OVERVIEW

This Predator 68 is destined to enchant buyers who prize distinguished styling, exhilarating performance, and the flawless craftsmanship synonymous with Sunseeker, and she is ready for viewing and prepared for her next discerning owner. Her bold, muscular silhouette hints at thrilling capability — speeds up to 36 knots — while sunlit, sumptuous interiors offer a serene yet sophisticated retreat. A broad hardtop sunroof and frameless glazing flood the living spaces with light, and thoughtful appointments, including a hydraulic swim platform and dedicated tender garage, blur the line between inside and out; refined finishes throughout deliver the pace, poise, and comfort that make effortless entertaining inevitable. She embodies the qualities of a Motor Yacht, Sport Yacht, Express Cruiser, Open Motor Yacht, and Performance Yacht, equally suited as a luxury cruiser or a perfect weekend escape. Recent updates include new exterior upholstery and completed M1 engine services.

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Hull & moulding

The profile begins with a white hull traced by a Jet Black boot top line, set off by Esthec Platinum decking with white corking laid across the platform, aft cockpit steps, the aft cockpit itself, the aft cockpit grating and the steps that rise to the foredeck sunpad, creating a refined contrast that catches the eye at every angle. A hydraulically lifting platform effortlessly handles up to 450kg and the engineering includes preparations already in place for the future installation of a Water Maker, while by night four white Lumishore LED underwater lights set the water aglow and accentuate the yacht's elegant silhouette. The yacht is specified in a three cabin, lower galley layout, combining balanced accommodation with seamless exterior design.

Foredeck

A black mesh windscreen and hard top glass cover shield the foredeck while a fresh water deck wash outlet keeps everything pristine after voyages and days at anchor, presenting a foredeck that is both protected and easy to maintain. Anchoring is authoritative with sixty metres of galvanised chain on a Lewmar 40kg Delta anchor, managed by a Lewmar V5GD 24V windlass for reliable holding and controlled operation. Comfort is assured on bow sunbathing cushions with folding backrests and entertainment carries forward with removable Bose speakers powered by a Sonos Connect amplifier, while low level white LED side deck lights, eight per side, trace the decks after dark to enhance both safety and ambience.

Aft cockpit

An electric black canopy deploys at a touch to shade the aft cockpit, where a teak table anchors a convivial lounge complemented by dedicated aft cockpit speakers, crafting a space perfectly poised for long evenings afloat. Entertaining is effortless with an electric ceramic Domino griddle, a Victrofrigo ice maker and an insulated ice chest cooled by Coolmatic, while a water purifier supplies the ice maker for crystal clear cubes; practical marina life is supported by a fresh water deck wash outlet, a fresh water marina connection with pressure regulator, a handheld swimming shower and a folding stainless steel bathing ladder discreetly stowed under a fiberglass lid. Docking is simplified by Lewmar stern docking winches to port and starboard, a Glendinning Cablemaster and an aft docking station with a second Xenta Smart stick docking, Multi panel and horn, with an additional pair of twelve inch oval mooring cleats fitted low on the aft hull band facing aft and a carbon fiber and polished stainless steel ensign staff replacing the standard, while the tender recovery roller system is pre set for a Williams 325.

Saloon and dining

A serene palette of Silver Oak in satin finish flows over wide plank oak flooring, creating an understated luxury that is both warm and contemporary, while the bar console is crowned by Nero Absolute Granite in an immaculate gloss that punctuates the interior with dramatic contrast. Lounge and dining seating are upholstered in Snow Leather and gathered around a gloss wenge coffee table to form an elegant social hub, climate is perfected by three 16,000 BTU air conditioning units and entertainment is cinematic via a Samsung 55 inch television paired with a Harmon Kardon Blu ray/DVD/CD/FM receiver, five surround speakers and an HK subwoofer, with an integrated U Line wine cooler standing ready; dimmers on the overhead lighting shape the mood at

will to suit every occasion.

Navigation station

The helm is a study in precision: Nero Leather seats with contrast silver diamond pattern stitching face a console with carbon fiber effect panels while the sliding roof's inner face is finished in clear gloss carbon fiber, all combining to frame an advanced navigation environment. A comprehensive Simrad suite includes two IS42 speed/depth instruments with a depth/speed/temperature transducer, an AC12 autopilot system with iS42 pilot display and QS80 pilot keypad, and twin 16 inch MO16 T touch displays, while navigation and awareness are amplified by a Simrad GS25 GPS and OP50 controller, a Simrad Halo 4 pulse compression radar with a 64nm range and a four foot open array scanner, a Simrad RS90 VHF radio with DSC and a 2.4 meter whip antenna, plus a Simrad AIS module with GPS and a dedicated 2.4 meter AIS VHF antenna. A Sanshin Twin Beam searchlight pierces the night, the Xenta Smart stick docking system refines close quarters control, and proportional lever control governs bow and stern thrusters for precise manoeuvring.

Galley

The galley is as beautiful as it is practical, with a Nero Absolute Granite worktop over wide plank oak flooring and its own dedicated 6,000 BTU air conditioning unit to ensure comfort while cooking. Refrigeration is by a stainless steel, dual voltage Vitrifrigo refrigerator above with two freezer drawers below, and cooking is handled by a three ring ceramic hob with a Bosch extractor fan, complemented by a Miele integrated slimline dishwasher and a Miele compact combination fan oven fitted in lieu of the standard unit for enhanced culinary capability.

Owner stateroom

The owner's sanctuary is finished in Silver Oak satin with carpets in Sensation Original Icing Sugar underfoot and a sprung mattress for deeply restful nights, creating a private retreat that feels both luxurious and serene. Climate is assured by a 16,000 BTU air conditioning unit and entertainment comes via a Samsung 32 inch television with Harmon Kardon and stereo flush speakers, while square polished chrome bezel overhead lights, all on dimmers, and flexible arm polished chrome reading lights set the tone for intimate evenings. A generous walk in wardrobe organises every journey and the master ensuite features Nero Absolute Granite flooring in a high gloss finish, a Tecma 2g toilet and Hansgrohe taps and accessories in polished chrome, with a Dometic safe discreetly concealed within the cabinetry for peace of mind.

Vip forward stateroom

Forward, the guest suite finished in Silver Oak low build satin offers a sprung mattress and its own 12,000 BTU air conditioning unit to ensure restful privacy for guests, while entertainment is provided by a Samsung 32 inch television with Harmon Kardon and stereo flush mount speakers. Lighting is versatile with dimmable overhead fixtures and polished chrome flexible reading lights for perfect ambience, and the ensuite is appointed with Nero Absolute Granite gloss finish flooring, a Tecma 2g toilet and Hansgrohe taps and accessories in polished chrome, delivering the same high standards found throughout the yacht.

Starboard guest cabin

The starboard guest cabin, finished in Silver Oak low build satin, features sprung mattresses for the single berths and its own 6,000 BTU

air conditioning unit to keep guests comfortable, while a 22 inch television with Harmon Kardon and stereo flush mount speakers serves entertainment needs. Dimmable overhead lighting sets the mood and the ensuite continues the theme with Nero Absolute Granite flooring, a Tecma 2G toilet and Hansgrohe ensuite taps and accessories in polished chrome, ensuring consistent quality and finish.

Crew cabin

The crew cabin is climate controlled by a dedicated 6,000 BTU air conditioning unit and made practical with a Splendide washer/dryer for extended service periods, while a Tecma 2G toilet, dimmable overhead lighting and polished chrome flexible reading lights round out a thoroughly capable space designed for functionality and rest.

Electrical and engine room

Power management is refined with an entertainment inverter and seamless transfer system, enabling the boat's entertainment to run directly from the DC batteries, while tropical spec air conditioning delivers 110,000 BTU and is supported by a second shore power inlet to meet heavy cooling demands. At the stern a TV shore cable inlet connection socket is neatly fitted for easy hook up and safety is overseen by a six zone fire and bilge flood monitoring alarm system, with electrical independence assured by an Onan 29 kW generator to keep systems running reliably underway or at anchor.
