The 2003 74' Azimut Solar stands as a refined embodiment of Italian boatbuilding, its lines and finish announcing pedigree and purpose. Propelled by twin MTU 12V 183TE 94 engines, she offers assured, efficient propulsion and a smooth, dependable cruising range that inspires confidence on open water. Arranged for convivial living, this flybridge motor yacht unfurls generous areas for alfresco dining, sunbathing and unhurried relaxation across two decks, each framed by expansive views. Born of a celebrated builder crafting luxury yachts since 1959, she promises seasons of graceful passage-making. At 74 feet, this performance motoryacht functions as both a welcoming family cruiser and an elegant platform for entertaining, carrying guests with poise and unmistakable style.

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Flybridge

The flybridge invites effortless circulation via the internal staircase rising from the salon and the external staircase descending from the aft cockpit, creating a fluid connection between decks. A dedicated helm seat commands the upper deck with clear sightlines, while a generous cushions area offers relaxed lounging and a robust fiberglass table accommodates twelve guests for memorable al fresco dining. Entertaining is made simple by well-proportioned bar furniture complete with a sink and refrigerator, and a defined area for the tender ensures waterside adventures are ready at hand. Overhead, a sculpted fiberglass roll bar forms a purposeful radar arch that integrates navigation lights, antennas and search lights into a clean, purposeful silhouette.

Main deck and cockpit

Refined exterior detailing begins with a mahogany cap rail crowned by a stainless steel handrail, framing a cockpit accessed through two side boarding gates in the aft cockpit that facilitate safe and elegant embarkation. Illumination for the external deck is thoughtfully placed along both sides of the superstructure, across the aft cockpit ceiling and tracing the lower part of the bow to create balanced night-time ambience and practical visibility. Practicality is further assured by a watertight door giving direct access to the galley on the starboard side and a watertight door to the engine room on the port side, each designed for secure, weatherproof operation.

Bow

At the bow, confident operation is ensured by an anchor winch control

positioned for swift, intuitive handling, while chain storage is equipped with a fire-extinguisher hose for added safety and readiness. The stem is protected by built-in stainless steel bow protection that guards against wear and impact, and two electric wipers keep the forward windows clear for uninterrupted visibility in all conditions.

Stern

At the stern, a salon door in tempered glass and stainless steel opens onto a welcoming cockpit anchored by a cockpit table that invites convivial outdoor living. Sound carries cleanly through watertight loudspeakers recessed into the aft cockpit ceiling for immersive audio without compromising weatherproofing. A broad swim platform finished with an anti-skid surface simplifies access to the water, while a shore power inlets box mounted on the transom's port side keeps systems supplied when alongside. The yacht's name in stainless steel graces the transom as a refined finishing touch, and fuel inlets are conveniently positioned on the port and starboard sides of the aft cockpit for efficient refueling.

Wheelhouse

The wheelhouse centers on an electrically adjustable helm seat with armrests, positioned before a comprehensive pilot station where a main engines controls synchronizer, navigation instruments, an electrical panel, main engine and reversing gear gauges, and controls for horn, trim tabs, navigation lights and wipers are all within immediate reach. Integrated intercom connectivity links the flybridge, engine room and main deck for seamless communication, while fuel pump and rudder pump controls are conveniently located for rapid response. Climate and comfort are enhanced by a fancoil system, and coordinated curtains, upholstery and carpet complete an interior that balances

operational focus with refined comfort.

Salon

The salon is composed for effortless hospitality, featuring two sofas with integrated storage illuminated by subtle lighting beneath the seats to create soft, inviting ambient glow. To starboard, a refined bar with dedicated bottle and glassware storage and an icemaker stands ready beside an elegant coffee table, supporting relaxed service and entertaining. Dishware and cutlery are stored in a compartment mounted on an electric hi-lo mechanism that preserves space while delivering service with a touch of theatre, marrying practicality with a deliberate sense of occasion.
