OVERVIEW

A natural progression from the celebrated 65' Johnson Motor Yacht, the 70' Johnson luxury motor yacht offers four tastefully appointed staterooms and an additional crew cabin located aft of the engine room. Key enhancements include an expanded aft deck and a larger flybridge, together with a hydraulic tender platform that frees up extra flybridge space—an elegant flybridge yacht and cruising yacht conceived for refined, long-distance voyages.

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

I. Hull & deck – exterior general:

The main deck is laid in rich teak, setting a timeless tone for a yacht detailed with stainless steel integral rollers and a chain stopper for the anchor chain, leading to 250 feet of galvanized chain measuring 3/8" and driven by a Maxwell hydraulic RC12-12 windlass. The ground tackle is completed by a stainless steel 120 lb single anchor, while heavy-duty 316 stainless steel handrails, stanchions, cleats, and fairleads frame the deck with unwavering strength. Medium-tinted safety glass lends privacy and protection, and a pneumatic stainless steel saloon sliding door with push-button operation and safety sensors provides effortless entry. Stainless steel port lights and an S/S rub rail with rubber insert elegantly protect the hull and deck joint. At the stern, twin 24V Maxwell VC2500 capstans serve mooring duties beside the built-in aft deck seating with cushions and a dedicated aft deck table. LED low-level courtesy lighting illuminates both the side deck and aft deck, while sculpted stairs rise to the flybridge. A generous teak-inlay swim platform with stairway to the aft deck invites the sea, complemented by a hot and cold transom shower and a stainless steel swim ladder. The foredeck presents a sunbathing area and a water-resistant bow sun pad, and practicalities abound with dedicated water fill and diesel fill deck fittings. Washdowns are handled by a Flojet 4325-343L pump, and the cockpit benefits from a powerful LED floodlight. Handling tender operations is effortless with a Besenzoni hydraulic 24 V G304 davit, while canvas covers protect the exterior settee and tables. The entire hull gleams in white gelcoat for a pristine finish.

II. Underwater gear:

Underwater performance is driven by five-blade bronze propellers turning on

AquaTech 22HS 3" diameter stainless steel shafts supported by robust bronze P-brackets. Precision Tides sealing solutions include a 3" shaft seal and shaft log, with a 3" Tides rudder seal, all safeguarded by a comprehensive antifouling program featuring Sea Hawk primer systems Tuff Stuff 1284 Grey or 1285 White and Sea Hawk self-polishing copolymer antifouling Cukote in 3445 Black or 3430 Dark Blue. A 3" boot top stripe finishes the waterline in your choice of black, blue, or red. Dynamic control comes from twin Humphree Interceptor trim tabs H750, while a full cathodic bonding system protects vital metals via zinc anodes. Seawater strainers serve the main engines, genset, and air-conditioning, and every underwater fitting is secured with seacocks. The underwater exhaust system includes a bypass for optimal operation and quiet efficiency.

III. Flybridge:

The flybridge features an FRP non-skid deck and a thoughtfully arranged instrument console, complemented by built-in seating with plush cushions and a height-adjustable table. Entertaining is effortless with a U-Line combo refrigerator/ice maker, while navigation comes by your choice of Garmin or Raymarine systems. The Garmin suite delivers dual GPSMAP 8617 fully integrated multi-touch MFDs, a GMI 20 marine instrument display, a GMR Fantom 4" 40W 72NM solid-state open-array radar, a Garmin VHF 200 marine radio, a Garmin AIS 600 Class B transceiver, the GHP 20 marine autopilot system with SmartPump, and a Garmin GSD 25 marine network sounder 2 kW. Alternatively, the Raymarine package offers twin Raymarine GSi 5.4" multifunctional displays with Wi-Fi, an i70 multifunction color display, a 48" HD color open array with 4 kW pedestal, a Raymarine RAY218E VHF radio, a Raymarine AIS 650 Class B transceiver, a Raymarine Evolution autopilot with P70R control head and ACU 400 actuator control unit, and a Raymarine CP100 DownVision fishfinder. Seamanship is further enhanced by a rudder indicator

and magnetic compass, with stainless steel guard rails and grab rails ensuring confidence underway. Low-level 24V courtesy lighting adds ambience, while a PAR 60010-2024 24V search light and a commanding Buell air horn bolster safety. The helm is anchored by a Besenzoni P217 24V seat and a stainless steel steering wheel. Entertainment rises at a touch with a pop-up TV cabinet housing a Vizio M322I-B1 32" 1080p LED LCD HDTV, framed by a Fusion stereo system comprising the MS AV700i DVD/receiver with Fusion Link, four MS CL602 6" marine ceiling-mount speakers, and an MS BT200 Bluetooth adapter module for the Sirius port, complemented by Apple TV. Shipwide intelligence includes the C Zone AC/DC monitoring system, while situational awareness is heightened by a CCTV array with four cameras covering the engine room, saloon door, and aft deck port and starboard. One complete shipset of LED navigation lights completes the bridge specification.

IV. Engine propulsion & E/R equipments:

Power comes from twin Caterpillar C 18 ACERT 1015 HP engines mated to ZF 550IV gearboxes, each protected by Racor dual fuel filters, while the generator is likewise safeguarded by a dedicated Racor filter. The engine room is comprehensively soundproofed and thoughtfully laid out, a spacious compartment with diamond-pattern deck plates for secure footing. Fuel tanks feature BEP electric sending units, and safety is underwritten by an automatic Sea Fire fire extinguisher system. Fresh air delivery is ensured by an engine room air intake system, with AC fluorescent lights and DC dome lights illuminating every task. The Henderson BP0510 manual bilge pump stands ready, while freshwater pressure is maintained by a high-volume AC Headhunter March 5 M5 115 pump with a Groco PSR 4000004-24 24V DC pump for backup. Climate control is assured by chilled-water air conditioning via dual Cruisair compressors, each rated at 48,000 BTU. Extended autonomy is supported by a Sea Recovery 700 GPD water maker, and maintenance is

simplified by an oil changing pump serving engines, generator, and clutches. Electrical power off the dock is delivered by an ONAN MDKDS 29 kW 60 Hz generator, and hot water comes from twin Seaward HF2250 20 gallon heaters.

V. Electrical:

The yacht is equipped with a robust 110V/220 AC electrical system and a 24V DC system, supported by twin 70' Glendinning Cable Master CM7 50A shore systems. Dedicated battery chargers manage both 24V and 12V circuits, with an alternator split charging system for intelligent energy distribution. Ship service relies on four 255 Ah gel cell sealed batteries, engine starting is handled by four 255 Ah gel cell sealed batteries, and the genset is served by a single 210 Ah gel cell sealed battery. AC sockets are distributed throughout, with GFI protection fitted where required, and power management centers on a main electrical panel with AC and DC circuit breakers. Two automatic isolating and booster transformers rated at 50A ensure clean, stabilized current, complemented by an anti electrolysis bonding system. For silent power at anchor, a 4 kW inverter stands ready.

VI. Mechanical and plumbing system:

Onboard systems include a holding tank with macerator pump and a holding tank level indicator, while showers discharge to a dedicated sump pump. The freshwater network uses marine grade lines fed from a 260 gallon stainless steel water tank with sending unit, and propulsion is sustained by an aluminum fuel tank of 1130 gallons with a sending unit and easy read sight gauges for both fuel and water. A dockside freshwater inlet simplifies shoreside service, and color coded piping provides intuitive identification. All through hull fittings are protected by bronze intake valves, and a unified overboard discharge manifold minimizes the total number of hull

penetrations. The Sealand freshwater vacuum toilet system provides reliable sanitation. Safety is elevated with a high water bilge alarm across six areas and six Rule 3700 24V bilge pumps. Low speed control and docking finesse come from hydraulic bow and stern thrusters, and comfort at anchor is secured by "at rest" stabilizers.

VII. Interior finish:

The interior is crafted in a harmonious blend of cherry and ivory lacquer, dressed with the Andari collection of upholstery fabrics for a refined tactile palette. Owners may select marble shower floors and marble countertops, tailoring the ambience with stone that suits their personal aesthetic.

VIII. Galley:

A professional grade galley centers on a Sub Zero ID 24R drawer type refrigerator and a Sub Zero ID 24FI drawer type freezer, paired with a stainless steel sink and a pressurized hot and cold water system. Convenience is assured with a latest model Fisher & Paykel dishwasher, twin double AC sockets, and abundant cupboards, drawers, and organized stowage. Culinary versatility arrives via a latest model GE microwave with extractor fan, a latest model GE trash compactor, and a latest model Miele four burner cooktop, all set over a warm teak sole. An escape power window offers peace of mind and natural ventilation when desired.

IX. Saloon:

Entry to the saloon is through a pneumatic stainless steel sliding door with push button control and safety sensors, revealing a lounge anchored by a Vizio M471i A2 47" TV. Cinematic sound comes from a Bose Lifestyle 535

Series III home theater system, with a Pioneer BDP 160 Blu ray Disc player and Apple TV for seamless streaming. A high quality leather couch spans the lower saloon and dining area, complemented by blinds, curtains, and mood setting 24V low level lights with 24V LED ceiling lighting. The space is finished with a refined coffee table and indirect lighting for a warm glow. For connoisseurs, a latest model U Line wine cooler keeps bottles at perfect temperature, while laundry is streamlined by latest model Splendid washer and latest model Splendid dryer.

X. Master stateroom:

The master sanctuary features a king size berth with generous storage beneath and integrated drawers in the base, paired with a refined vanity. Illumination includes 24V LED ceiling lighting and two Cantalupi Milos chrome/matt nickel LED reading lights at 110 VAC. Each side is graced by two large rectangular portlight windows with a center section that opens for fresh breezes. Entertainment arrives via a Vizio M322I B1 32" 1080p LED LCD HDTV, a Fusion stereo system comprising the MS RA205 receiver/media player with full iPod/iPhone control, four MS CL602 6" marine ceiling mount speakers, and an MS BT200 Bluetooth adapter module for the Sirius port, augmented by a Sony BDP S360 Blu ray Disc player and Apple TV. A walk in closet completes this private retreat.

XI. Master ensuite shower room:

The master ensuite is appointed with a Sealand vacuum toilet in bone color, a wash basin set into a marble countertop, and a refined mix of hot and cold water fixtures with quality faucets and fittings. A dressing mirror and mirrored ceiling amplify light, while lacquered finishes above the basin countertop and warm veneer below provide textural contrast. Ventilation is assured by an

extractor fan, and convenience comes via an AC double socket with GFI. The shower area carries a durable lacquer finish, highlighted by 24V LED ceiling lights and a marble floor underfoot.

XII. Forward (vip) stateroom:

The forward VIP welcomes guests with a double berth offering storage beneath and drawers in the base, complemented by a walk in closet. Entertainment is served by a Vizio M3221 B1 32" 1080p LED LCD HDTV, a Fusion stereo system with MS AV700i DVD/receiver with Fusion Link, four MS CL602 6" marine ceiling mount speakers, and an MS BT200 Bluetooth adapter module for the Sirius port, plus Apple TV. Utility features include AC double sockets and an escape hatch, while each side presents a large rectangular portlight window with a center piece that opens for sea air. Ambient 24V LED ceiling lights and Quick MAYA30 24V reading lights ensure perfect illumination.

XIII. Forward (vip) ensuite shower room:

The VIP ensuite features a Sealand vacuum toilet in bone color, a wash basin set into a marble countertop, and hot and cold water delivered through quality faucets and fittings. A mirror and mirrored ceiling brighten the space, with lacquered finishes above the basin countertop and a warm veneer below. Ventilation is managed by an extractor fan, and an AC double socket with GFI adds convenience. The shower area carries a lacquer finish and gleams under 24V LED ceiling lights, all set over an elegant marble floor.

XIV. Port guest cabin:

The port guest cabin offers a serene double berth with under berth storage, illuminated by Quick MAYA30 24V reading lights and paired with two 24V LED

ceiling fixtures. A hanging locker provides wardrobe space. Entertainment comes via a Vizio M3221 B1 32" 1080p LED LCD HDTV and a Fusion stereo system comprising the MS AV700i DVD/receiver with Fusion Link, two MS CL602 6" marine ceiling mount speakers, and an MS BT200 Bluetooth adapter module for the Sirius port, alongside Apple TV.

XV. Port head/day head:

The port head/day head presents a Sealand vacuum toilet in bone color, a wash basin with a marble countertop, and reliable hot and cold water through fine faucets and fittings. The space is brightened by a mirror and mirrored ceiling, with a separate shower compartment in a lacquer finish for a clean, modern look. Convenience includes an AC double socket with GFI, lacquer finishes above the basin countertop, warm veneer below, an extractor fan for ventilation, 24V LED ceiling lights, and a luxurious marble floor.

XVI. Starboard guest cabin:

The starboard guest cabin mirrors its port counterpart with a double berth and under berth storage, Quick MAYA30 24V reading lights, and two 24V LED ceiling lights. Wardrobe needs are met by a hanging locker. Entertainment is supplied by a Vizio M3221 B1 32" 1080p LED LCD HDTV and a Fusion stereo system including the MS AV700i DVD/receiver with Fusion Link, two MS CL602 6" marine ceiling mount speakers, and an MS BT200 Bluetooth adapter module for the Sirius port, with Apple TV for streaming.

XVII. Crew cabin:

The crew cabin is accessed via a port side entrance door and is illuminated by 24V LED ceiling lights, with an AC double socket for practical use. Amenities

include a U Line CO29B03 icemaker and a Vizio 24" Class E2411 B1 Smart TV, with a Fusion stereo system comprising the MS AV700i DVD/receiver with Fusion Link, four MS CL602 6" marine ceiling mount speakers, and an MS BT200 Bluetooth adapter module for the Sirius port. Apple TV completes the modern comfort for the crew.

Remarks:

The 70' Johnson Flybridge (new construction) represents a rare opportunity to tailor a proven platform to your personal vision. Please note that this is an unbuilt new construction project that has not yet been started. A comprehensive standard specification, as detailed above, delivers a remarkably complete yacht from the outset, while a curated list of popular options and pricing is available to refine the build. Estimated completion is approximately 9–12 months, subject to concurrent yard projects. Options are available upon request, and all specifications are subject to change without notice. Pricing is FOB Taiwan and excludes duty and tariffs. As this is a new build offering, all photos shown are of previous projects; exact layout, wood species, and stone selections are the buyer's choice.


