OVERVIEW

Class Dismissed is a compelling 2017 Azimut 72 Flybridge that fuses Italian artistry with precision engineering and sumptuous comfort, positioning it among the most sophisticated yachts in its class. Exterior lines by Stefano Righini and interiors conceived by Carlo Galeazzi express Azimut's signature flowing silhouette, expansive glazing, and a fresh, contemporary sensibility. The yacht's graceful profile is topped by an extensive flybridge created for effortless al fresco life, appointed with deep lounges, a convivial dining nook, and a well-equipped wet bar. Strategic use of carbon fiber in the superstructure trims weight and improves efficiency while increasing interior volume and structural rigidity, a combination that elevates both performance and sea-kindly stability. As a true flybridge motor yacht and planing performance cruiser, it is crafted for owners who prize poise, presence, and exacting performance on the water.

Measuring 74 feet 3 inches overall with an 18 feet 4 inches beam, Class Dismissed delivers a generous platform for refined living. The main deck unfolds in an open, flowing plan that links salon, dining area, and galley beneath broad, sweeping windows that frame the sea and sky. Carefully chosen furnishings, premium finishes, and attentive detailing create a serene contemporary atmosphere that reads as both luxurious and inviting. Aft, the cockpit extends the interior outward with comfortable seating and a versatile dining area—ideal for leisurely breakfasts, sunset cocktails, and elegant alfresco suppers—making this Mediterranean cruiser as welcoming at anchor as it is underway.

Below decks, four finely appointed staterooms serve as private sanctuaries, each complemented by its own en suite. The full-beam owner's suite amidships benefits from large hull windows that flood the space with natural light, a king-size berth, abundant storage, and a cosy lounge that turns the

cabin into a true personal retreat. Forward, a VIP stateroom and two additional guest cabins ensure every guest enjoys equal measures of comfort and privacy. Discreet crew quarters preserve the calm atmosphere on board while supporting attentive service, rounding out the yacht's functional elegance. Propulsion comes from twin MAN V12 engines rated at 1,400 hp each, delivering brisk acceleration, a top speed near 32 knots, and a comfortable cruise around 26 knots. Intuitive helm systems—combining modern navigation suites with precise joystick controls—translate scale into confidence, making close-quarters handling and tight marina maneuvers feel surprisingly simple. A Seakeeper 16 gyro stabilizer substantially reduces roll both at rest and underway, refining the yacht's seakeeping and lifting onboard comfort for guests who expect a smooth, quiet passage from a premium motor yacht. Innovation permeates every aspect, from robust connectivity and immersive entertainment systems to thoughtful power management designed to keep voyages seamless and worry-free. Whether whisking away for impromptu weekend escapes or venturing on extended bluewater cruises, this Azimut 72 Flybridge balances speed, style, and serenity with rare finesse. Class Dismissed stands as an elegant, contemporary platform that excels equally at entertaining, relaxing, and exploring.

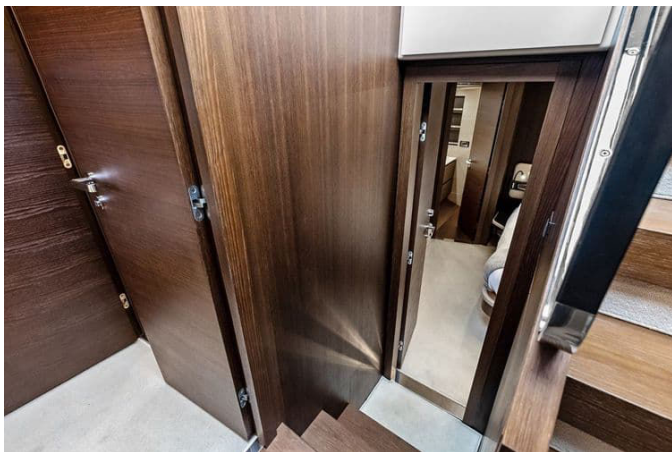


















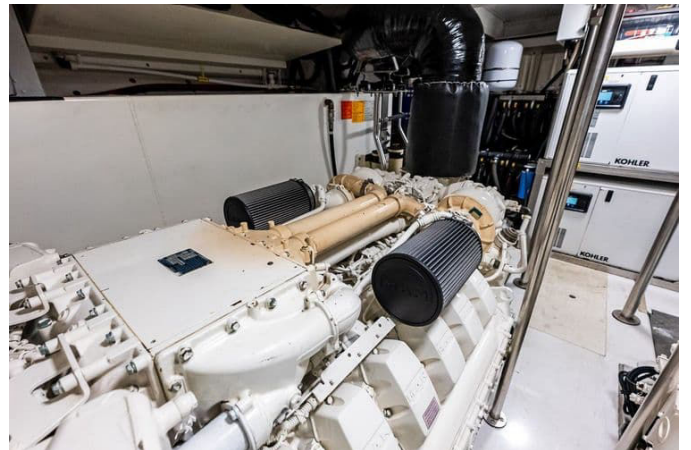














DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Bow

Forward, the bow is crafted as a welcoming retreat, with a convivial table and deep, wraparound seating that invites lingering sunsets and unhurried conversation. A generous sun pad crowns the foredeck for effortless lounging, while a sleek canopy extends over the bench seating, its motion powered by smooth hydraulic pumps to deliver instant shade on demand. Practicality is woven into every detail: ample storage lockers discreetly stow gear, JL Audio speakers bathe the space in rich sound, and the windlass with deck-mounted controls works in concert with two dedicated chain lockers for confident anchoring. Completing the picture, water and waste deck fills are thoughtfully positioned for clean, efficient service alongside neatly organized hardware.

Flybridge

The flybridge is a social sanctuary in the open air, anchored by an electric grill and a two-burner cooktop that turn casual afternoons into culinary occasions. A sink, an Isotherm ice maker, and a Vitrifrigo refrigerator keep service seamless, while a retractable roof shade deploys at the touch of a remote to temper the sun. Safety is always close at hand with a properly stowed life raft, and the mood is elevated with a Fusion remote head unit driving crisp JL Audio speakers. It's a space designed for easy entertaining, long lunches, and uninterrupted horizons.

Flybridge helm

Command comes naturally at the flybridge helm, where dual Raymarine screens pair with two Bioning engine displays to present navigation and

machinery data with absolute clarity. Two captain's chairs offer ergonomic support, while a responsive joystick, Side-Power bow and stern thrusters, and a Raymarine autopilot with dedicated display and remote bring fingertip control to close-quarters maneuvers and passage-making alike. An ACR searchlight remote, Seakeeper display, chain counter, Humphree tabs display, VHF, and Fusion head unit round out a professional-grade console. Underfoot, teak decks add warmth and grip, and abundant storage keeps the helm orderly and ready.

Engine room

Below, the engine room is meticulously organized and purpose-built, complete with a well-stocked toolbox and two Onan generators showing 1993 hours and 2027 hours for dependable auxiliary power. A Bluewater water maker ensures self-sufficiency on extended cruises, while a robust A/C plant keeps the interior climate controlled and serene. Exhaust fans maintain fresh airflow, and the Fireboy system provides vigilant fire suppression for confident, uninterrupted operation.

Aft deck

The aft deck is tailored for gracious living on the water, featuring a starboard-side wing station with joystick, Side-Power thruster, and passerelle control to make docking as elegant as the arrival. Practical systems—battery switches, powered capstans, and manual bilge pumps—are within easy reach yet discreetly integrated. Entertaining is effortless around a dining table that seats up to eight, served by a sink with storage, a Vitrifrigo fridge, and dedicated trash and recycling bins, with additional storage throughout including clever under-seat compartments. A Fusion remote and JL Audio speakers set the tone, while an engine-room deck hatch provides quick access

below. A fire hose stands ready for safety, and the hydraulic swim platform—with its intuitive controls and flip-down ladder—pairs beautifully with a cavernous locker sized for dive tanks or bulky gear.

Galley

The galley blends professional capability with refined style: a Bosch four-burner cooktop partners with a Millie convection oven microwave to handle every menu with ease. A Dometic fridge-freezer unit keeps provisions perfectly chilled, assisted by an efficient exhaust fan to maintain a fresh working environment. The Barazza dual sink streamlines prep and cleanup, while the choice of formal dining or a relaxed breakfast settee lets you set the tone for every meal.

Day head

Thoughtfully positioned for convenience, the day head is configured in a welcoming Jack-and-Jill layout that opens directly to the port-side queen cabin, offering guests easy access by day and private en suite comfort by night.

Port queen

The port-side queen cabin is a serene haven, softly lit with dedicated reading lights and finished with warm LED accents. Entertainment comes via a Samsung TV, climate is dialed in at the touch of a thermostat, and personal belongings find a tidy home in a generous hanging locker. An en suite head completes the privacy, ensuring restful nights and restorative mornings.

STBD twin

The starboard twin cabin is bright and cleverly arranged, with two comfortable

berths illuminated by focused reading lights and framed by efficient LED lighting. A Samsung TV and individual thermostat enhance comfort, while a hanging locker provides organized storage. The en suite head underscores the cabin's independence and ease.

VIP cabin

The forward VIP cabin feels both elevated and inviting, with a Samsung TV paired to a Bose sound bar for cinematic evenings. Alcove reading lights and ambient LED lighting strike a refined balance, while under-bed storage maximizes space. Two hanging lockers keep wardrobes pristine, and the en suite head ensures the serene, self-contained experience discerning guests appreciate.

Primary cabin

The full-beam primary stateroom is a masterclass in quiet luxury, with a relaxing settee and a vanity complete with a makeup mirror offering a personal retreat within a retreat. Entertainment is immersive via a Samsung flat screen and a Bose surround sound system, while lighting for reading and soft LED accents set the tone. The en suite head features a rain shower and his-and-hers sinks for an indulgent daily ritual, with two hanging lockers keeping wardrobes impeccable. A digital safe secures valuables with effortless peace of mind.

Crew quarters

Thoughtfully appointed crew quarters make professional service seamless, with a separate stateroom offering a single berth and a second bunk to accommodate changing schedules. A dedicated head and a practical

washer/dryer support extended time aboard, while the neatly integrated power plant equipment reflects purposeful engineering and easy access for routine checks.

Recent services

Recent care underscores a no-compromise maintenance philosophy. In 2026, the generators received a full service on 3/26, engines were treated to fresh fluids, filters, and zincs on 3/26, a new 4 kW Raymarine radar was installed, and the A/C system was serviced and acid-flushed to peak efficiency. The 2025 program added thoughtful upgrades and preventative work, including new Apple TV units in the master and port stateroom, six new AGM batteries, a Seakeeper service on 2/25, a new bow thruster gear leg on 6/25, fresh bottom paint with PropSpeed on running gear on 7/25, and a new salon A/C blower fan installed on 12/25.

Salon

The salon welcomes with a cool hush courtesy of a new A/C unit, while a Vitrifrigo wine cooler and an illuminated liquor cabinet elevate every occasion from aperitif to nightcap. A Bose surround sound system pairs beautifully with a Samsung flat screen that rises and lowers on a smooth electric lift, all managed to your ideal temperature with a dedicated thermostat. Supple leather couches invite you to settle in and stay awhile, turning the sea into your favorite living room view.

Helm

At the lower helm, precision meets poise. Dual Raymarine GS165 displays sit at the core, complemented by two Bioning engine displays and twin Raymarine

autopilots for redundancy and confidence. Fine control comes by way of a joystick, Side-Power bow and stern thrusters, a Humphree trim tab indicator, and a chain counter for precise anchoring. An ACR spotlight control, Seakeeper screen, clear A/C vents, engine start/stop, VHF, an analog compass, a Sea-Fire indicator, and a Raymarine remote complete an authoritative helm. Two adjustable captain's chairs and a starboard side door underscore comfort and practicality in equal measure.

Exclusions

The following items are excluded from the sale: the jet ski and all owner's personal effects.

Upgrades and options

A comprehensive suite of upgrades and options enhances performance, comfort, and control: a Seakeeper 16 gyro brings remarkable stability; Aventics joystick docking makes close-quarters handling intuitive; and twin Kohler 23 kW generators anchor robust ship's power. The 1400 HP MAN engine package delivers authoritative thrust, complemented by a full Raymarine electronics suite and an exterior JL Audio speaker package for soundtrack and situational awareness alike. A hydraulic swim platform expands your private beach, while both bow and stern thrusters refine maneuverability. An OpacMare passerelle transforms boarding into an effortless ritual, a foredeck canopy tempers the midday sun, and a flybridge grill with a sunroof integrated into the flybridge hardtop turns open air living into an art form. Six underwater lights dramatize evenings at anchor, Starlink keeps you connected offshore, and Bose surround systems envelop both the master and the main salon in cinema grade sound. Practical luxuries include a separate washer and dryer, a freshly reupholstered crew cabin, new windshield wipers, and a rejuvenated exterior lighting suite

with 20 fixtures offering three colors—red, white, and blue. Rounding it out are six new batteries and recently serviced motor oil, filters, and fuel systems to keep adventures effortless from the first push of the throttles.

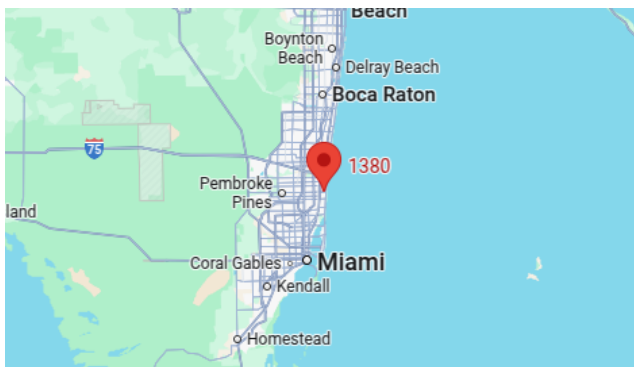
