OVERVIEW

Poised yet commanding, this 72-foot 2004 performance motor yacht, lying in the United States, combines exhilarating pace with refined comfort. Powered by twin MAN inboard diesels, she cruises confidently at 32 knots and can push to a 34-knot sprint, while an 18-foot beam provides exceptional stability and generous interior volume. Built with a robust fiberglass hull and fiberglass decks, the yacht offers durable, low-maintenance construction that contributes to a quiet, assured ride ideal for extended passages or relaxed weekend escapes.

The interior is bathed in natural light and finished with tasteful materials that foster an atmosphere tailored for entertaining, unwinding, and unhurried passagemaking. Accommodations are thoughtfully arranged and supported by three well-appointed heads, ensuring privacy and comfort for family and guests, and a dedicated crew cabin makes both owner-operator and fully crewed arrangements equally practical. Generous tankage—approximately 1,109 gallons of diesel and 317 gallons of freshwater—adds valuable range between ports, reinforcing the vessel's blend of performance and practicality. From her seakindly hull form to the smooth delivery of inboard diesel power, this elegant fiberglass motor yacht is as comfortable slipping into a favorite harbor as she is carving through open water. Available now in the United States, this proven 72-foot platform presents a compelling opportunity for buyers seeking speed, volume, and timeless style; clean trades considered.

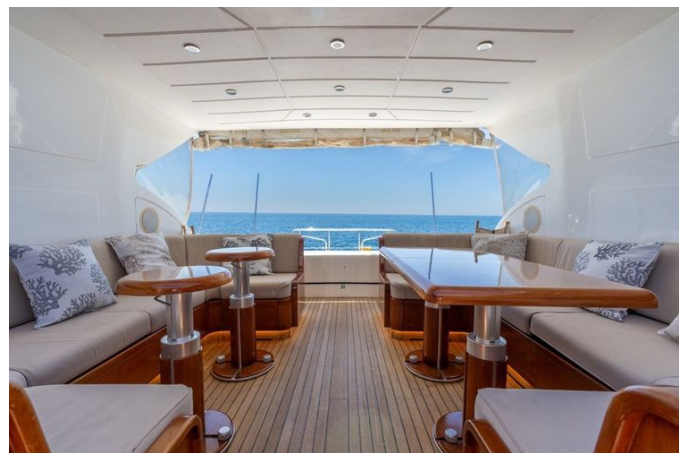
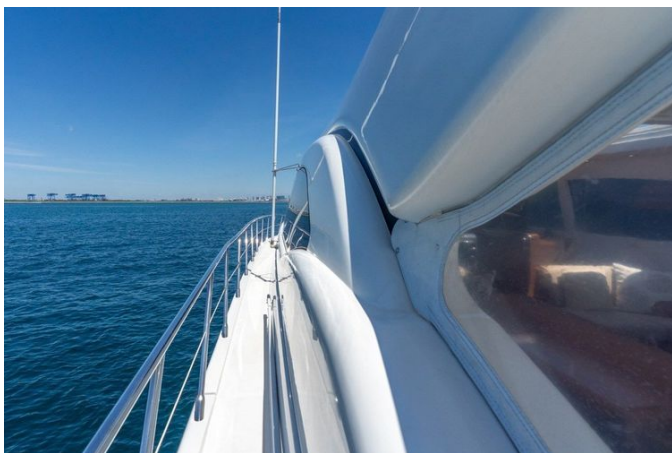

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Description

The Mangusta 72 by Overmarine epitomizes Italian engineering where high-performance capability meets refined elegance, offering exhilarating pace balanced by composed handling and a striking silhouette. Her streamlined profile and impressive cruising range create an on-water experience that is at once dynamic and effortlessly sophisticated. The interior has been intelligently configured to sleep up to seven guests across three cabins, anchored by an inviting main salon and a fully equipped galley that support comfortable extended cruising or gracious entertaining. Outside, broad teak decks provide generous lounging areas and easy access to the sea, while a dedicated tender garage, an included jet ski and contemporary onboard systems expand the yacht's versatility and leisure options.

A comprehensive refit completed in 2022 delivered substantial enhancements throughout the yacht, including upgraded interiors, renewed soft furnishings, modernized galley appliances, and numerous mechanical and technical improvements that elevate both comfort and functionality while respecting the vessel's distinctive Mangusta character. Ownership has remained proactive: significant maintenance work over the past six months culminated in the installation of a completely new battery bank this week and a professional hull polish and cleaning, leaving the yacht in superb cosmetic condition. Mechanically sound and meticulously cared for, this Mangusta 72 is effectively turnkey and ready for immediate use—ideal for spirited coastal runs, entertaining or extended stays afloat. Clean trades accepted.

Key features

Configured to welcome up to seven guests across three elegantly appointed cabins, this yacht benefited from an extensive refit completed in 2021–2022 that renewed both her styling and her reliability; entertaining is effortless thanks to a large wine cooler/wine cellar on board, while propulsion performance has been enhanced by two new Rolla propellers (2023); dedicated crew accommodation for two guarantees discreet, attentive service throughout every voyage.

Hull and construction

Launched by Overmarine in 2004, the Mangusta 72 features a glass-reinforced plastic (GRP) hull with a matching GRP superstructure, carries a gross tonnage of 72 GT and is built to comply with CE classification standards.

Dimensions

Spanning 23.00 m (75'6") overall, she presents a generous beam of 5.50 m (18') and a shallow draft of 1.15 m (3'8"), proportions carefully balanced to deliver assured seakeeping, abundant interior volume and effortless access to shallow cruising grounds.

Performance

Reaching a peak speed of 34 knots and sustaining an effortless cruising pace of 32 knots, she delivers swift passages that marry exhilarating performance with composed, refined handling.

Machinery and mechanical

Beneath the decks sit twin MAN V12 diesel engines, each delivering 1,600 HP through a reliable shaft drive to achieve a harmonious combination of power and refinement. Hydraulic trim tabs fine-tune the vessel's running attitude for smooth, efficient passages, while close-quarters handling is enhanced by an electric bow thruster fitted new in 2022. An engineered engine-room ventilation system underpins consistent operational performance, and onboard electrical needs are supplied by twin Kohler generators, each rated at 16 kW.

Capacities

Built to undertake extended voyages, the yacht carries a capacious 4,200 liters of fuel together with 1,200 liters of fresh water, providing dependable range and enduring onboard comfort for prolonged passages between ports.

Exterior features

Every exterior detail has been conceived to marry refined style with assured functionality, beginning at the bow and flowing to the stern. Full teak decking covers the cockpit, aft deck, bathing platform and stairs, providing a warm, nonslip surface whether underway or at anchor. A Besenzoni hydraulic gangway facilitates graceful boarding, while a discreet tender garage stores water toys out of sight yet ready for instant deployment. The radar arch defines the yacht's silhouette with practical presence and an electric anchor windlass ensures mooring is both swift and precise. Secure sea rails and sturdy bulwarks deliver confidence on deck, complemented by a convenient deck shower and washdown for rinsing off after a dip. A generous swim platform with bathing ladder makes entry to the sea effortless, and after dark

underwater lights illuminate the waterline, casting the yacht in an enchanting glow.

Interior features

A gracious main deck salon, anchored by a dedicated dining area, serves as the yacht's social nucleus and flows seamlessly into an open-plan galley designed to keep conversation alive while making service effortless. Navigation is handled from twin helm positions: an interior helm station providing reliable all-weather control and a raised bridge helm that delivers enhanced sightlines. Guests are accommodated by three ensuite bathrooms, and a recent refit replacing interior soft goods has imparted a fresh, contemporary finish throughout.

Galley and appliances

The galley is comprehensively fitted with a ceramic cooktop, microwave oven, dishwasher, refrigerator and freezer, coffee maker and sink, complemented by a dedicated wine refrigerator, creating an efficient culinary workspace crafted for effortless meal preparation and sophisticated onboard entertaining.

Electronics and navigation

Anchored by a complete Furuno electronics suite, the helm is fitted with Furuno radar, a Furuno chart plotter, Furuno GPS, a Furuno autopilot and a Furuno echo sounder, together providing meticulous situational awareness and effortless course management. Navigation is further refined by a high-accuracy compass and a clearly readable rudder angle indicator, while an electric searchlight guarantees confident, controlled operation well into the night.

Entertainment and communication

Onboard entertainment and connectivity are executed with subtle luxury: a Simrad VHF radio guarantees clear, reliable maritime communication, satellite TV provides a curated selection of programming for relaxed viewing, and Starlink internet supplies consistent, high-performance connectivity at sea. Samsung flat-screen TVs deliver crisp, detailed visuals in each living area, while a refined audio system fills the interior with balanced, atmospheric sound to enhance every moment on the water.

Water and climate systems

Comfort aboard is delivered by a sophisticated climate system offering both air conditioning and heating to maintain an impeccably tempered atmosphere through every season. A pressurised freshwater distribution network guarantees a steady flow to all areas of the yacht, while a generous water heater supplies abundant hot water for the galley and heads. Extended autonomy is achieved thanks to a seawater treatment system that replenishes onboard freshwater reserves, and separate grey and black water systems discreetly and responsibly manage all waste.

Safety features

For complete peace of mind, the yacht is fitted with strategically positioned fire extinguishers for immediate access and is stocked with life jackets and lifebelts for every guest and crew member. Three high-capacity bilge pumps are installed to manage any water ingress efficiently, while a comprehensive vessel monitoring system provides continuous oversight of critical functions. An integrated camera system enhances awareness both on deck and below, and whether underway or moored, heavy-duty fenders, reliable mooring lines and

purpose-built safety equipment form a cohesive protective ensemble designed to safeguard everyone aboard.

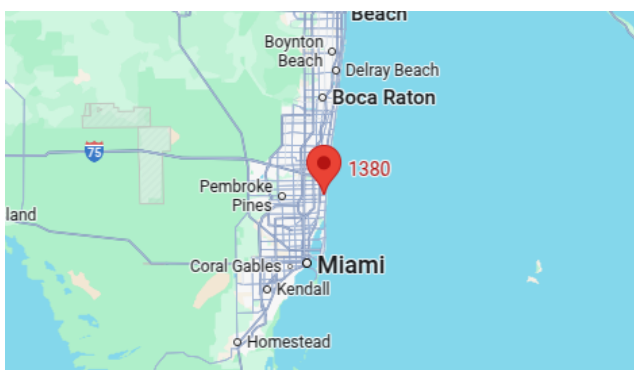
