OVERVIEW

Meticulously maintained and reserved exclusively for private cruising, this Princess Y72 flybridge motor yacht is presented in pristine condition. Retained by a sole private owner since delivery and never offered for charter, she has been cared for to the exacting standards one expects of a luxury motor yacht. Twin MAN V12 – 1,650 hp engines provide hushed, assured propulsion and a composed, confident ride that blends the performance of a motor yacht with refined elegance. A third control station in the cockpit (engine controls, bow thruster controls, engine emergency stop) adds practical versatility for close-quarters handling.

Designed for gracious entertaining and comfortable living at sea, the expansive salon embraces an open-plan arrangement with a stylish bar and a fully equipped galley—an ideal layout for hosting family and friends aboard a premium flybridge yacht. The interior is finished in refined Silver Oak satin joinery, while a high-end Naim audio system enhances the onboard ambiance. Accommodating up to eight guests, the vessel offers four beautifully appointed en-suite cabins, crowned by a full-beam owner's stateroom accessed by a private staircase from the salon—an exceptional feature for an owner-operated cruiser. Further creature comforts and systems include hydraulic bow and stern thrusters, underwater lighting, a GRP flybridge hardtop, a Seakeeper 18 gyro stabilizer, and a hydraulic up/down bathing platform, all contributing to outstanding comfort whether underway or at anchor and perfectly suited to coastal and Mediterranean cruising.





DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Description

Powered by twin MAN V12-1650 engines delivering 1,650 hp each, this yacht blends muscular performance with poised refinement, its specification elevated by an Idromar watermaker producing 160 liters per hour and a serenely modern interior in silver oak with a satin finish while the galley, dinette and helm floors are executed in V groove planked walnut; maneuvering is effortless thanks to the dual station Aventics joystick that operates both engines and the bow thruster, and the flybridge is crowned by a GRP hardtop with a fixed glass panel and dimmable LED lighting, finished in white gelcoat with Oyster Grey Metallic legs and reduced height aerials mounted atop. Precision handling at close quarters comes from a hydraulic variable speed 320 kgf bow thruster and a hydraulic 240 kgf stern thruster, replacing the standard 250 kgf electric bow thruster, supported by an engine driven hydraulic system and a dual control station that features a docking system hold function, while comfort at sea is optimized by a Seakeeper 18 gyroscopic stabilizer with upper helm control via the chartplotter. The port stateroom features a double berth on a sliding mechanism and every bathroom is appointed with marble floors, the main hardtop awning is finished in Graphite Gray Metallic with Oyster Gray Metallic legs, and boarding and shore access are simple and secure via a telescopic 4.1 m gangway with folding handrails and remote control, with teak decking spanning the flybridge, side decks and foredeck for a timeless, practical finish. A third control station in the cockpit provides engine controls, bow thruster controls and an engine emergency stop, while side entry doors on both port and starboard ensure flexible boarding.

Ground tackle and deck amenities are equally comprehensive: an Ultra Marine

stainless steel anchor upgraded to 50 kg is complemented by an additional twenty meters of 12 mm chain for a total of 80 m, and forward a teak coffee table with anchor point serves the seating area; a shore water inlet is positioned at the transom and a deck wash system is located in the transom, bow and flybridge lockers, bathing is refined by a carbon fiber transom shower pole and a deck shower with an outlet on the swim platform, al fresco cooking is elevated by an additional Kenyon grill matching the standard Kenyon in the flybridge wet bar — two in total — while the Muirhead coffee table with storage in Cairngorm White adds a clean, architectural touch and watersports are effortlessly supported by Seabob stowage with charging points in the transom locker. Electrical independence is bolstered by an upgraded ONAN 27 kW/50 Hz main generator and visibility in adverse weather benefits from a windshield warm air heater system, and on deck relaxation and conversation are anchored by two Portofino B95A cockpit chairs.

The electrical and domestic specification enhances every moment on board: guest cabins are fitted with electric Roman blinds in lieu of Venetian blinds, all main deck windows excluding the patio door and helm area are equipped with electric standard Venetian blinds or optional Roman blinds with curtains, and the master cabin enjoys electric Roman blinds as well; atmosphere after dark is transformed by full colour underwater lighting to the aft hull, heated towel rails in each bathroom and underfloor heating in the bathrooms. The Exterior Lighting Upgrade Package introduces LED linear lighting one and fiber optic illumination to the valances and cockpit ceiling, together with low level LED dock lighting twenty eight, while the Salon Lighting Upgrade Package adds additional fiber optics for the saloon and dinette and extra LED strips to the valances for gentle, low level illumination. Electrical resilience is improved by replacing the standard batteries with AGM batteries, and for awareness and convenience a single pan/tilt cockpit camera is installed alongside a Miele washer/dryer, a Sub Zero refrigerator drawer of 71 L mounted on the external galley counter and an icemaker at the flybridge wet bar; practicality extends to

a comprehensive power outlet upgrade that adds outlets in the forward, port, starboard, master and aft/crew cabins as well as additional USB charging ports at the flybridge wet bar and on the foredeck sunbathing area.

Entertainment is anchored by a meticulously curated standard audio visual suite: in the deck saloon a 55" UHD LED TV on a tilt/unscrew mechanism pairs with a Naim Uniti Atom featuring Bluetooth, multi room streaming and a dedicated app, complemented by a Blu ray CD/DVD player, two Focal 100 ICW6 speakers and a Focal Cub Evo subwoofer; the master cabin hosts a 50" UHD LED TV with a Naim Uniti Atom offering Bluetooth, multi room streaming and app control plus a Blu ray CD/DVD player and two Focal 100 ICW6 speakers, and on the flybridge a Naim Uniti Atom with Bluetooth, multi room streaming and a dedicated app drives two waterproof Bowers & Wilkins Marine 6 speakers without HDMI connection. The audio system integrates built in Ethernet and 4G connectivity, built in Wi Fi with an external Wi Fi antenna and 3G/4G for extended range and delivers connectivity to shore based Wi Fi networks throughout the vessel, with an activated mobile data SIM card required for mobile internet; the forward cabin features a 43" UHD LED TV and a Naim Uniti Atom with Bluetooth, multi zone streaming and app control paired with a Blu ray CD/DVD player and two Focal 100 ICW6 speakers.

Command and control come via a comprehensive navigation suite: standard equipment includes Raymarine Axiom XL16 multifunction color displays, with two at the lower helm and one at the upper helm serving radar/chartplotter with GPS and a 4 kW SHD 48" digital open matrix color scanner, while a Raymarine Evolution autopilot with speed gyro, control heads and multifunction i70s instruments provides precise steering and comprehensive readouts for speed, distance, trip data, depth alarm, water temperature and more. Upgrades extend capability with an additional Raymarine Axiom XL16 color multifunction display on the upper helm, an RMK 10 remote control keyboard for the upper helm display, a Raymarine Magnum HD color radar

with a 12 kW 48 inch open array scanner and a Raymarine AIS 700 Class B transponder interfaced with the chartplotter and featuring a built in VHF/2.4 m antenna splitter; both helms are further equipped with one 15" Bioning display each dedicated to the Bioning system, presenting engine instrumentation including fuel levels and fuel consumption, a digital boat alarm, lighting control, AC/DC control and monitoring and video surveillance camera display.

Finally, thoughtful retro fits amplify autonomy and connectivity: Hotel Mode is enabled via a Victron system with a 35 kW/h lithium battery package, while Starlink satellite internet brings robust, far reaching bandwidth to life at sea.
