OVERVIEW

The 2013 Princess 72 flybridge motor yacht IBIZA is offered in immaculate condition under private ownership, exuding timeless elegance and the assured performance expected of a high end cruiser. Powered by twin Caterpillar C32A diesel engines, she is a true planing yacht that delivers poised, refined passages, while TRAC fin stabilizers and hydraulic thrusters fore and aft ensure secure, comfortable motion whether at speed or at rest. A sweeping flybridge, complete with wet bar and a dedicated dining area, invites effortless entertaining and leisurely evenings afloat, complemented by a hydraulic bimini with integrated lighting and a premium Bose audio system for ambience.

Professionally crewed and meticulously maintained, IBIZA arrives with complete service records, documented shipyard periods and a full dry dock history. Never used for charter and showing light, considerate use, she has enjoyed only two owners from new and presents a genuinely private experience. Practical conveniences include a hydraulic raise/lower stern bathing platform and a third helm station in the cockpit, while the interior reveals piano gloss walnut joinery and elegant parquet timber flooring throughout.

Accommodation is arranged for family and guests in four sumptuous cabins for up to eight, with separate quarters for two crew—an ideal configuration for Mediterranean family cruising or serious bluewater passages. With a motivated seller, IBIZA represents a compelling opportunity for those seeking a sophisticated, capable motor yacht.

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Description

A pure white hull, polished walnut furniture and a suite of bespoke finishes set the tone for an elegant yacht crafted for connoisseurs, where teak graces the side passages and the flybridge and underfoot teak elevates the lounge, dining area, galley and wheelhouse beyond the standard. The galley's working surface is finished in Juparana Colombo granite and the wheelhouse seats are upholstered in brown leather with contrast stitching, while in the cabins Velvet Pearl carpet from the Platinum collection softens every step and teak floors continue the theme of natural luxury in the bathrooms. Attention to comfort and coherence extends throughout the exterior, where the seating in the cockpit and on the flybridge together with the sunbathing mattresses are trimmed in Movida Metallic Beige with Weiss inserts, practical detailing includes anchorages for the keel blocks of the tender on the swimming platform, a washing machine with drying relocated to the stern instead of beneath the stairs to the cabins, a removable teak table at the bow, a Lava Brick barbecue in place of the standard and a stainless-steel anchor replacing the standard. Power, poise and control are assured by a TRAC fin stabilization system and a comprehensive hydraulic installation consisting of independent pumps mounted on each main engine with a cross connection allowing hydraulic devices to be fed by pressure from either pump; the installation includes a hydraulic winch and an uprated bow thruster in lieu of the standard and is complemented by hydraulic bow and stern thrusters, a flybridge crane and a third control station for the main engines and thrusters located in the cockpit. Extended autonomy comes via an Idromar 160 lt water maker and an ONAN 27.50 kW generator installed in place of the standard, with European-standard 220V-240V electrical outlets throughout. Entertainment is

immersive and impeccably integrated, the salon featuring a BOSE Lifestyle 48 DVD home theater system while the master cabin and the bow cabin each boast a BOSE 3.2.1. GS system with DVD, both connected to the BOSE Lifestyle 48 head set; on the flybridge waterproof speakers are tied into the BOSE Lifestyle 48 and managed by a separate control panel, a 22" LCD TV in the bow cabin connects to the BOSE 3.2.1. GS and docking stations for an iPOD are provided in the cabin and the master cabin. The ambiance is refined further with interior materials from the Platinum collection and a non-standard interior scheme employing Alcantara and beige vinyl instead of standard white materials, door handles with brown leather trim of the slope replacing standard handles, a zippered pocket crafted for the cockpit cover and thirty-four decorative pillows. Everyday luxury has been anticipated down to the smallest touch with electric heated towel rails in the master cabins, the bow cabin and the starboard cabins, a combined toilet with a built-in bidet instead of the standard unit, eight mosquito nets on the windows plus two large mosquito nets for the bow cabin and two for the master cabin, and above it all a dark blue bimini top with hydraulics, additional lighting and remote control shades the deck with all outer covers finished in dark blue instead of standard white, while an installed kingston prepares the yacht for the subsequent addition of a desalter or water treatment system, underscoring thoughtful engineering for voyages to come.
