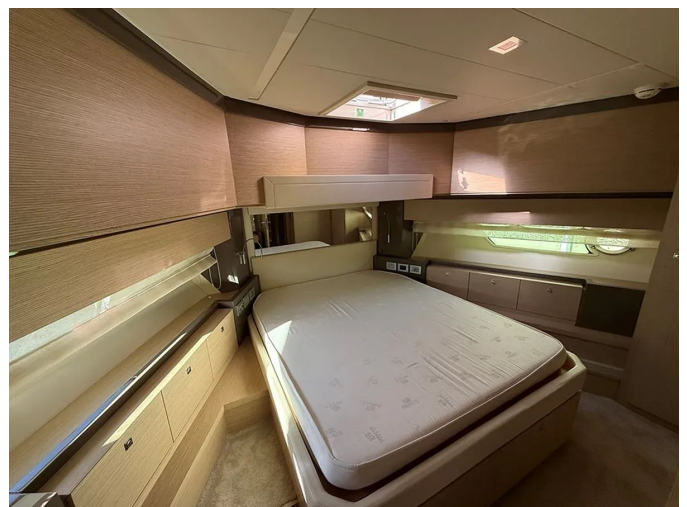

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

About the yacht

At 22.75 metres overall, the Ferretti 750 presents a classic flybridge silhouette that marries a dynamic, sporty presence with the refined grace of Italian design. Conceived for owners who demand both capable performance and upscale living, she offers a harmonious fusion of aesthetic flair, onboard comfort and practical functionality throughout her layout.

Generous, light-filled interiors are beautifully appointed to create an atmosphere that is at once sophisticated and inviting, with abundant natural illumination enhancing the openness of the main salon and dining areas. Premium materials, tasteful finishes and exacting craftsmanship speak to Ferretti's hallmark attention to detail, while the considered interior arrangement preserves privacy and comfort for both owners and their guests. Accommodation is provided in four elegantly finished cabins, each conceived as a tranquil retreat and perfectly suited to extended voyages or leisurely family escapes. Outside, the expansive flybridge is arranged to encourage relaxation and sociable entertaining, offering extensive seating and open-air living that echo the leisurely rhythms of the Mediterranean. The deck plan delivers a variety of options for sunbathing, alfresco dining, convivial gathering or secluded enjoyment of the sea.

Blending contemporary onboard comforts with the unmistakable character of Italian yachtbuilding, the Ferretti 750 furnishes an exclusive cruising environment for the discerning owner. From its gracious interior spaces to its versatile exterior areas, every element has been refined to support relaxed family cruising, elegant entertaining and longer passages offshore.

Equipment

Meticulously outfitted to make every cruise effortless, this yacht is fitted with both bow and stern thrusters to deliver assured handling in tight marinas, while a hydraulically operated platform streamlines tender deployment and water access. A fully integrated third control station adds an extra layer of precision when berthing, and a slender passerelle offers polished, easy boarding. An included tender invites shore excursions beyond the anchorage, satellite television provides onboard entertainment, and a reliable watermaker together with an inverter extend the vessel's self-sufficiency for longer passages. At the heart of the navigation suite a clear, intuitive chart plotter supports confident passage planning and route management.

Equipment and other details

Propulsion and electrical needs are supported by twin Onan generators, each rated at 19 kW and displaying approximately 4,200 hours of operation. Accommodation is arranged in four cabins—a full-beam Master suite, a VIP stateroom and two comfortable guest cabins—offering refined private spaces for owners and visitors. The yacht is fitted for extended cruising with a watermaker, satellite TV, a tender, inverter and chart plotter, complemented by a broad selection of additional equipment to ensure effortless, enjoyable voyages. Hauled out in January 2026, she underwent all scheduled seasonal work alongside major mechanical and technical services, with roughly EUR 160,000 invested in maintenance and upgrades. Professionally maintained and fully serviced, the vessel is presented turnkey and ready for the 2026 cruising season.

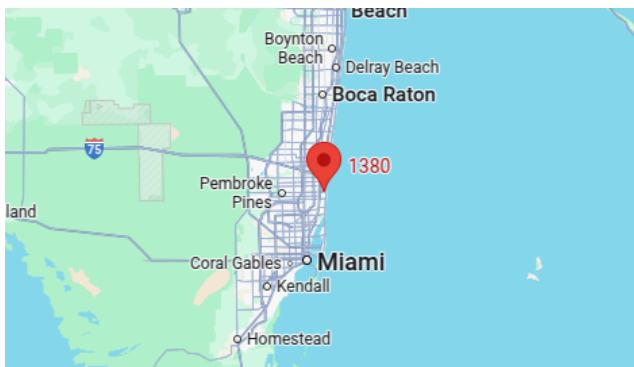
