OVERVIEW

Meet Psyche, a 2015 Ocean Alexander 72—an immaculately maintained flybridge pilothouse motor yacht that blends performance, refinement, and thoughtful engineering into a single, elegant package. Her semi-displacement hull, driven by twin Caterpillar C18 ACERTs, propels her with assured grace, cruising at approximately 18 knots and capable of around 22 knots at top speed. Solid underfoot and refined within, she carries the composure of a bluewater, long-range cruiser while remaining ideally suited to graceful coastal passages and weekend escapes.

Onboard appointments and systems are chosen to elevate life at sea: fin stabilizers with oversized surfaces deliver exceptional roll control; an optional Yacht Controller provides effortless remote docking; bow and stern thrusters give precise close-quarters maneuverability. The exterior wears an Alexseal high-gloss polyurethane finish, and navigation is managed through a comprehensive Garmin electronics package. Practical equipment includes a Steelhead yacht crane/davit for tender handling, a Kohler 23 kW generator for reliable ship's power, and FIREBOY-XINTEX automatic fire suppression for safety. An additional tender rounds out the offering for shore runs and exploration.

Psyche represents a compelling chance to own a proven, capable, and beautifully styled Ocean Alexander 72—luxury pedigree, cruising versatility, and ready-now confidence.

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Salon / galley

The salon and galley converge as an open, inviting living space, their spacious layout encouraging effortless flow between lounging and dining, where large sightlines and carefully considered finishes create an atmosphere of relaxed refinement; high-end interior appliances elevate daily life on board, turning every meal into a refined occasion and every gathering into an easy celebration framed by comfort and style.

Accommodation

Four guest staterooms provide generous privacy and comfort, including a master suite with a private entrance from the salon and three staterooms forward, each designed to offer serene retreat and thoughtful storage; three guest heads serve the accommodation deck with hotel-like ease, while an aft crew cabin, discretely separate from guest areas, ensures professional service and unobtrusive operation, and a dedicated crew head completes the thoughtful division between personal retreat and operational efficiency.

Deck

On deck, a Steelhead ES1500R yacht crane stands ready for seamless tender handling, its robust capacity making launching and retrieval effortless, while the exterior Alexseal polyurethane paint minimizes maintenance and preserves a crisp, enduring luster that resists the elements; ground tackle is managed with authority by a Maxwell windlass VWCLP3500, bringing confident anchoring to every anchorage.

Electronics

The helm is anchored by a comprehensive Garmin electronic suite that delivers intuitive navigation and heightened situational awareness through integrated displays and sensors, complemented by the dependable Ritchie Compass FN201 for redundant heading reference; presence on the water is announced with authority by two Kahlenberg horns, models S-OA/24V and V-69-K/24V, which combine classic tone with modern reliability to ensure unmistakable signaling.

Mechanical equipment & engine

Performance and poise come from twin Caterpillar C18-Acert diesel engines, 1136 HP, delivering direct drive propulsion to two Hung Shen 40" four-blade propellers that translate torque into smooth, efficient thrust; fuel oil filtration for the main engines is handled by a Racor 75/1000Max30 to protect injection systems, while precise control arrives via the Glendinning Eee double 24V 11230-C engine control system and the Teleflex PSHC-5803/5804-22-2 power steering system with helm pump model H-22 for responsive helm feel. Seakeeping is enhanced by a Keypower 6ft-2fin stabilizer, with low-speed maneuvering assured by a Keypower 12" hydraulic bow thruster rated at 25 HP and a Keypower 10" hydraulic stern thruster rated at 15 HP. The engine room breathes cleanly through a Delta "T" 600-C2 ventilation system, and onboard comfort is sustained by full air-conditioning throughout the guest cabins, owner's stateroom, salon, crew quarters, and flybridge.

Electrical system

Electric autonomy is anchored by a Kohler 23kW generator protected by a Racor 75/500Max30 fuel oil filter, feeding a robust DC architecture; power

storage is specified with DISCOVER EV8DA-A BATTERIES 24V for the main bank, DISCOVER D31A-120D BATTERIES 12V for the generator, and DISCOVER EV8DA-A BATTERIES 24V for the engines, while charging is handled by a Victron Centaur 24/60 with 90/265 VAC 45–65 HZ input and 28.5VDC 50 AMP output to ensure reliable replenishment. Safety is elevated with a FIREBOY-XINTEX MA2-1500-FE241 fire extinguisher system and a FIREBOY-XINTEX ES-8000-01 24V automatic engine shutdown system for rapid, automated protection.

Additional tender

An additional tender complements the mothership: the 12' Walker Bay 2017 EWW, HIN EWVGE753B717, powered by an Evinrude Etec 40HP, offering a nimble, dependable shuttle for shore runs and exploration; flying the USA flag, this tender is tax paid and registered in FL, ensuring effortless ownership and immediate readiness for adventure.
