70' Johnson Skylounge (New Build) — an unstarted, semi-custom endeavor conceived as a luxurious motor yacht with an enclosed flybridge skylounge, fashioned for elegant bluewater passage-making. The base specification arrives remarkably complete, and a carefully curated catalog of popular upgrades with pricing is available upon request; projected completion is approximately 9–12 months, subject to the yard's schedule. All specifications are subject to change without notice, and because this is a new construction offering, imagery reflects previous sisterships. Price is FOB Taiwan and includes U.S. Duty and full pre-delivery commissioning. Owners may customize the precise layout and choose their preferred woods and stone finishes, creating a personalized flybridge yacht that marries refined appointments with seaworthy performance—an exceptional new-build yacht for sale in the skylounge motor yacht category that carries both superyacht styling and long-range cruising credibility.

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

I. Hull & deck – exterior general:

The main deck is laid in teak, creating a warm and inviting surface that leads to stainless steel integral rollers and a chain stopper securing 250 feet of galvanized 3/8" chain driven by a MAXWELL hydraulic RC12-12 windlass paired with a single stainless steel 120 lb anchor, delivering confident anchoring and easy handling. Heavy-duty 316 stainless steel handrails and stanchions are matched by equally robust 316 stainless steel cleats and fairleads, while medium-tinted safety glass and stainless steel port lights wrap the superstructure in strength and clarity. A stainless-steel rub rail with a rubber insert protects the hull-to-deck joint, and a pneumatic stainless steel saloon sliding door operates at the touch of a button with safety sensors for smooth, assured access. Aft, twin MAXWELL VC2500 stern capstans, 24V and arranged in two sets, assist in line handling and service a built-in aft deck seating area finished with cushions and a matching aft deck table, all softly illuminated by LED low-level courtesy lighting on both side decks and the aft deck. Movement is effortless thanks to stairs to the flybridge and a large teak-inlay swim platform with a stairway to the aft deck, complemented by a hot-and-cold transom shower and a stainless steel swim ladder. Forward, a dedicated sunbathing and seating area invites relaxation, and practical deck fittings for water fill and diesel fill make service straightforward. A FLOJET 4325-343L deck washdown pump and a high-output LED cockpit floodlight prepare the yacht for any condition, with canvas covers protecting the exterior settee and tables. The bow's water-resistant sun pad is paired with U-shaped seating for luxurious lounging, and the hull is finished throughout in pristine white gel coat for lasting brilliance.

II. Underwater gear:

Beneath the waterline, five-blade bronze propellers are mounted on stainless steel AQUATECH 22HS shafts supported by bronze P-brackets, while Tides three-inch rudder seals and Tides three-inch shaft seals maintain watertight integrity. The bottom receives anti-fouling protection with Sea Hawk Primer Systems Tuff Stuff 1284 Grey or 1285 White, overlaid with Sea Hawk self-polishing copolymer antifouling Cukote 3445 Black or 3430 Dark Blue for long-lasting hull cleanliness. A three-inch boot top stripe may be specified in black, blue, or red to personalize the waterline, and dual HUMPHREE Interceptor trim tabs H750 provide precise attitude control underway and at rest. A full cathodic bonding system ties to zinc anodes for corrosion protection, while seawater strainers safeguard the engines, genset, and air-conditioning systems. Seacocks are fitted on all underwater fittings, and the underwater exhaust system is arranged to ensure smooth, quiet operation.

III. Skylounge:

The skylounge welcomes with a teak helm area that provides sure footing and a plush carpeted lounge area arranged before an instrument console, a leather sofa with a coffee table, and a U-LINE combo refrigerator/ice maker that keeps refreshments perfectly chilled. The helm is powered by a comprehensive GARMIN suite: dual GPSMAP 8617 fully integrated multi-touch MFDs, a GMI 20 marine instrument display, a GMR Fantom four-foot/40W/72NM solid-state open-array radar, a GARMIN VHF 210 marine radio, a GARMIN AIS 600 Class B transceiver, a GHP 20 marine autopilot system with SmartPump, and a GARMIN GSD 25 marine network sounder 2 kW, with navigation refined by a rudder indicator and a magnetic compass. Stainless steel guard rails and grab rails provide security, while dual SPEICH Nautic Type LP wipers clear the view. Safety and visibility are enhanced by 24V low-level courtesy lights, a PAR

60010-2024 24V search light, and a BUELL air horn. Comfort at the helm is assured by twin BESENZONI P217 24V helm seats, a stainless steel steering wheel, and a pop-up TV cabinet housing a VIZIO M322I-B1 32" 1080p LED LCD HDTV. Entertainment is rich and immersive thanks to a FUSION stereo system: in the skylounge the MS-AV700i DVD/receiver with FUSION Link drives MS-CL602 six-inch marine ceiling-mount speakers two, paired with an MS-BT200 Bluetooth adapter module for the Sirius port, while aft on the flybridge the MS-RA205 receiver/media player with full iPod/iPhone control powers MS-FR7021 seven-inch 260-watt speakers three with grilles and the same MS-BT200 Bluetooth adapter module. Apple TV brings streaming, a CCTV system with four cameras monitoring the engine room, saloon door, aft deck port and starboard provides confident oversight, and a full ship-set of LED navigation lights completes the command.

IV. Engine propulsion & engine room equipment:

Power is delivered by twin CATERPILLAR C-18 ACERT 1150 HP engines, each matched to ZF 550IV gearboxes and protected by dual RACOR engine fuel filters and a RACOR generator fuel filter to ensure impeccably clean fuel supply. The engine room is comprehensively soundproofed and laid out for service with diamond-pattern deck plates and generous access, while fuel tanks are monitored by BEP electric sending units and an automatic SEA-FIRE fire extinguisher provides fixed protection. Ventilation and illumination are achieved through an engine room air intake system, AC fluorescent lighting, and DC dome lights for clear visibility during maintenance. Bilge safety and serviceability are supported by a HENDERSON BP0510 manual bilge pump and a high-volume AC fresh water pressure pump complemented by a 24V DC pump, specifically a HEADHUNTER MARCH five M5-115 AC pump and a GROCO PSR 4000004-24 24V DC pump. Climate control is delivered by chilled water air conditioning via CRUISAIR units with 48,000 BTU compressors two, while

independence at sea is aided by a SEA RECOVERY 700 GPD water maker and an oil changing pump for engines, generator, and clutches. Shipboard electrical power is anchored by an ONAN MDKDS 29 kW 60 Hz generator, with hot water on demand provided by two SEAWARD HF2250 twenty-gallon water heaters. Environmental compliance is addressed by a 600 GPD HEADHUNTER sewage treatment system completing the specification.

V. Electrical:

A robust 110V/220V AC electrical system is paired with a 24V DC system to power every facet of life aboard, supported by twin seventy-foot GLENDINNING Cable Master CM7 50A units for seamless shore-power handling. Dedicated battery chargers serve both 24V and 12V circuits and are complemented by an alternator split charging system. Energy reserves consist of 255 AMP/HR GELL CELL sealed batteries for ship service four, 255 AMP/HR GELL CELL sealed batteries for engines four, and a 210 AMP/HR GELL CELL sealed battery for the genset one. AC sockets are distributed throughout the yacht with GFI protection where required, and a battery selector switch and a main electrical panel with AC and DC circuit breakers centralize control. Two 50A automatic isolating and booster transformers stabilize incoming power, an anti-electrolysis bonding system preserves underwater metals, and a 4 kW inverter extends silent power availability.

VI. Mechanical and plumbing system:

Onboard mechanical and plumbing systems are engineered for reliability, beginning with a holding tank equipped with a macerator pump and a holding tank level indicator for precise monitoring. Dedicated sump pumps service the showers, while marine-grade lines feed the fresh water system from a stainless steel water tank with sending unit holding 260 gallons, and fuel is stored in an

aluminum tank with sending unit at 1130 gallons, both fitted with sight gauges for visual verification. A dockside fresh water inlet accelerates turnaround, color-coded piping simplifies identification, and bronze intake valves secure all thru-hull fittings. An overboard discharge manifold minimizes the number of thru-hull penetrations, the SEALAND fresh water vacuum toilet system ensures dependable sanitation, and high-water bilge alarms monitor six areas. Rule 3700 bilge pumps 24V six keep the bilges dry, while bow and stern hydraulic thrusters enhance close-quarters handling and "at rest" stabilizers elevate comfort at anchor.

VII. Interior finish:

The interior joinery is executed in rich cherry complemented by a refined ivory lacquer, upholstered in the luxurious textures of the Andari collection to create a serene, contemporary ambiance that balances warmth and modernity. Owners have the option to specify marble shower floors and marble countertops, tailoring the palette and veining to their personal aesthetic and ensuring that stone selections harmonize with the cherry and lacquer finishes for a fully bespoke interior.

VIII. Galley:

The galley is fully equipped for gourmet cruising, featuring a SUB-ZERO ID-24R drawer-type refrigerator and a SUB-ZERO ID-24FI drawer-type freezer, a stainless steel sink with hot-and-cold water, and culinary-grade systems for precision. A FISHER & PAYKEL latest model dishwasher one handles cleanup, while double AC sockets two ensure ample power for appliances. Thoughtful cabinetry provides cupboards, drawers, and abundant stowage, and cooking is effortless with a GE latest model microwave with extractor fan, a GE latest model trash compactor, a MIELE latest model four-burner cooktop, all set over

a classic teak sole that brings warmth underfoot.

IX. Saloon:

The saloon opens through a pneumatic stainless steel sliding door to a refined living area anchored by a VIZIO M471i-A2 47" TV, a BOSE Lifestyle 535 Series III home theater system, and a PIONEER BDP-160 Blu-ray Disc player, with Apple TV for seamless streaming. A high-quality leather couch spans the lower saloon and dining area, and blinds and curtains allow precise light control while layered lighting—low-level 24V and ceiling LED 24V—creates atmosphere. A coffee table and indirect lighting complete the décor, a U-LINE 1115WC wine cooler keeps vintages at peak service temperature, and a SPLENDID latest model washer and SPLENDID latest model dryer are discreetly integrated for onboard convenience.

X. Master stateroom:

The master stateroom centers on a king-size berth with storage beneath and drawers in the base, complemented by a vanity and illuminated by 24V LED ceiling lighting and two CANTALUPI Milos/Chrome/Matt Nickel LED reading lights 110 VAC. Natural light pours through two large rectangular portlight windows on each side, with a center piece that opens for fresh air.

Entertainment includes a VIZIO M322I-B1 32" 1080p LED LCD HDTV and the FUSION system—MS-RA205 receiver/media player with full iPod/iPhone control driving MS-CL602 six-inch marine ceiling-mount speakers four with an MS-BT200 Bluetooth adapter module for the Sirius port—plus a SONY BDP-S360 Blu-ray Disc player and Apple TV. A walk-in closet completes this private sanctuary.

XI. Master ensuite shower room:

The master ensuite is appointed with a SEALAND vacuum toilet in bone color, a wash basin set into a marble countertop with hot-and-cold water and refined faucet fittings, and a dressing mirror with a mirrored ceiling that amplifies space and light. Finishes include lacquer above the basin countertop and veneered finish below, an extractor fan, an AC double socket with GFI for safety, a lacquer finish in the shower area, 24V LED ceiling lights, and a marble floor for a luxurious, easy-care environment.

XII. Forward (VIP) stateroom:

The forward VIP stateroom features a double berth with storage beneath and drawers in the base, a walk-in closet, and centered entertainment via a VIZIO M322I-B1 32" 1080p LED LCD HDTV. QUICK MAYA30 24V reading lights two and 24V LED ceiling lights set the mood, while a FUSION stereo—MS-AV700i DVD/receiver with FUSION Link powering MS-CL602 six-inch marine ceiling-mount speakers four and paired with an MS-BT200 Bluetooth adapter module for the Sirius port—delivers premium sound. Apple TV expands streaming options, AC double sockets add convenience, and an escape hatch is provided for safety. One large rectangular portlight window each side features a center piece that opens for added ventilation.

XIII. Forward (VIP) ensuite shower room:

The VIP ensuite combines a SEALAND vacuum toilet in bone color, a wash basin set into a marble countertop with hot-and-cold water and elegant faucets and fittings, and a dressing mirror with a mirrored ceiling that enhances the sense of volume. Finishes include lacquer above the basin countertop and veneer below, an extractor fan, an AC double socket with GFI

for safety, a lacquered shower area, 24V LED ceiling lights, and a marble floor for sophisticated durability.

XIV. Port guest cabin:

Thoughtfully designed for comfort, the port guest cabin offers one double berth with under-berth storage, QUICK MAYA30 24V reading lights two, 24V LED ceiling lights two, and a hanging locker. Entertainment includes a VIZIO M322I-B1 32" 1080p LED LCD HDTV and a FUSION stereo—MS-AV700i DVD/receiver with FUSION Link driving MS-CL602 six-inch marine ceiling-mount speakers two and paired with an MS-BT200 Bluetooth adapter module for the Sirius port—along with Apple TV for streaming.

XV. Port head/day head:

The port head/day head features a SEALAND vacuum toilet in bone color, a wash basin with a marble countertop and hot-and-cold water, refined faucets and fittings, and a mirror with a mirrored ceiling. A separate shower compartment with a lacquer finish, an AC double socket with GFI, lacquer above and veneer below the basin countertop, an extractor fan, 24V LED ceiling lights, and a marble floor deliver both elegance and everyday practicality.

XVI. Starboard cabin:

The versatile starboard cabin functions as a serene workspace and retreat, featuring a desk with overhead storage, a hanging closet, concealed shelving and storage, and illumination by 24V LED ceiling lights two. Additional stowage is provided by a hanging locker, and audio is served by a FUSION system—MS-RA205 receiver/media player with full iPod/iPhone control

powering MS-CL602 six-inch marine ceiling-mount speakers two and complemented by an MS-BT200 Bluetooth adapter module for the Sirius port—so the atmosphere is always tuned to taste.

XVII. Crew cabin:

Designed for practicality and morale, the crew cabin includes 24V LED ceiling lights, an AC double socket, and a U-LINE CO29B03 icemaker to keep service effortless. Off-duty hours are enhanced by a VIZIO 24" Class E241I-B1 Smart TV and a FUSION stereo—MS-AV700i DVD/receiver with FUSION Link powering MS-CL602 six-inch marine ceiling-mount speakers four and paired with an MS-BT200 Bluetooth adapter module for the Sirius port—while Apple TV provides streaming convenience.
