OVERVIEW

RITI is a finely fashioned motor yacht—an elegant luxury flybridge vessel with classic wooden lines and true bluewater cruising credentials—presented in immaculate, near-new condition after three discerning owners. Built of fine wood and launched in 1989, she combines timeless craftsmanship with capable offshore performance.

Measuring roughly 22.00 m overall with a beam of about 5.39 m and a draft near 2.48 m, RITI offers generous interior volume with 2.00 m of headroom and a displacement of approximately 40,000 kg, proportions that lend both seagoing stability and gracious accommodation.

Certified to carry 12 guests and rated for navigation up to 150 NM from a safe haven, she balances passenger capacity with genuine offshore capability for comfortable extended passages.

Under her decks the propulsion is purposeful and refined: twin MAN engines delivering $2 \times 1,343$ kW (1,826 HP), running on diesel to achieve a steady passage speed of 18 kn and a thrilling top speed of 28 kn, with a practical range of roughly 500 NM and only 20 recorded engine hours.

Tankage is generous for extended cruising, with fuel stored in $5 \times 1,000$ L tanks and fresh water held in $2 \times 1,000$ L tanks, supporting autonomy and comfort at sea.

Inside, the accommodation is thoughtful and elegant: 4 cabins providing 6 + 2 berths and 4 bathrooms/wet rooms. A full-beam owner's suite enjoys privacy and its own shower and WC; two twin guest staterooms each include en-suite shower and WC; a crew cabin also benefits from an en-suite shower and WC. A grand saloon furnishes a refined space for entertaining, while the flybridge affords open-air cruising and panoramic outlooks.

The galley is comprehensively equipped to professional standards, appointed

with an extraction hood, freezer, electric hob, oven, sink, two refrigerators and an additional electric fridge to accommodate provisioning for extended voyages.

Navigation and electronics are complete and redundant where it matters: fish finder, VHF transceiver, echo sounder, chartplotter and a chartplotter with integrated GPS, standalone GPS, radar and radar reflector, autopilot, onboard computer, weather receiver, plus paper sea charts and harbour pilot guides for traditional navigation backup.

A hardtop provides shelter on deck while maintaining the flybridge's open character.

The technical systems are robust and modern: a battery bank with battery charger and master switch, generator, solar array and shore-power inlet; automatic and electric bilge pumps together with a bilge alarm; electric bow and stern capstans and a stern rudder; air-conditioning and engine-driven heating; hot water and pressurized water systems; inverter; searchlight; watermaker; underwater illumination; position flares; and tachometers.

Deck appointments and entertainment facilities are extensive and designed for ease and leisure: foredeck hatch, electric passerelle, integrated bathing platform and hydraulic swim platform, aft, bow and additional deck showers, teak-laid decks, guard rails, cockpit dining table with carpeting and speakers, a home cinema system with Blu-ray player and MP3/CD/radio unit, TV with satellite system, automatic satellite antenna and DVB-T TV antenna. The foredeck offers sunpads with protective cushion covers; stainless-steel window frames and hydraulic trim tabs enhance durability and performance. A tender garage houses a dinghy with outboard; additional conveniences include washer & dryer, deck cooler box, antifouling coat, fenders, primary and secondary anchors, boarding/bathing ladder and comprehensive owners' manuals.

Safety equipment is complete and ready: fire extinguishers, a fixed fire

suppression system, EPIRB beacon, life raft, life jackets, a pyrotechnic distress kit, smoke detector and signal flags.


