OVERVIEW

Delivered in 2013 and currently lying in Mugla, Turkey, this Azimut 70 is the essence of Italian yachtmaking, fusing timeless refinement with contemporary capability. Measuring 21.60 metres overall with a 5.60 metre beam, the yacht's luminous Carlo Galeazzi interior is appointed in high gloss walnut and supple cream leather, offering accommodation for eight guests across four ensuite staterooms, while a separate crew cabin for two preserves privacy and service. Twin MAN engines propel a GRP hull for assured, efficient cruising, and the flybridge layout amplifies alfresco living with a generous bridge deck complete with a wet bar, sun loungers and teak laid decks throughout. A fully equipped galley and an elegant dining area for eight enhance onboard life, while Raymarine displays and a BOSE sound system provide modern navigation and entertainment. Additional highlights include twin 20 kW KOHLER generators, a hydraulic swim platform and comprehensive household appliances—an accomplished performance cruiser for Mediterranean adventures.

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Specification - standard and optional exrtas

The interior is crafted with the unmistakable Azimut touch, where high-gloss walnut, cream leather upholstery, and expansive windows bathe each space in natural light to create a bright, elegant atmosphere. A generous saloon with a U-shaped sofa and panoramic windows flows into a formal dining area for 8 guests, while the fully equipped galley—complete with refrigerator, freezer, oven, dishwasher, and abundant storage—caters to extended cruising. A lower helm station integrates a full Raymarine navigation suite for complete command in all conditions, and an entertainment ecosystem combines TV, a high-fidelity sound system, onboard WiFi, and satellite TV to keep guests connected and entertained underway or at anchor. Outdoors, a vast flybridge hosts a helm, wet bar, BBQ grill, dining area, and sun loungers for effortless open-air living. Teak graces the cockpit, swim platform, and side decks, while a hydraulic swim platform simplifies launching a tender or jet-ski. Forward, cushioned sunpads invite relaxed sunbathing, and the aft cockpit dining area—shaded by the flybridge overhang—sets the scene for long alfresco meals in comfort. The navigation and equipment package centers on Raymarine multifunction displays, complemented by GPS, radar, autopilot, VHF, and a depth sounder. Bow and stern thrusters deliver precise low-speed control, and two KOHLER 20 kW generators support air conditioning throughout. A watermaker extends autonomy, a hydraulic gangway eases boarding, and electric winches with a robust anchor system streamline handling. Electrical systems are configured for global versatility with 220V/24V/12V circuits. Climate control is assured by an air-conditioning and heating unit operating on 12V, 24V, and 220V, backed by 2 x 20 kW KOHLER generators, a battery charger, inverter, and shore power plug for seamless

dockside connectivity. Additional options heighten capability and comfort with a bow thruster, a hard-top on the flybridge featuring an opening sunroof, extensive teak decking on the platform, cockpit, and side decks, a bathing ladder, a chain counter, a shore water plug, stern mooring winches, a telescopic passerelle, a hydraulic bathing platform, and a flybridge wetbar with fridge and grill. Practical cruising enhancements include a holding tank, water heater, and water pump. The galley and household suite is thoughtfully appointed with a 4-burner hob and hood, oven, fridge, freezer, icemaker, and dishwasher, ensuring gourmet readiness on every passage. Entertainment is immersive and refined, featuring a BOSE Home Theatre, BOSE Hi-Fi stereo sound system, DVD/CD player, dedicated speakers on the cockpit and flybridge, and 3 flatscreen TVs distributed for relaxed viewing throughout.

General - accomodation & layout

AZIMUT 70, 2013 model year, epitomizes the shipyard's mastery of luxury yacht design, blending timeless Italian style with advanced engineering and poised performance. Conceived by Stefano Righini with interiors by Carlo Galeazzi, the yacht exudes elegance, volume, and comfort across every deck, inviting effortless living at sea. A planing GRP hull delivers efficient cruising and agile seakeeping, while powerful twin MAN engines harmonize speed with refinement, making this 70-footer an ideal companion for extended coastal passages and island-hopping adventures. Accommodation and layout are tailored for privacy and conviviality in equal measure, offering 4 guest cabins plus 1 crew cabin to host 8 guests and 2 crew in comfort. The full-beam master suite amidships features panoramic windows and an ensuite bathroom; a forward VIP also enjoys its own ensuite; twin guest cabins to port and starboard are arranged with twin beds and benefit from separate bathrooms; and well-conceived crew quarters are positioned aft with convenient access from the cockpit. Four bathrooms in total, each ensuite to its respective cabin,

underscore the yacht's dedication to personal space and refined onboard living.
