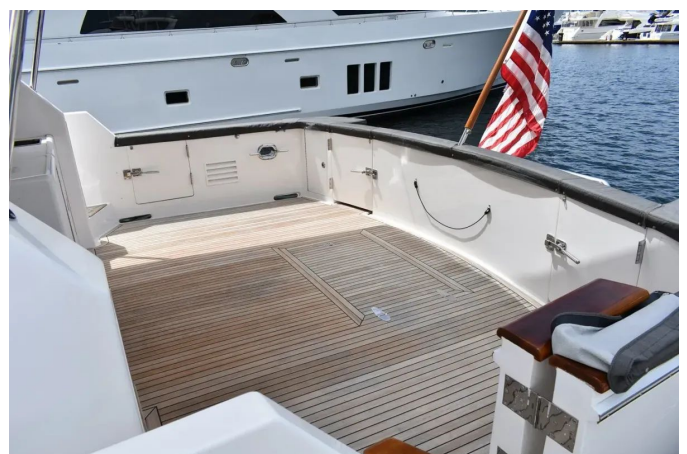














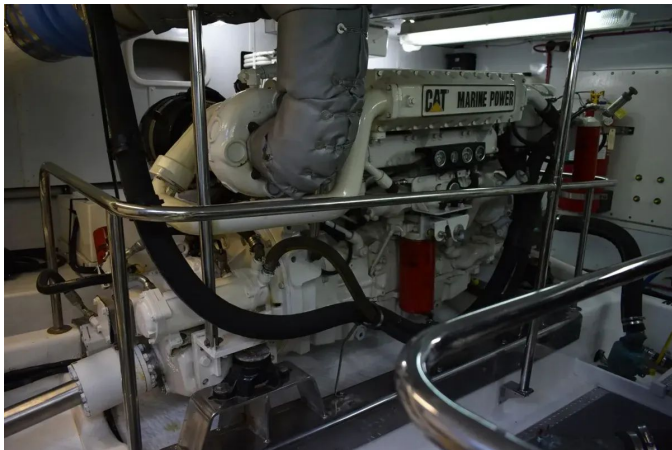


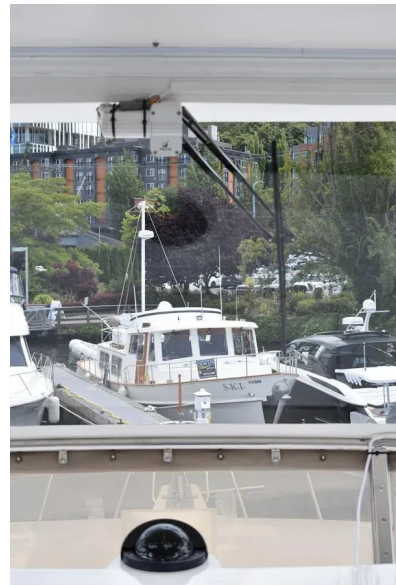












DETAILED DESCRIPTION

2026 upgrades

The 2026 refit introduced a suite of thoughtful technological and aesthetic refinements, beginning at the lower helm where a Garmin 8616xsv MFD now presides, paired with Garmin GPS 8616xsv navigation charts and supported by Garmin ClearVu CHIRP sonar for exceptional underwater imaging. Up on the flybridge the helm electronics were elevated with the addition of a Garmin 8616 MFD alongside a Garmin 8612 MFD, providing intuitive, high-resolution situational awareness. Communications were upgraded to an ICOM 605 VHF with AIS and reception of ten NOAA weather channels, ensuring reliable contact and up-to-the-minute meteorological information. Exterior improvements include newly installed teak planking in the cockpit that refreshes the vessel's on-deck presence, while the bridge benefits from a polycarbonate enclosure center panel equipped with a windshield wiper to maintain visibility in adverse conditions. Interior social areas were refined with the flybridge dinette table and the pilothouse dinette table both professionally refinished, and onboard convenience received a practical enhancement with the installation of a dishwasher.

2025 upgrades

In 2025 the yacht underwent a thorough refresh that included fresh bottom paint with PropSpeed applied to the running gear, the installation of a new diamond-plate engine-room floor and a complete engine-room repaint. Mechanical systems were also upgraded to enhance reliability and performance, with a new starboard transmission, new PFF dripless shaft seals and a new stern thruster motor, ensuring confident operation for seasons ahead.

2024 upgrades

In 2024 the yacht benefited from a comprehensive program of enhancements and preventative maintenance designed to raise performance, reliability and onboard comfort. Both fuel tanks were meticulously cleaned and polished, the main engine aftercooler was professionally serviced, and the water pump impellers were replaced to maintain peak propulsion efficiency. Electrical readiness was restored with new batteries for the main engines, generator, thrusters and house bank, while modern connectivity was added via Starlink. Interior comfort and convenience were upgraded with a new Vacu-Flush unit in the primary head, a new garbage disposal and a Samsung 42" flatscreen installed in the salon. On deck, command and visibility were improved with a new ICOM VHF on the flybridge, the exterior LED running lights were replaced, and a new PH sunscreen cover was fitted.

Other recent vessel upgrades

A carefully curated program of enhancements has elevated both the yacht's finish and operational capability: the cap rails have been expertly refinished, the teak transom step deck replaced, and the flybridge outfitted with new padded flooring. Interior appointments have been refreshed with upgraded upholstery and new carpeting, and the pilothouse teak-and-holly sole has been meticulously restored to its original sheen. Mechanical and electrical systems were upgraded as well, with the installation of an Air Lock One ionizer, stabilizers serviced at Nordlund Marine, the addition of a Victron 5000 inverter alongside a new isolation transformer, and a new Headhunter Mach 5 water pump dedicated to the freshwater system. Deck handling and helm control have been improved by fitting an upgraded Steelhead S-1500 davit system and enhanced MMS Micro Commander engine controls, providing greater precision

and reliability.

Other notable features

Thoughtfully specified for confident passagemaking, this yacht is outfitted with a Glenndenning Cable Master 50/240 power cord and reel and a Northern Lights 20 kW generator showing approximately 3,700 hours. Stability and handling at sea are enhanced by Key Power hydraulic stabilization and Side Power twenty-four-volt bow and stern thrusters, while anchoring and tight-quarters control are made effortless by a Maxwell twenty-four-volt windlass, dripless rudder seals, and robust 34-inch by 38-inch four-blade bronze propellers. Comfort is assured by MarineAire reverse-cycle air and heat and extended self-sufficiency comes courtesy of a Filtration Systems water maker; onboard luxury is further reflected in granite galley and vanity countertops and a GE Space Maker washer/dryer. A 2005 Nouvarania 430 DL RIB powered by a 60 hp Yamaha expands your cruising options, and a cockpit barbecue sets the stage for relaxed alfresco entertaining.

Electronics

A sophisticated onboard electronics package transforms every voyage, blending precise navigation with refined entertainment. Core navigational gear includes AIS, radar, GPS with chartplotter, a dedicated navigation center, a reliable compass, a log and speedometer, and a depthsounder, all augmented by instruments for wind speed and direction and supported by repeaters that make data clearly visible throughout the yacht. Course-keeping is effortless thanks to the autopilot, while VHF and radio systems ensure dependable communications; an onboard computer and Wi-Fi complete the shipboard digital suite. For moments of relaxation, a flat-screen TV and an additional television are supplied with a DVD player, CD player and VCR, and cockpit

speakers deliver rich sound across the decks.

Inside equipment

Meticulously outfitted for comfort and extended cruising, the interior features integrated air conditioning and heating with hot water available throughout. The galley is appointed with a refrigerator, oven, microwave oven and dishwasher, while a washing machine adds a level of self-sufficiency ideal for longer voyages. Core systems have been installed to exacting standards and include an air compressor, battery charger, electric bilge pump, electric head, fresh water maker and sea water pump. Confident maneuvering in marinas and tight quarters is assured by both a bow thruster and a stern thruster.

Outside equipment/extras

The deck is a study in refined utility, where plush cockpit cushions and a teak-laid cockpit establish an elegant setting for leisurely entertaining, while a freshwater cockpit shower and a sturdy swimming ladder simplify the transition from swim to deck. Practical handling is assured by a robust hydraulic winch and a versatile davit system that make launching and stowing the tender effortless, and a fin stabilizer system delivers a composed, comfortable ride underway. A capable tender rounds out the accommodation, providing prompt shore transfers whenever you wish.

Covers

A substantial, expertly engineered hardtop provides constant overhead shelter, guarding the cockpit from sun and sea spray while respecting the yacht's elegant, streamlined lines. The protected cockpit becomes a dry, refined living area, enabling effortless, comfortable cruising in a wide range of

conditions.

Electrical equipment

Power aboard is delivered by a robust generator that maintains all onboard systems whether underway or at anchor, while a refined inverter offers whisper-quiet AC power drawn from the battery bank for silent operation when preferred. A shore power inlet provides seamless dockside connection, allowing effortless charging and full use of onboard services while in port.

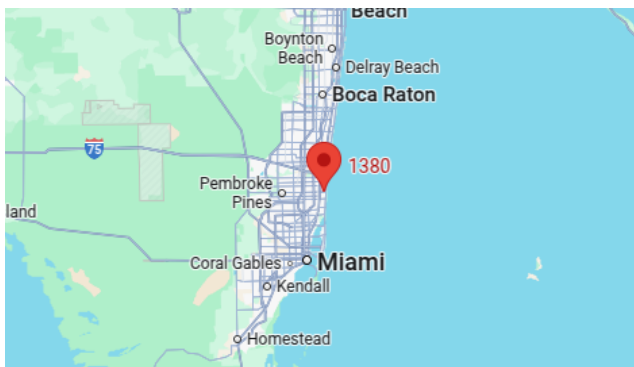
