OVERVIEW

The Azimut 70's 22-metre silhouette lengthens beyond the edges of a photograph and feels even more commanding afloat, a living reflection of the precision and purpose embedded in every contour. As a continuing chapter in luxury motor yacht evolution, it awakens new impressions at every voyage.

That sense of proportion is heightened by the daring glazing imagined by Stefano Righini. Towering and expansive, the windows total more than 15 square metres, their sculptural "shark's fin" emerging from the deckhouse and unfurling into perfectly elliptical panes. Bold in both shape and utility, they flood the interior with natural light to spectacular effect—an "extreme" signature of this flybridge yacht.

Aft, the cockpit is arranged for effortless hospitality, focused on a welcoming C-shaped sofa and a dining table sized for eight guests. Above, the 11-square-metre flybridge transforms into an open-air salon—an ideal platform for sunbathing, alfresco dining, cocktails and easy conversation—designed for comfort whether cruising the coast or making passages.

On the main deck, length, beam, height and refinement meet. Seating is upholstered in elegant Rubelli textiles, while decapé oak cabinetry is finished with tactile leather trim. The result is a level of sophistication more commonly found on superyachts, tempered by a warm, contemporary sensibility crafted for discerning yachtsmen.

Midships, the full-beam owner's suite is set between two panoramic windows divided into four vertical sections, two of which open to admit fresh air. Daylight pours into a starboard dinette with an integrated vanity and a portside chest topped with a tray. Approximately 15 square metres of private living are complemented by a walk-in wardrobe; the bed's leather headboard is gently framed by mirrored surrounds for a touch of refined glamour.

Below decks, the arrangement sets a benchmark in its class: four cabins and four bathrooms prepared for family and guests. As the standout in the 70-foot motor yacht category, the Azimut 70 delivers roughly 30 square metres of flybridge living between sea and sky, while more than 15 square metres of glazing draw daylight deep into the interior. Balanced, athletic and unmistakably elegant, this performance cruising yacht's reputation is no accident—it is classic Azimut.

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

General

The Azimut 70's twenty-two metres of hull length unfold like a promise in every photograph and become even more imposing on the water, a living canvass that elegantly reflects the revolutionary lines with which she was conceived. That sense of scale is magnified by Stefano Righini's intentionally "extreme" window design: panes as tall and as wide as they are bold, with a combined surface of over 15 square metres, sculpted into a striking shark's fin that rises from the deckhouse and flows into the perfectly elliptical outlines of the glazing, admitting an extraordinary flood of natural light. Generous space has been devoted to the cockpit, where an inviting C-shaped sofa embraces a dining table that seats eight guests in complete comfort, while the flybridge, with its eleven square metres, becomes an ideal refuge for relaxation, dining and cocktails, encouraging effortless socialising under open skies. The main deck celebrates four dimensions — length, width, height and elegance — with seating upholstered in Rubelli décor fabrics and furniture in decapé oak enhanced by leather details, creating an atmosphere of refined conviviality. Midships, the owner's cabin stretches full beam, its two panoramic windows composed of four vertical sections, two of which open to invite fresh sea air; abundant light bathes a cosy dinette with a built-in vanity to starboard and a chest of drawers with a tray top to port, while the suite's fifteen square metres of living space and a generous walk-in wardrobe deliver absolute comfort, the bed's leather headboard artfully framed in a mirror. Below, the lower deck is the most complete in its class, offering four cabins and four bathrooms, while as the largest flybridge in its category the Azimut 70 provides thirty square metres to savour between sky and sea; with over 15 square metres of glass surfaces allowing light to cascade through and a balanced design that defines

the entire range, it is no accident that the 70 is a resounding success, and it is no accident that she is an Azimut.
