OVERVIEW

The 2023 Viking 72 “Free Spool” merges refined luxury with uncompromising sportfishing performance, offering an elevated convertible platform for both serious anglers and those seeking relaxed cruising in high style. Every inch reflects pedigree and purpose, from the sleek exterior lines to the sumptuous accommodations beneath deck.

Power comes from upgraded MTU Series 2000 V16 M96L engines, backed by extended warranty protection through 12/2027 or 3,400 hours to provide confidence for seasons ahead. Cutting-edge electronics include Furuno Omni Full Color Sonar, while a Seakeeper SK26 gyro—also under warranty until 12/2026—ensures exceptional stability and a composed ride when the sea demands it.

The tournament-ready cockpit is thoughtfully equipped for bluewater work with a refrigerated fish box, two ice makers and generous storage to support long days on the bite. Inside, a four-stateroom, five-head arrangement finished in high-gloss walnut delivers generous private accommodations and all the modern conveniences, anchored by a chef-caliber galley. Comfort is heightened throughout with helm air-conditioning and a custom teak helm pod that perfectly complements the yacht’s refined aesthetic.

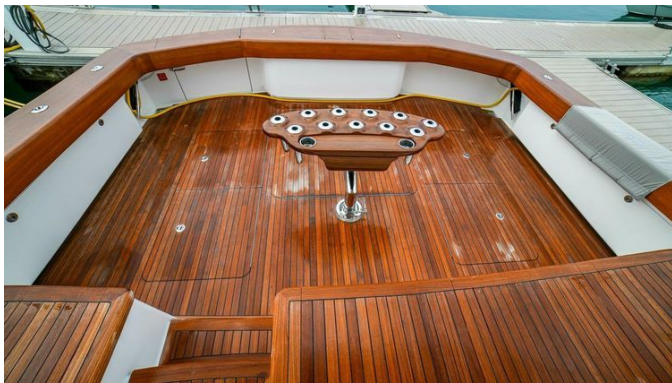

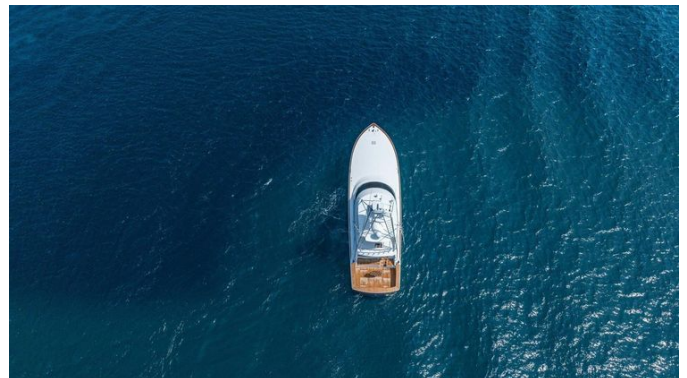












DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Interior and layout

Engineered to marry private retreats with easy, everyday living, the accommodation comprises four staterooms and five heads, including a conveniently positioned day head in the salon for guests' use. Gloss-finished horizontal walnut flows throughout the interior, imparting a warm, contemporary sophistication that unifies each space. Sanitary needs are handled by the proven Headhunter head system, providing dependable and high-performance operation.

Galley

Every element of the galley has been carefully considered and impeccably finished. Cold storage is abundant and organized with an additional undercounter refrigerator featuring drawers alongside an undercounter refrigerator-and-freezer unit, also equipped with drawer storage. Culinary work is made effortless by a conventional oven tucked beneath a surface-mounted stovetop, paired with a stainless steel undermount sink and a satin nickel faucet that lends a refined gleam. Underfoot, bespoke Amtico flooring harmonizes with a custom countertop in Pental Quartz Amarcord and a matching full-height polished Pental Quartz Amarcord backsplash for a unified, luxurious aesthetic. Overhead LED lighting is fitted with a dimmer to set the perfect mood, while everyday convenience is addressed by a discreet pull-out trash can. Adjacent to the workspace, a custom dinette platform supports an elegant wood dinette table on a wood pedestal, creating an inviting spot for dining and gathering.

Salon

Step through the electric salon door into an impeccably appointed living area where refined joinery and thoughtful functionality meet. Rich wood valances and wood strips in the salon headliner establish a sophisticated architectural cadence that continues in the custom companionway horizontal wood stripping and the bespoke companionway wood door and frame enclosing the linen closet; detailed wood trim crisply defines the junction where Amtico meets carpet. Entertaining is effortless thanks to a 55-inch pop-up television seamlessly housed within the entertainment center, while a clear ice maker and a custom storage ottoman complete with a Viking-supplied wood tray ensure refreshments and comfort are always at hand. Practical convenience is integrated without compromise: the electric panel is positioned up in the salon, overhead LED lights are fitted with dimmers to set the perfect ambiance, and modern power needs are addressed with a custom 110-volt outlet including a USB port and an AC receptacle discreetly tucked beneath the dinette table. A day head finished with custom Amtico flooring provides quick-access convenience, and the flooring throughout is protected by a full carpet runner canvas in the salon and a Costa canvas carpet runner with step covers in the companionway.

Master stateroom

A refined synthesis of fine joinery and considered conveniences defines the master stateroom, where a 40-inch flat-screen television is set into a wooden crown-molded surround and LED lighting with dimmer control sculpts the ambiance. Storage has been carefully rethought with a custom extended under-bed rod compartment that keeps gear neatly concealed, while a bespoke headboard rising to a full height of 12 inches provides a strong, architectural focal point. Flanking wooden columns and a coordinating

nightstand introduce tactile warmth and compositional balance, completing this tranquil, impeccably appointed retreat.

Master head

The master head is distinguished by a mirrored ceiling that bathes the space in reflected light and visually expands the volume, paired with a custom one-piece frameless glass shower door that preserves a seamless, uninterrupted profile. Underfoot, custom Amtico flooring combines durability with refined elegance, while the vanity is crowned with a custom polished Pental Quartz Amarcord vanity top, delivering a sumptuous and resilient surface.

Forward stateroom

Gentle LED lighting, fully dimmable, bathes the cabin in a warm, inviting glow while a 32" flat screen television offers effortless onboard entertainment; the berth hides extended storage beneath, accessed through a purpose built hatch for easy reach into the space below.

Forward stateroom head

The mirrored ceiling magnifies both light and perceived volume, bathing the space in a brighter, more open ambiance. Beneathfoot, custom Amtico flooring delivers a refined, marine-ready surface that pairs durability with understated sophistication. Anchoring the arrangement is a custom polished Pental Quartz Amarcord vanity top, its sleek contemporary finish imparting lasting elegance to the head.

Crew stateroom

The crew stateroom is crafted for quiet luxury, illuminated by soft LED lighting controlled by a dimmer to create the ideal ambience, and equipped with a 22-inch flat-screen TV for onboard entertainment. Discreet outboard storage is tucked behind custom wood cabinet doors, keeping necessities impeccably organized, while a bespoke, wider lower bunk expands sleeping space and comfort to ensure truly restorative rest between passages.

Crew head

A mirrored ceiling in the crew head expands both light and the perceived volume of the space, creating a brighter, airier ambience throughout the compartment. Underfoot, tailor made Amtico flooring provides a resilient, finely grained surface designed for long term wear while retaining a refined texture. The vanity is finished with a custom polished Pental Quartz Amarcord vanity top, whose soft luster and robust composition deliver enduring performance and a quietly luxurious touch that elevates everyday functionality.

Port stateroom

Dimmable LED lighting casts a soft, controllable glow throughout the stateroom, creating an atmosphere of refined calm; a custom-raised upper bunk increases headroom and eases access, while both bunks have been custom-widened for superior sleeping comfort, and the lower bunk incorporates custom storage drawers beneath for efficient, discreet stowage.

Cockpit

The sweeping mezzanine cockpit is conceived for high-performance sportfishing and effortless entertaining, finished with bespoke teak decking and coaming boards, a custom faux-teak transom and an elegant faux-and-clear treatment on the exterior side of the salon door. Purposeful fishing features include two full-length fishboxes, a cockpit fishbox with a split lid, and a transom coaming outfitted with a gate and fish box, while integrated transom swim steps ensure convenient water access. Shade and protection are provided by a Costa cockpit sunshade mounted on carbon fiber poles, paired with a matching Costa cockpit cover. Cold storage and bait management are comprehensively arranged with a cockpit freezer equipped with bait trays, a refrigerated cockpit step box, a crushed-ice machine that discharges into the starboard mezzanine box and a second ice maker dedicated to the starboard fishbox. Power requirements are handled by two 24V 30AMP outlets forward under the coaming—one to port and one to starboard—along with two 12VDC 30AMP outlets similarly under the coaming, and a second cable master located in the cockpit. Lighting balances utility and atmosphere through tri-color lights in the aft deck overhang, tri-color rope lights beneath the coaming, and cockpit DC lights incorporated into the fighting chair. The cockpit is fitted and plumbed for two on-deck livewells, and thoughtful engineering includes a power actuator for the Seakeeper hatch plus storage lockers beneath both the port and starboard coamings.

Flybridge & helm

From the refined Release teak helm pod fitted with electronic single-lever controls to recessed electronics boxes closed with push-button catches, the flybridge combines precision engineering with refined aesthetics. Helm air conditioning maintains a composed environment, while custom Release

Marine Trillion Series helm chairs provide ergonomic support for extended passages. Essential systems are arranged for clarity and convenience: a VHF Radio Icom-604 sits at hand and a dedicated watermaker control panel is positioned on the flybridge, with separate batteries reserved for electronics to ensure continued performance. Functional refinement is evident in split radio box lids for rapid access, a refrigerated bridge drink box alongside a bridge freezer box, and a freshwater outlet on the bridge for easy rinsing. LED floodlights mounted on the hardtop light night operations, a handrail along the side of the helm console above the helm access door steadies movement, and a removable backrest for the flybridge jump seat provides adaptable seating when required.

Tower

A bespoke tuna tower by Palm Beach Towers provides an elevated command post, featuring a 9'6" gap framed in polished pipe that marries structural integrity with refined aesthetics. Evening and overnight operations are assured by tri-color Lumitec LED lighting, complemented by a complete Rigid lighting ensemble that includes a 50" RDS light bar with diffused lenses mounted aft, a 20" RDS light bar with diffused lenses mounted forward, and an additional Rigid 50" light bar positioned forward on the platform. The generous oval radar pod is configured for serious offshore use, fitted with an enlarged sliding door and dedicated brackets for Taser reels, while the molded standing platform integrates a molded storage box for secure gear stowage. All control functions are centralized within a 63" control box featuring a flush-mounted compass and a recessed electronics box with a lid, sheltered beneath a molded tower sunshade with internal tracks. Rod handling is meticulous, with eight polished holders welded to the rail and six polished holders welded to the aft tower legs, and spread deployment is managed by 47' Rupp Big Rig hydraulic outriggers in a 4 Spreader HD configuration. For precise deep-drop and teaser

control, the installation includes two Miya Epoch Super US9 R units with high-speed motors, delivering the power and responsiveness demanded offshore.

Deck

The forward deck has been specified for both function and refined aesthetics, featuring a removable stainless steel anchor fairlead and an upgraded Lewmar Delta stainless anchor, both deployed and retrieved with confidence via a Lewmar V4 stainless steel windlass. Within the bow's anchor locker a freshwater washdown and a dedicated anchor bracket keep the area tidy and secure, while a discreet sliding fender track beneath the rub-rail runs from the transom to the cabin edge to allow precise fender placement along the hull. A tasteful faux teak toe rail completes the composition, introducing a warm, classical accent to the deck.

Electronics

A commanding, professional navigation and entertainment suite defines the Electronics package, beginning with a Furuno UHD Digital Radar 25 kW fitted with a six-foot array and integrated into the Furuno TZT2BB NavNet TZtouch2 system with a TZT2BB Controller and Furuno GP330B GPS antenna, all presented on a dedicated Seatronx nineteen-inch touchscreen for uncompromised situational awareness. Navigation is further enhanced by a Garmin GPSMAP TS MFD preloaded with coastal charts paired with the Garmin Remote Input GRID, a second Seatronx nineteen-inch touchscreen, a Garmin 24XD GPS antenna, and a Garmin GPSMAP twelve-inch unit carefully installed within the teaser reel box. For sub-surface imaging the Furuno FCV 1900 sounder works in concert with a Furuno CA50BL-12HR 2 kW 50 kHz transducer and a Furuno CA200B-8B 2 kW 200 kHz transducer, supplemented by a third

Seatronx nineteen-inch touchscreen, a Garmin GDS-26 CHIRP Video Sounder Module and an Airmar PM411C-LWM ultra wide beam transducer to deliver a high-resolution, complete picture beneath the hull. Real-time depth and environmental data are provided by a Garmin GMI20 marine instrument interfaced with an Airmar DT820BV-235-N2 transducer and an Airmar ST850 speed and temperature transducer, while offshore sonar capability is ensured by a Furuno CSH8L 600 mm sonar mounted with a custom AME sonar shaft fairing and supported by a Poly-Planar external speaker and dedicated sonar remote control. Precise autopilot and steer-by-wire control are supplied by a Garmin Reactor 40 Corepack with GHC 50 and Garmin interconnect cable. Communications are handled with redundancy and clarity through two ICOM IC-M605 BLK VHF radios installed with an ICOM MB75 VHF flush mount and paired to two custom-painted black Comrod sixteen-foot VHF antennas, with voice reinforcement from a Poly Planar external VHF speaker. Onboard audio and entertainment are delivered by a Fusion MS-RA770 Apollo Series touchscreen stereo with Apple AirPlay and a Fusion MS-ACSXV-Only Sirius/XM tuner, amplified by a JL Audio M700/5 feeding four JL M6 Marine 8.8 speakers and two JL M6 Marine eight-inch subwoofers, while uninterrupted connectivity at sea is provided by Starlink. Safety and awareness systems include three GOST Wide Angle 1080p mini ball cameras augmented by a FLIR M364C color thermal camera system, and salon comfort and control are refined with an Apple TV5 64 GB digital media receiver alongside a fanless mini PC (4 GB, WiFi, Windows 10). Vessel security and tracking are protected by the GOST Apparition AME 204 package. From the tower, a Garmin GPSMap 8612 integrates with an ICOM HM 195B (Blk) HM-195 Command Mic and two JL M6 6.5-inch speakers to provide confident command aloft, while the cockpit features fingertip audio control via a Fusion Apollo ERX400 wired remote that feeds a JL Audio M600/1 subwoofer amp and a JL Audio M400/4 channel 100w amplifier powering two JL M6 Marine 8.8-inch speakers and two JL M6 Marine 10-inch subwoofers, with navigation and data displayed on a Garmin GPSMAP

8617. The nocturnal ambiance is elevated by four Lumishore underwater lights complemented by a Lumishore TIX803 EOS color-changing pair, allowing vivid, customizable illumination after dark.

Engine room and mechanical

Beneath the yacht's decks, an upgraded MTU Series 2000 V16 M96L engine package provides formidable performance and is backed by an extended engine warranty, while onboard electrical demands are reliably handled by two Onan 29 kW generators. Access to the engine room is conveniently arranged from the stateroom and is monitored by dedicated engine room cameras, and day-to-day serviceability is enhanced by 24 V fuel priming pumps, a Willy Vac, and two white toolboxes neatly mounted on shelves above the generators. The centralized seawater system is engineered with Electrosea protection, upgraded pumps and raised mounting plates to ease routine maintenance, and a backup seawater pump plumbed in parallel offers assured redundancy. Fresh water is supplied by a Headhunter freshwater pump and polished by a Spotzero/Watermaker combo unit to maintain superior water quality throughout the vessel. Ride stability is addressed by a Seakeeper SK 26 covered under warranty until 12/2026, with a dedicated 24 V DC fan in the lazarette supporting the Seakeeper's operation.

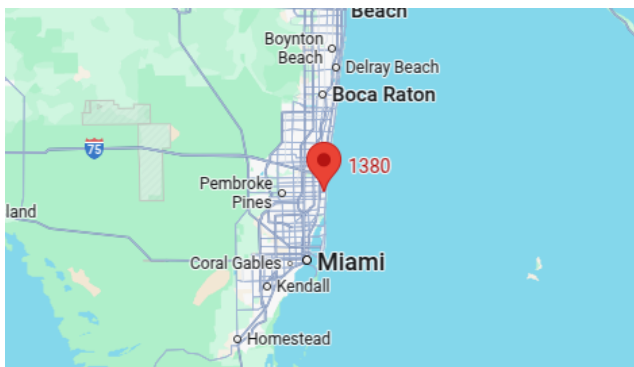
