OVERVIEW

NAUTI KAT spent the summer exploring the Northeast and is now making her way back to Florida—a rare chance to own a late model Pearl 72. This striking 72 foot Pearl flybridge motor yacht has been attracting attention from the Eastern Seaboard to the Bahamas, blending the sumptuous comfort of a luxury cruiser with the seaworthiness of a bluewater family yacht. Inside Kelly Hoppen's Indulgence interior, a calm, contemporary palette unfolds across four en suite double guest staterooms with four heads, while a separate crew cabin for 2-3 ensures discreet, capable service. The layout includes a forward master with a private entrance and a second full beam master amidships, offering exceptional accommodation flexibility.

Her practical and recreational appointments are equally refined: a tender/jet ski garage with a custom built in storage system capable of stowing a RIB, a foredeck lounging area with canopy shade for daytime relaxation, and Starlink satellite internet for reliable connectivity. Seakeeper stabilization and robust MAN power deliver composed, confident passages, and Dixon Yacht Design exterior styling and naval architecture lend both grace and performance. A hardtop with a tilt and slide sunroof, hydraulic swim/bathing platform and drop down side platforms that form expansive beach club terraces complete the package, making the Pearl 72 a modern, elegant cruising yacht with the soul of a sport yacht.

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Engines and generators

Power is delivered by two MAN 1,550 HP engines, their authority complemented by a Marco oil change system that transforms routine servicing into a fast, immaculate operation. Electrical autonomy at anchor and underway is assured by two Kohler 20.5 kW generators fitted with an auto start system, currently showing hours of use at P-287 and S-285, giving a clear service snapshot for careful ownership. Command is effortless from three dedicated control stations—cockpit, flybridge and lower helm—each providing precise engine and thruster control exactly where you need it, so handling and manoeuvring feel intuitive whether docking or cruising offshore.

Interior

Four guest cabins, each with its own ensuite, are arranged with considered luxury as two Master cabins, one Double and one Twin, while the crew benefit from a dedicated cabin featuring twin bunks, a crew mess, an ensuite and direct access to the engine room for discreet, efficient operation. Decorative bed covers and scatter cushions from Kelly Hoppen lift the onboard aesthetic, joined by wood flooring throughout that gives a warm, contemporary finish. The saloon invites relaxation with an L-shaped sofa, two armchairs and a coffee table, while two custom-made front-flip seats with manual slide adjustment at the lower helm add comfort and practicality underway. Selected options amplify refinement with the “Indulgence” Interior by Kelly Hoppen Interior Design and Kelly Hoppen collection accessories, overhead windscreen blinds and forward saloon side window blinds, electrically operated blinds throughout, plus an upgraded stainless-steel patio door converted to electrically operated with a patio door curtain to create a seamless transition

between interior elegance and open-air living.

Air conditioning

Selected upgrades provide true tropical capability, with air conditioning engineered to perform in ambient temperatures up to 40°C, dedicated vents installed to the guest head cabins and a full climate control system fitted to the crew cabin, together assuring consistently cool, quiet comfort throughout the vessel whether at rest or under way.

Deck and hull

Command from the flybridge is poised and confident thanks to two custom-made helm seats with manual slide adjustment, while the deck layout invites every style of open-air living with a flybridge deck featuring a walk-behind wetbar, a forward sunbathing area with upholstered seating and a teak table, a foredeck seating area with a fold-out teak table and generous storage lockers, and a spacious aft cockpit with a wet bar and sink. A dedicated tender and jet ski garage works in concert with an H&B hydraulically operated bathing lift platform, and fold-down side platforms convert the waterline into a private beach club. Precision handling is delivered by a Side Power electric bow thruster and a Humphree Trim Interceptor with Automatic List and Trim Assist. Deck-selected options raise versatility and style with a hard top featuring a tilt-and-slide sunroof and an electrically operated sun awning aft, a Bedouin-style foredeck bimini, an aft flybridge sunpad with storage beneath, a foredeck table with an electrically operated leg and a bow sunpad with a flip-up backrest. Practical appointments include a Trend marine semi-electric side door operable from the lower helm, two Williams tender/jet ski launch-and-recovery systems, teak fitted to the flybridge, two side boarding gates, three pairs of underwater lights, four pop-up foredeck lights, rear

docking lights and a 3.8M Opacmare telescopic passerelle. Shore-side readiness is complete with two Glendenning cable master units and an in-port water connection, while exterior presentation is refined with Spradling external upholstery in MERCURY, a full set of external covers in light grey, a white hull and coloured gel coat detail on the flybridge, hard top, foredeck and cockpit. Hull-selected options add ultimate poise with a Seakeeper SK18 gyro stabilizer, an Ultramarine 80 kg stainless-steel anchor upgrade, a Side Power 13HP stern thruster and an upgrade of the bow and stern thrusters to hydraulic type.

Navigation and audio visual

Navigation is anchored by two Garmin GPS MAP units and two Garmin GMI 20 marine instrument displays, paired with a Garmin Auto Pilot rector pack and a Garmin GHC20 second-station autopilot to deliver reliable route-keeping and situational awareness. Communications and sensors are comprehensive, including a VHF aerial, Garmin VHF, Garmin GHS handset, a Garmin transducer, a Garmin SD card reader, a Garmin GRF10 rudder feedback sensor and a Garmin GPS24XD antenna/receiver, all integrated within an intuitive Garmin navigation network. Entertainment flows through a Fusion sound system with speakers distributed throughout the vessel, wiring for Sat TV and dedicated screens with a 43" Smart 4K HD TV with rise/fall mechanism in the owner's cabin and a 43" Smart 4K HD TV in the VIP cabin, each supported by a pair of flush-fit speakers, while Fusion speakers serve the cockpit and flybridge. Selected upgrades elevate capability with an expanded navigation suite including a 48" Garmin radar with open scanner and a package of four Garmin screens with AIS, an upgraded A/V system adding TVs in guest cabins plus a foredeck and flybridge stereo with amplifiers and speakers, an upgraded saloon screen to a 65" TV and three CCTV cameras enhancing security and visibility.

Electrical and appliances

A robust Applied Marine Automation AC/DC electrical system with remote breakers and a lower helm distribution panel provides a dependable backbone, complemented by a 40-gallon water heater equipped with a heat exchanger and heating element and a Headhunter 24V DC X caliber water pump for reliable domestic systems. Practical fittings include a dual trumpet horn, Exalto windshield wipers, a Marinco searchlight, 24 V garage lighting, custom overhead lighting, wall and bedside reading lights, wardrobe illuminated hanging rails, tank level monitoring and IMCO Marine LED navigation lights. The galley and wetbar are specified to a premium level with a Miele induction hob with built in extractor, a Miele combination microwave/oven/grill, a full-height fridge/freezer and a wine cooler. Up on deck, a Kenyon electric BBQ on the flybridge is joined by a Vitrigio refrigerator and a coolbox on the flybridge, with sinks and folding hot-and-cold water taps both on the flybridge and in the cockpit for effortless hospitality. Selected options further amplify autonomy and convenience with an upgrade to Boost isolation transformers, an icemaker, a Miele washer/dryer, a Vitrofrigio C51iX fridge in the crew cabin, a Vitrofrigio C51iX fridge in the cockpit wet bar in place of the standard waste bin, and four Dometic CD20 drawer fridges serving the guest staterooms.
