of classic motor yachts. Her graceful sheer and timeless profile catch every eye in port, a study in proportion and artisanal sensibility that appeals to aficionados of vintage wooden craft and collectors of maritime design.

At 68' in overall length with a generous 16-foot beam, she provides generous interior volume for elegant entertaining and extended voyages, while a seakindly draft of approximately 13.67 feet lends a steady, reassuring motion through sea and swell. Powered by twin GM inboard diesel engines, she cruises comfortably at 8 knots with a purposeful top speed approaching 11 knots. A 550-gallon fuel tank paired with 400 gallons of fresh water supports thoughtful coastal passages and unhurried weekends aboard, marrying quiet efficiency with the reliability experienced yachtsmen expect.

Boarding reveals an interior bathed in warm woodwork and restrained, sophisticated appointments. The main salon invites comfortable conversation and gracious hospitality, flowing seamlessly to broad side decks and ample exterior spaces ideal for alfresco living underway or at anchor. Below decks, private accommodations are arranged for comfort and discretion and are complemented by three thoughtfully appointed heads. A well-laid-out galley equips the vessel for effortless provisioning and service, while the pilothouse affords commanding sightlines and the tactile satisfaction of traditional helm controls.

True to the Trumpy name, this yacht strikes a balance between artistry and practical utility; her structure and finish echo a legacy of craftsmanship that is increasingly rare and rewarding to the owner who values the warmth, resonance, and enduring strength of quality wood construction. Underway she

moves with composed dignity; at rest she reads as a floating salon, a gentleman's yacht whose presence enhances every marina she visits. Located in the United States and ready for her next steward, this 68' Trumpy remains a quintessential Classic Motor Yacht—an elegant Vintage Wooden Yacht and Heritage Yacht, equally suited as a Luxury Cruiser, Pilothouse Motor Yacht, or refined Liveboard for those who prize authenticity, comfort, and style.





# DETAILED DESCRIPTION

---

## Main description

---

LIBERTY LOVE is a beautiful exemplar of classic American yacht craftsmanship, embodying everything that has made Trumpy motor yachts legendary. Built in 1954 under contract number 368 and originally christened Sereno III, this 68' Trumpy marries elegant sheerlines, warm traditional styling, and a highly functional layout that continues to captivate discerning yachtsmen more than seven decades on. The yacht is her owner's second Trumpy, a distinction that speaks volumes about the depth of care, knowledge, and appreciation invested in her stewardship. Designed for comfortable cruising and extended stays aboard, LIBERTY LOVE features a three-stateroom layout complemented by dedicated crew quarters and a forward-facing galley, ensuring excellent separation between owner and guest accommodations and the crew/service areas. Powered by twin diesel engines, she delivers dependable performance, while a bow thruster simplifies docking and close-quarters maneuvering. Thoughtful modern upgrades enhance her classic character, including Garmin electronics at the helm and Starlink connectivity, allowing owners and guests to remain connected whether cruising the coast or relaxing at anchor. LIBERTY LOVE's timeless interior and gracious living spaces create an inviting atmosphere for family voyages, elegant entertaining, or classic yacht rendezvous where Trumpys are perennially admired and celebrated. After fulfilling their dream of Trumpy ownership once again, the current owners are now ready to pass LIBERTY LOVE to the next family, offering a rare opportunity to acquire a well-appointed, thoughtfully updated classic motor yacht with proven pedigree. If you seek enduring style, a proven design, and the unmatched presence of a true Trumpy, LIBERTY LOVE is a must-see.

## Vessel details

---

In the pilothouse, a single 16" Garmin screen pairs with a Garmin autopilot and a Sidepower bow thruster controller to deliver confident, fingertip control, while a classic 24" wooden ship's wheel faces a Kelvin-White stainless-steel compass and binnacle. Communications and ship systems are supported by an I-Com IC M330 VHF radio, a Northern Light generator control panel, and an AC/DC power distribution panel. For comfort and convenience, there is a drink refrigerator, a JVC stereo/CD player, and a built in helm bench with five drawers, and quick movement fore and aft is ensured by port and starboard side deck access doors. Forward, the crew area is intelligently arranged with the captain's cabin to port, a hanging closet, a full bunk with five built in drawers, and, to starboard, a single bunk, a shower, and a built in storage bench and cabinet; an electric head is positioned forward, and a dedicated crew refrigerator serves the space. The master stateroom centers on a pedestal queen berth set on the centerline, with a drawer on each side, complemented by port and starboard built in nightstands fitted with period crystal lamps and four drawers apiece. To starboard, a built in vanity enhances day to day comfort, while port and starboard hanging closets provide ample wardrobe stowage. Entertainment and amenities include an 18" VISIO flat screen TV, an en suite head and shower with a porcelain sink and a brushed nickel faucet, a brushed nickel towel holder, and an FCF A/C controller. The port guest stateroom offers twin berths and a built in centerline nightstand with three drawers, a hanging closet to port, an access door to the day head and shower, and atmospheric period brass wall sconces. To starboard, the guest stateroom features a full size bed, a built in nightstand with four drawers, period glass lamps, a hanging closet, and its own FCF A/C controller. The forward facing galley is equipped with a period Frigidaire stove/oven, a period stainless steel refrigerator and freezer, and a microwave oven; stainless steel countertops and sink are set over cabinets

below, with built in racks for plate and glass storage. Practicality is elevated by an engine room access door, a forward crew room access door, and four port lights that draw in natural light. Aft, the salon invites conversation and relaxation with two occasional chairs to starboard, a loveseat on the forward bulkhead facing aft with a period side table to starboard, and a built in period bar and credenza with six drawers; climate comfort is aided by a radiator and an FCF A/C controller, while wood blinds to port and starboard provide privacy and warmth. The guest head completes the accommodations with a large shower enclosed by a glass door, an electric head, and a refined brushed nickel faucet and towel rack ensemble.
